901101-5 CREATOR OF HEAVEN AND EARTH

3:40 Hebrews 11:3 “Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see”. Terry goes on to teach about the meaning of faith in both its broad and specific context – either in science, religion or daily living.

9:40 Teaching on the scriptural understanding of creation as it is presented alongside the other cosmological ideas, such as the theory of Macro-Evolution.

18:10 Psalm 90:2 “Before the mountains were born or you brought forth the earth and the world, from everlasting to everlasting you are God”. Our God is eternal, He is creator, He is not a component of the creation, but the Creator alone. No Pantheism.

28:10 The Trinity (entire Godhead) involved in the creation. Terry goes on to teach that Jesus was the agent of creation as the Word – John 1:1 ff. Hebrews 1:1-2 God speaks – His Word, Jesus is the Word. Colossians 1:16 All things were created by Jesus and for Him.

55:00 Terry speaks to the difference between Micro and Macro evolution. No such thing as Macro – meaning hydrogen to man evolution – whereby man is just the highest product of an Ape like predecessor. The scripture is clear – each species

was created according to its own kind. No cross phylum transitions. Micro evolution is an acceptable concept, whereby there can be some changes within a species, perhaps to adapt to their environment.

58:50 Terry teaches on the distinctiveness of man, as God's special creation.

60:00 Man is not simply a sophisticated Ape. Man has a spirit and no other created thing has a spirit. Theistic Evolution is not a valid concept (Theistic Evolution says that God intervenes in the natural order from time to time to alter the chain of created things supernaturally – There are no missing links because God just changes the Ape into Man in one step). Not a valid concept.

01:15:00 We are to be stewards of what God has created.

01:16:00 Acts 17:24 The Lord of heaven and earth does not live in buildings built by the hands of man. He lives in the lives of believers.

01:21:15 Matthew 25:35-45 So how do you serve a God who has no need of anything – You serve him by doing unto others.

01:23:00 We need not argue over the creation; we should instead worship the Creator. Nehemiah 9:5-6 and Revelation 4:11

Heb. 11:3 By faith we understand that the universe was formed at God's command, so that what is seen was not made out of what was visible.

Psa. 90:2 Before the mountains were born
or you brought forth the earth and the world,
from everlasting to everlasting you are God.

John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was with God in the beginning.

John 1:3 Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made.

Heb. 1:1 In the past God spoke to our forefathers through the prophets at many times and in various ways, 2 but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom he made the universe.

Col. 1:16 For by him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things were created by him and for him.

Acts 17:24 "The God who made the world and everything in it is the Lord of heaven and earth and does not live in temples built by hands.

Matt. 25:35 For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in, 36 I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was sick and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me.'

Matt. 25:37 "Then the righteous will answer him, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you something to drink? 38 When did we see you a stranger and invite you in, or needing clothes and clothe you? 39 When did we see you sick or in prison and go to visit you?'

Matt. 25:40 "The King will reply, 'I tell you the truth, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of mine, you did for me.'

Matt. 25:41 “Then he will say to those on his left, ‘Depart from me, you who are cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels. 42 For I was hungry and you gave me nothing to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me nothing to drink, 43 I was a stranger and you did not invite me in, I needed clothes and you did not clothe me, I was sick and in prison and you did not look after me.’

Matt. 25:44 “They also will answer, ‘Lord, when did we see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or needing clothes or sick or in prison, and did not help you?’

Matt. 25:45 “He will reply, ‘I tell you the truth, whatever you did not do for one of the least of these, you did not do for me.’

Neh. 9:5 And the Levites—Jeshua, Kadmiel, Bani, Hashabneiah, Sherebiah, Hodiah, Shebaniah and Pethahiah—said: “Stand up and praise the LORD your God, who is from everlasting to everlasting.”
