# 901108-5     I BELIEVE IN JESUS CHRIST HIS ONLY SON

6:00 John 1:14 The Word became flesh and dwelt among us.

7:50 John 16:7b Unless I go away, the Counselor will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you.

9:50 What does it mean to say that you believe IN ? If it were I believe “that” then it would be a statement of doctrine, but by making it I believe “IN” it establishes a relationship.

10:30 The Hebrew Jeshua, the Greek Jesus is the name meaning the one who saves. Matthew 1:21 and Luke 2:21.

13:00 Christ is not the name but the Title. The expected anointed Messiah.

16:40 1 Chronicles 17:11-14 Old Testament Prophecies about one to come who would be the Father’s true Son. Also, Isaiah 9:6.

48:40 Galatians 4:4-7 Jesus is Thee Son, we are adopted as sons with full inheritance rights.

56:00 Do most Christians have an identity crisis as to who they really are ? They can dispense with that anxiety by understanding their position in Christ and God's family.

John 1:14 The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

John 16:7 But I tell you the truth: It is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Counselor will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you.

Matt. 1:21 She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins.”

Luke 1:29 Mary was greatly troubled at his words and wondered what kind of greeting this might be. 30 But the angel said to her, “Do not be afraid, Mary, you have found favor with God. 31 You will be with child and give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus. 32 He will be great and will

be called the Son of the Most High. The Lord God will give him the throne of his father David, 33 and he will reign over the house of Jacob forever; his kingdom will never end.”

John 3:15 that everyone who believes in him may have eternal life.

John 3:16 “For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. 17 For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him.

Matt. 16:15 “But what about you?” he asked. “Who do you say I am?”

Matt. 16:16 Simon Peter answered, “You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.”

John 3:18 Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because he has not believed in the name of God’s one and only Son.

Gal. 4:4 But when the time had fully come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under law, 5 to redeem those under law, that we might receive the full rights of sons. 6 Because you are sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, the Spirit who calls out, “Abba, Father.” 7 So you are no longer a slave, but a son; and since you are a son, God has made you also an heir.
