910314-5 TO JUDGE THE LIVING AND THE DEAD

- 1:00 Eschatology the portion of Theology that has to do with the Last Things.
 - 5:00 Who is the Judge? The one who comes again.
- 8:00 The last things is not only a reference to chronology it is also the fulfillment of what was predicted.
- 10:00 Hebrews 1:1-2 In these last days (the time between Jesus' 1st coming and his 2nd coming) God the Father has spoken to us not by prophets as in OT, but by his Son.
- 13:50 John 3:17-21 We are already condemned. The only way to remove the condemnation is to accept God's gift of his Son. Jesus is the Judge who examines by light in the darkness.
- 23:30 John 12:44-48 Jesus comes as light, to illumine the path from darkness. He comes 1st as savior, but next time as Judge.
- 29:00 John 5:22 The Father will Judge no one but has entrusted all Judgment to the Son.
- 39:00 Matthew 12:33-37 Jesus own teaching on the Judgment.

42:50 Matthew 13:24-30 God does not want us to judge where a person stands in reference to the Lord. He will make that judgment.

53:00 Matthew 25:31-40 One of the ways we can be servants of God's purpose is to take care of others in their times of need, especially their spiritual needs. Verse 40 - Jesus says: whatever you have done for the least of my brothers you have done for me.

Jesus made sure he joined two concepts: Love of God and Love of others.

01:00:00 Acts 17:31 The judgment day is set, even if not known by any other than the Father Himself. He has placed his Son in the position to be the Judge.

01:06:10 Hebrews 9:27 Man is destined to die once and then the Judgment.

Is it unbelievable that the Judge is the same as the Savior. Only God could work that out.

Heb. 1:1 In the past God spoke to our forefathers through the prophets at many times and in various ways, $\underline{2}$ but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom he made the universe.

John 3:17 For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him. 18 Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because he has not believed in the name of God's one and only Son. 19 This is the verdict: Light has come into the world, but men loved darkness instead of light because their deeds were evil. 20 Everyone who does evil hates the light, and will not come into the light for fear that his deeds will be exposed. 21 But whoever lives by the truth comes into the light, so that it may be seen plainly that what he has done has been done through God."

John 12:44 Then Jesus cried out, "When a man believes in me, he does not believe in me only, but in the one who sent me. 45 When he looks at me, he sees the one who sent me. 46 I have come into the world as a light, so that no one who believes in me should stay in darkness.

John 12:47 "As for the person who hears my words but does not keep them, I do not judge him. For I did not come to judge the world, but to save it. 48 There is a judge for the one who rejects me and does not accept my words; that very word which I spoke will condemn him at the last day.

<u>John 5:22</u> Moreover, the Father judges no one, but has entrusted all judgment to the Son,

Matt. 12:33 "Make a tree good and its fruit will be good, or make a tree bad and its fruit will be bad, for a tree is recognized by its fruit. 34 You brood of vipers, how can you who are evil say anything good? For out of the overflow of the heart the mouth speaks. 35 The good man brings good things out of the good stored up in him, and the evil man brings evil things out of the evil stored up in him. 36 But I tell you that men will have to give account on the day of judgment for every careless word they have spoken. 37 For by your words you will be acquitted, and by your words you will be condemned."

Matt. 13:24 Jesus told them another parable: "The kingdom of heaven is

like a man who sowed good seed in his field. <u>25</u> But while everyone was sleeping, his enemy came and sowed weeds among the wheat, and went away. 26 When the wheat sprouted and formed heads, then the weeds also appeared.

Matt. 13:27 "The owner's servants came to him and said, 'Sir, didn't you sow good seed in your field? Where then did the weeds come from?'

Matt. 13:28 "'An enemy did this,' he replied.

"The servants asked him, 'Do you want us to go and pull them up?'

Matt. 13:29 "'No,' he answered, 'because while you are pulling the weeds, you may root up the wheat with them. <u>30</u> Let both grow together until the harvest. At that time I will tell the harvesters: First collect the weeds and tie them in bundles to be burned; then gather the wheat and bring it into my barn.'"

Matt. 25:31 "When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, he will sit on his throne in heavenly glory. 32 All the nations will be gathered before him, and he will separate the people one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats. 33 He will put the sheep on his right and the goats on his left.

Matt. 25:34 "Then the King will say to those on his right, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father; take your inheritance, the kingdom prepared for you since the creation of the world. 35 For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in, 36 I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was sick and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me.'

Matt. 25:37 "Then the righteous will answer him, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you something to drink? 38 When did we see you a stranger and invite you in, or needing clothes and clothe you? 39 When did we see you sick or in prison and go to visit you?'

Matt. 25:40 "The King will reply, 'I tell you the truth, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of mine, you did for me.'

Acts 17:31 For he has set a day when he will judge the world with justice by the man he has appointed. He has given proof of this to all men by raising him from the dead."

Heb. 9:27 Just as man is destined to die once, and after that to face judgment,
