THE LIFE GOD HONORS

3:00-4:45 1 Samuel 2:27-36 The Lord has both conditional and unconditional promises. Most of the promises from God are of the “Conditional” kind. Deuteronomy 4:29 – If you will seek me you will find me.

4:50 Isaiah 9:6-7 The Lord’s promise of a child who would become Almighty God, Everlasting Father..... This is an example of an unconditional promise.

6:00 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins. Conditional.

7:30 1 Samuel 2:30 The Lord’s response to Eli’s failure to honor Him cancels out the conditional promise made to Aaron and the Priesthood before him. Conditional.

8:50 Jeremiah 18:7-10 Conditional: ..and if at another time I announce that a nation or kingdom is to be built up and planted, and if it does evil in my sight and does not obey me, then I will reconsider the good I had intended to do for it.

Also Conditional: Deuteronomy 11:13-15.

12:20 Terry teaches on the doctrine of Sovereignty. Does God change his mind depending on the actions of man?

21:00 John 5:22-23 Honor to God is part of the conditional relationship.

24:20 Matthew 7:21 and Isaiah 29:13 There is a connection between what we say and our behavior. If we say one thing but live another way we invite God's rebuke. (Hypocrisy)

26:45 Proverbs 3:9 Honor the Lord with your wealth...One of the ways God measures our Honor is in how we handle our material things in reference to him. Does He receive our Firstfruits.

29:00 -35:00 A teaching on the Tithe and giving.

40:00 Psalm 91:14-16 God honors those who honor him.

41:00 Two questions to ask of ourselves – 1.Does our life honor God ? 2. Do you know if God is honoring you ?

1Sam. 2:27 Now a man of God came to Eli and said to him, “This is what the LORD says: ‘Did I not clearly reveal myself to your father’s house when they were in Egypt under Pharaoh? 28 I chose your father out of all the tribes of Israel to be my priest, to go up to my altar, to burn incense, and to wear an ephod in my presence. I also gave your father’s house all the offerings made with fire by the Israelites. 29 Why do you scorn my sacrifice and offering that I prescribed for my dwelling? Why do you honor your sons more than me by fattening yourselves on the choice parts of every offering made by my people Israel?’

1Sam. 2:30 “Therefore the LORD, the God of Israel, declares: ‘I promised that your house and your father’s house would minister before me forever.’ But now the LORD declares: ‘Far be it from me! Those who honor me I will honor, but those who despise me will be disdained. 31 The time is coming when I will cut short your strength and the strength of your father’s house, so that there will not be an old man in your family line 32 and you will see distress in my dwelling. Although good will be done to Israel, in your family line there will never be an old man. 33 Every one of you that I do not cut off from my altar will be spared only to blind your eyes with tears and to grieve your heart, and all your descendants will die in the prime of life.

1Sam. 2:34 “ ‘And what happens to your two sons, Hophni and Phinehas, will be a sign to you—they will both die on the same day. 35 I will raise up for myself a faithful priest, who will do according to what is in my heart and mind. I will firmly establish his house, and he will minister before my anointed one always. 36 Then everyone left in your family line will come and bow down before him for a piece of silver and a crust of bread and plead, “Appoint me to some priestly office so I can have food to eat.” ’”

Deut. 4:29 But if from there you seek the LORD your God, you will find him if you look for him with all your heart and with all your soul.

Is. 9:6 For to us a child is born,
to us a son is given,
and the government will be on his shoulders.

And he will be called
Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God,

Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

Is. 9:7 Of the increase of his government and peace
there will be no end.

He will reign on David's throne
and over his kingdom,
establishing and upholding it
with justice and righteousness
from that time on and forever.

will accomplish this.

1John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our
sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.

Jer. 18:7 If at any time I announce that a nation or kingdom is to be uprooted,
torn down and destroyed, 8 and if that nation I warned repents of its evil, then
I will relent and not inflict on it the disaster I had planned. 9 And if at another
time I announce that a nation or kingdom is to be built up and planted, 10 and
if it does evil in my sight and does not obey me, then I will reconsider the good
I had intended to do for it.

Deut. 11:13 So if you faithfully obey the commands I am giving you
today—to love the LORD your God and to serve him with all your heart and with
all your soul— 14 then I will send rain on your land in its season, both autumn
and spring rains, so that you may gather in your grain, new wine and oil. 15 I
will provide grass in the fields for your cattle, and you will eat and be satisfied.

John 5:22 Moreover, the Father judges no one, but has entrusted all judgment
to the Son, 23 that all may honor the Son just as they honor the Father. He who
does not honor the Son does not honor the Father, who sent him.

Matt. 7:21 “Not everyone who says to me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ will enter the
kingdom of heaven, but only he who does the will of my Father who is in
heaven.

Is. 29:13 The Lord says:

“These people come near to me with their mouth
and honor me with their lips,
but their hearts are far from me.

Their worship of me
is made up only of rules taught by men.

Prov. 3:9 Honor the LORD with your wealth,
with the firstfruits of all your crops;

Psa. 91:14 “Because he loves me,” says the LORD, “I will rescue him;
I will protect him, for he acknowledges my name.

15 He will call upon me, and I will answer him;
I will be with him in trouble,
I will deliver him and honor him.

16 With long life will I satisfy him
and show him my salvation.”
