GOD'S LAST MESSAGES TO MAN

1:20 Revelation 22:7-20 Jesus gives His four last messages to man. 1. Last Proclamation (Verses 13 & 16) I am the Beginning and the End – I am the root of David , the bright Morning Star. 2. Last Promise (Verses 7, 12, 20) Behold I am coming soon. 3. Last Prayer (Verse 20) Even so Come Lord Jesus. 4. Last Provision (Verse 17) Come whoever is thirsty and let him drink the water of life (The Spirit).

7:30 Ephesians 1:9-23 God has made known the mystery of His will: that all will unite around Jesus Christ in unity and significance.

13:30 1 Chronicles 17:11-14 There is predicted one to come who will have a kingdom and throne forever. A promise to David.

16:20 Jeremiah 23:5-6 400 years after David has died the prophet reminds Israel that the Branch of David will come and his name will be The Lord of Righteousness.

17:30 Isaiah 9:6-7 700 years before Christ the prophet predicts a child will be born who shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father.

18:30 Luke 1:31-33 One to be born for the Throne of David whose kingdom will never end.

19:30 Isaiah 11:1 A shoot from the stump of Jesse and a branch out of his roots.

23:30 Teaching about the second coming of Jesus. More than 100 predictions in Old Testament but even more astonishing is that there are only two passages in the New Testament regarding the first coming but more than 100 about the second coming.

26:30 Matthew 24:3-8 Jesus teaches about the signs of the beginning of the "birth pains" associated with the 2nd coming.

28:00 2 Timothy 3:1-5 A description of the activity of people in society in the last of the last days. Godlessness, lovers of money etc.

31:00 Matthew 24:36-44 and Matthew 25:13 No one knows the day or the hour of the second coming.

33:20 Titus 2:11-14 What shall we do as we prepare for the second coming? Live Godly lives

34:00 2 Peter 3:11 Live Godly lives.

36:00 John 4:10 Jesus teaches that the Holy Spirit is essential for us and he uses teachings related to the Living Water to make the point. Also Matthew 7:37-39.

40:00 A summation of the last of the four last messages from Jesus. 1. Last Proclamation, 2. Last Promise, 3. Last Prayer, 4. Last Provision.

Rev. 22:7 And behold, I am coming soon.”

Blessed is he who keeps the words of the prophecy of this book.

Rev. 22:8 I John am he who heard and saw these things. And when I heard and saw them, I fell down to worship at the feet of the angel who showed them to me; 9 but he said to me, “You must not do that! I am a fellow servant with you and your brethren the prophets, and with those who keep the words of this book. Worship God.”

Rev. 22:10 And he said to me, “Do not seal up the words of the prophecy of this book, for the time is near. 11 Let the evildoer still do evil, and the filthy still be filthy, and the righteous still do right, and the holy still be holy.”

Rev. 22:12 “Behold, I am coming soon, bringing my recompense, to repay every one for what he has done. 13 I am the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, the beginning and the end.”

Rev. 22:14 Blessed are those who wash their robes, that they may have the right to the tree of life and that they may enter the city by the gates. 15 Outside are the dogs and sorcerers and fornicators and murderers and idolaters, and every one who loves and practices falsehood.

Rev. 22:16 “I Jesus have sent my angel to you with this testimony for the churches. I am the root and the offspring of David, the bright morning star.”

Rev. 22:17 The Spirit and the Bride say, “Come.” And let him who hears say, “Come.” And let him who is thirsty come, let him who desires take the water of life without price.

Rev. 22:18 I warn every one who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: if any one adds to them, God will add to him the plagues described in this book, 19 and if any one takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God will take away his share in the tree of life and in the holy city, which are described in this book.

Rev. 22:20 He who testifies to these things says, “Surely I am coming soon.” Amen. Come, Lord Jesus!

Eph. 1:9 For he has made known to us in all wisdom and insight the mystery of his will, according to his purpose which he set forth in Christ 10 as a plan for the fulness of time, to unite all things in him, things in heaven and things on earth.

Eph. 1:11 In him, according to the purpose of him who accomplishes all things according to the counsel of his will, 12 we who first hoped in Christ have been destined and appointed to live for the praise of his glory. 13 In him you also, who have heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and have believed in him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit, 14 which is the guarantee of our inheritance until we acquire possession of it, to the praise of his glory.

Eph. 1:15 For this reason, because I have heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love toward all the saints, 16 I do not cease to give thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers, 17 that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give you a spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of him, 18 having the eyes of your hearts enlightened, that you may know what is the hope to which he has called you, what are the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints, 19 and what is the immeasurable greatness of his power in us who believe, according to the working of his great might 20 which he accomplished in Christ when he raised him from the dead and made him sit at his right hand in the heavenly places, 21 far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and above every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come; 22 and he has put all things under his feet and has made him the head over all things for the church, 23 which is his body, the fulness of him who fills all in all.

1Chr. 17:11 When your days are fulfilled to go to be with your fathers, I will raise up your offspring after you, one of your own sons, and I will establish his kingdom. 12 He shall build a house for me, and I will establish his throne for ever. 13 I will be his father, and he shall be my son; I will not take my steadfast love from him, as I took it from him who was before you, 14 but I will confirm him in my house and in my kingdom for ever and his throne shall be established for ever.”

Jer. 23:5 “Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will raise up for

David a righteous Branch, and he shall reign as king and deal wisely, and shall execute justice and righteousness in the land. 6 In his days Judah will be saved, and Israel will dwell securely. And this is the name by which he will be called: 'The LORD is our righteousness.'

Is. 9:6 For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government will be upon his shoulder, and his name will be called "Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace." 7 Of the increase of his government and of peace there will be no end, upon the throne of David, and over his kingdom, to establish it, and to uphold it with justice and with righteousness from this time forth and for evermore. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will do this.

Luke 1:31 And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus. 32 He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Most High; and the Lord God will give to him the throne of his father David, 33 and he will reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there will be no end."

Is. 11:1 There shall come forth a shoot from the stump of Jesse, and a branch shall grow out of his roots.

Matt. 24:3 As he sat on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to him privately, saying, "Tell us, when will this be, and what will be the sign of your coming and of the close of the age?" 4 And Jesus answered them, "Take heed that no one leads you astray. 5 For many will come in my name, saying, 'I am the Christ,' and they will lead many astray. 6 And you will hear of wars and rumors of wars; see that you are not alarmed; for this must take place, but the end is not yet. 7 For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom, and there will be famines and earthquakes in various places: 8 all this is but the beginning of the birth-pangs.

2Tim. 3:1 But understand this, that in the last days there will come times of stress. 2 For men will be lovers of self, lovers of money, proud, arrogant, abusive, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, unholy, 3 inhuman, implacable, slanderers, profligates, fierce, haters of good, 4 treacherous, reckless, swollen with conceit, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, 5 holding the form of religion but denying the power of it. Avoid such people.

Matt. 24:36 “But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, nor the Son, but the Father only. 37 As were the days of Noah, so will be the coming of the Son of man. 38 For as in those days before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day when Noah entered the ark, 39 and they did not know until the flood came and swept them all away, so will be the coming of the Son of man. 40 Then two men will be in the field; one is taken and one is left. 41 Two women will be grinding at the mill; one is taken and one is left. 42 Watch therefore, for you do not know on what day your Lord is coming. 43 But know this, that if the householder had known in what part of the night the thief was coming, he would have watched and would not have let his house be broken into. 44 Therefore you also must be ready; for the Son of man is coming at an hour you do not expect.

Matt. 25:13 Watch therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour.

Titus 2:11 For the grace of God has appeared for the salvation of all men, 12 training us to renounce irreligion and worldly passions, and to live sober, upright, and godly lives in this world, 13 awaiting our blessed hope, the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, 14 who gave himself for us to redeem us from all iniquity and to purify for himself a people of his own who are zealous for good deeds.

2Pet. 3:11 Since all these things are thus to be dissolved, what sort of persons ought you to be in lives of holiness and godliness,

John 4:10 Jesus answered her, “If you knew the gift of God, and who it is that is saying to you, ‘Give me a drink,’ you would have asked him, and he would have given you living water.”
