08-307-6 A BLAMELESS HEART

1:45 2 Chronicles 16:9 God is searching for one who's heart is blameless, so that He can demonstrate the glory that attends His presence. The Holy Spirit can show, through our obedience, that we are overcomers.

12:00 1 Samuel 16:7 Man looks on the outward appearance of a man, but the Lord looks on the Heart (The center and summation of the essence of the man – soul and spirit – mind, thoughts, will, emotions, conscience).

15:50 Our inner being (Heart) is fully known to God. "Unto you Lord to whom all hearts are open, all desires known, and from whom no secrets are hid; Cleanse the thoughts of our hearts by the inspiration of thy Holy Spirit, that we may perfectly love thee, and worthily magnify thy holy Name; through Christ our Lord.

16:50 1 Chronicles 28:9 The Lord searches all hearts and understands every motive and thought. God is concerned with how we deal with our inner self.

21:20 If we are to be a channel of His Grace we need to be honest about our inner being.

23:15 Matthew 15:18-20 It is from the heart of man that he is either clean or unclean.

25:50 Acts 13:22 David was a man after the very heart of God.

31:20 Psalm 51:1-19 David knew the condition of his heart and its' evilness, so he cried out to the lord to make him a a new and clean heart. That should be our constant prayer.

33:00 Verse 3-4 A blameless heart is not one without sin, yet one that knows what to do about sin. "For I know my transgressions, and my sin is always before me. Against you, you only, have I sinned.....

35:50 Ezekiel 36:26 The Lord promises that one day he will remove the heart of stone.

37:00 Psalm 51: 10-12 Create in me a new heart...restore the Joy of your salvation. The first thing to disappear from us, in our rebellion to God, is Joy. The fruit of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23) only flourishes in the garden of obedience. His Joy is a kingdom Joy, not something to be squandered on our personal desires.

44:00 What is separating us from the fullness of the Lord. Confess it and seek a clean heart.

<u>2Chr. 16:9</u> For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to show his might in behalf of those whose heart is blameless toward him. You have done foolishly in this; for from now on you will have wars."

<u>1Sam. 16:7</u> But the LORD said to Samuel, "Do not look on his appearance or on the height of his stature, because I have rejected him; for the LORD sees not as man sees; man looks on the outward appearance, but the LORD looks on the heart."

<u>1Chr. 28:9</u> "And you, Solomon my son, know the God of your father, and serve him with a whole heart and with a willing mind; for the LORD searches all hearts, and understands every plan and thought. If you seek him, he will be found by you; but if you forsake him, he will cast you off for ever.

<u>Matt. 15:18</u> But what comes out of the mouth proceeds from the heart, and this defiles a man. <u>19</u> For out of the heart come evil thoughts, murder, adultery, fornication, theft, false witness, slander. <u>20</u> These are what defile a man; but to eat with unwashed hands does not defile a man."

<u>Acts 13:22</u> And when he had removed him, he raised up David to be their king; of whom he testified and said, 'I have found in David the son of Jesse a man after my heart, who will do all my will.'

<u>Psa. 51:1</u> Have mercy on me, O God, according to thy steadfast love; according to thy abundant mercy blot out my transgressions. <u>2</u> Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin! <u>3</u> For I know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me. <u>4</u> Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, and done that which is evil in thy sight, so that thou art justified in thy sentence and blameless in thy judgment. <u>5</u> Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity, and in sin did my mother conceive me. <u>6</u> Behold, thou desirest truth in the inward being; therefore teach me wisdom in my secret heart. <u>7</u> Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean; wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow. <u>8</u> Fill me with joy and gladness; let the bones which thou hast broken rejoice. <u>9</u> Hide thy face from my sins, and blot out all my iniquities. <u>10</u> Create in me a clean heart, O God, and put a new and right spirit within me. <u>11</u> Cast me not away from thy presence, and take not thy holy Spirit from me. <u>12</u> Restore to me the joy of thy salvation, and uphold me with a willing spirit. <u>13</u> Then I will teach transgressors thy ways, and sinners will return to thee. <u>14</u> Deliver me

from bloodguiltiness, O God, thou God of my salvation, and my tongue will sing aloud of thy deliverance. <u>15</u> O Lord, open thou my lips, and my mouth shall show forth thy praise. <u>16</u> For thou hast no delight in sacrifice; were I to give a burnt offering, thou wouldst not be pleased. <u>17</u> The sacrifice acceptable to God is a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, thou wilt not despise. <u>18</u> Do good to Zion in thy good pleasure; rebuild the walls of Jerusalem, <u>19</u> then wilt thou delight in right sacrifices, in burnt offerings and whole burnt offerings; then bulls will be offered on thy altar.

Ezek. 36:26 A new heart I will give you, and a new spirit I will put within you; and I will take out of your flesh the heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh.

<u>Gal. 5:22</u> But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <u>23</u> gentleness, self-control; against such there is no law.
