17-010-6 THE KIND OF PERSON GOD USES

1:00 Terry sets up the teaching by recalling the Exodus events. Deliverance from bondage.

2:30 We are as the Israelites, set free to be able to serve. Saved to Serve.

11:30 Ephesians 2:10 "For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do".

God has been preparing you long before you acknowledged it.

18:20 There is a Godly destiny for each one of us and we should be responding to that calling.

19:45 John 17:4 Jesus knew that the only way he could honor and glorify the Father was to finish (accomplish) the work that had been set before him. The way to glorify God is to walk in the good work he has prepared for you to do.

24:10 It is in the fulfillment of His plan for you that the Blessings of God and the Joy of God will be felt.

25:00 Exodus 3:10 and 4:10 A lesson from the life of Moses to make the point that two things should be considered:

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1. What is God's plan for you ?, 2. How will it be accomplished ? So many times we look at our limitations and choose not to move. If God calls He will equip.

32:20 Jeremiah 1:4-5 Understand that God has gone before us and when He calls he has already prepared you to begin the good works. God does not call the fit – he fits the called.

37:45 God's purpose for you will remain hidden if your response is always procrastination. The key to further illumination is a willingness to yield to His will. You first say you are willing and then He will show you what.

Don't succumb to the devil's technique of making you think of yourself as unworthy. Look at the characters that God used to further His kingdom (Moses, David, Abraham, Paul etc.)

45:00 Don't say you don't know God's plan for your life. Ignorance is no obstacle for God but willfulness is.

47:40 Psalm 139: 12-16 God created you with a plan in mind and you need to discover it.

50:30 Matthew 25:14-30 Teaching on God's desire for you and your responsibility of being a good steward of what he has given to you as gifts (talents) to accomplish His plan. Use the gifts to further His purpose for you. What He expects of us is directly related to what he has equipped you for. Don't compare yourself to others. God uses anyone who will. He will take care of the "can" and the enabling.

Eph. 2:10 For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

John 17:4 I have brought you glory on earth by completing the work you gave me to do.

Ex. 3:10 So now, go. I am sending you to Pharaoh to bring my people the Israelites out of Egypt."

Ex. 4:10 Moses said to the LORD, "O Lord, I have never been eloquent, neither in the past nor since you have spoken to your servant. I am slow of speech and tongue."

Jer. 1:4 The word of the LORD came to me, saying,

Jer. 1:5 "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I set you apart; I appointed you as a prophet to the nations."

Psa. 139:12 even the darkness will not be dark to you; the night will shine like the day, for darkness is as light to you.

Psa. 139:13 For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb.

14 I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well.

15 My frame was not hidden from you when I was made in the secret place.

16 When I was woven together in the depths of the earth, your eyes saw my unformed body. All the days ordained for me were written in your book before one of them came to be.

Matt. 25:14 “Again, it will be like a man going on a journey, who called his servants and entrusted his property to them. 15 To one he gave five talents of money, to another two talents, and to another one talent, each according to his ability. Then he went on his journey. 16 The man who had received the five talents went at once and put his money to work and gained five more. 17 So also, the one with the two talents gained two more. 18 But the man who had received the one talent went off, dug a hole in the ground and hid his master’s money.

Matt. 25:19 “After a long time the master of those servants returned and settled accounts with them. 20 The man who had received the five talents brought the other five. ‘Master,’ he said, ‘you entrusted me with five talents. See, I have gained five more.’

Matt. 25:21 “His master replied, ‘Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things. Come and share your master’s happiness!’

Matt. 25:22 “The man with the two talents also came. ‘Master,’ he said, ‘you entrusted me with two talents; see, I have gained two more.’

Matt. 25:23 “His master replied, ‘Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things. Come and share your master’s happiness!’

Matt. 25:24 “Then the man who had received the one talent came. ‘Master,’ he said, ‘I knew that you are a hard man, harvesting where you have not sown and gathering where you have not scattered seed. 25 So I was afraid and went out and hid your talent in the ground. See, here is what belongs to you.’

Matt. 25:26 “His master replied, ‘You wicked, lazy servant! So you knew that I harvest where I have not sown and gather where I have not scattered seed? 27 Well then, you should have put my money on deposit with the bankers, so that when I returned I would have received it back with interest.

Matt. 25:28 “ ‘Take the talent from him and give it to the one who has the

ten talents. 29 For everyone who has will be given more, and he will have an abundance. Whoever does not have, even what he has will be taken from him. 30 And throw that worthless servant outside, into the darkness, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.'
