## # 19-030-6 CALLED TO A HOLY CALLING

- :30 Romans 8:28 Called according to God's purpose. Two parts **1**. The Called, **2**. Called by God. We are called out of something into something.
- 3:00 What are the implications to those who are called. There are 4 aspects:
- 4:00 Hebrews 3:1 God calls we respond (or not). Implication # **1** It is a heavenly calling. God initiates it.
- 8:30 2 Timothy 1:8-9 Implication # **2** It is a Holy calling. Verse 9 "who has called us to a holy life-not because of anything we have done but because of his own purpose and grace. Implication # **3** not because of anything of our merit, but by his grace.
- 14:10 Implication # **4** It is according to his own purpose.
- 15:30 God does not exist for our sake we exist for his sake.
- 17:40 John 17:4 God the Father is Glorified when we finish the work he has prepared for us to do.

- 19:00 What issues from a life submitted to the call of God?
- 19:10 1 Corinthians 1:9 Issue # **1** Fellowship with the Son. Also 1 John 1:3 The Father and the Son and the other brothers in Christ.
- 21:00 We are to be members one to another. Individual salvation alone is only half of the story.
- 27:25 1 Thessalonians 4:3&7 Issue # **2** We are to grow into a holy life sanctified.
- 31:50 Galatians 5:13 Issue # **3** We are called to be free. We are not of the law on tablets; instead we are to understand God's purpose in our very own hearts.
- 33:30 1 Corinthians 7:15 Issue # **4** Called to live in Peace. Especially related to the marriage relationship.
- 36:50 2 Thessalonians 2:14 Issue # **5** called to share in the Glory of the Lord however it must be understood that it is a reflective glory. He is the light, we like the moon can reflect his light to others, but he is the source.
  - 38:50 We are called of God to His Purpose.

- Rom. 8:28 And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.
- Heb. 3:1 Therefore, holy brothers, who share in the heavenly calling, fix your thoughts on Jesus, the apostle and high priest whom we confess.
- 2Tim. 1:8 So do not be ashamed to testify about our Lord, or ashamed of me his prisoner. But join with me in suffering for the gospel, by the power of God, 9 who has saved us and called us to a holy life—not because of anything we have done but because of his own purpose and grace. This grace was given us in Christ Jesus before the beginning of time,
- John 17:4 I have brought you glory on earth by completing the work you gave me to do.
- 1Cor. 1:9 God, who has called you into fellowship with his Son Jesus Christ our Lord, is faithful.
- 1John 1:3 We proclaim to you what we have seen and heard, so that you also may have fellowship with us. And our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son, Jesus Christ.
- 1Th. 4:3 It is God's will that you should be sanctified: that you should avoid sexual immorality; 4 that each of you should learn to control his own body in a way that is holy and honorable, 5 not in passionate lust like the heathen, who do not know God; 6 and that in this matter no one should wrong his brother or take advantage of him. The Lord will punish men for all such sins, as we have already told you and warned you. 7 For God did not call us to be impure, but to live a holy life.
- Gal. 5:13 You, my brothers, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the sinful nature; rather, serve one another in love.
- 1Cor. 7:15 But if the unbeliever leaves, let him do so. A believing man or woman is not bound in such circumstances; God has called us to live in peace.
- <u>2Th. 2:14</u> He called you to this through our gospel, that you might share in the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.
