:30 Proverbs 3:5-6 “Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make your paths straight”

3:30 Matthew 6:33 Seek first his kingdom and all the other things in life will find their proper place. Teaching on the Biblical use of the term Kingdom of God.

5:50 Living for doing God’s will. He knows better than we do the best course in life.

8:00 Walking in His will. Terry uses an analogy to a seeing his life alongside a stream.

11:00 James 1:5-8 Don’t block his will by your own willfulness - Doing your own thing. We cannot flourish by leading a double minded life.

14:30 Proverbs 3:5-6 See quote at :30. **Trust** - To commit your life to first believe on him and then act on that belief. God will show you his plan for your life.

17:20 **Heart** – In the fullness of our being.

18:00 Do not lean on your own understanding. Don't be taking your guidance from your mind if it is not informed by the Holy Spirit.

22:00 Acknowledge Him. The result of knowing that you really belong to him.

24:30 He will direct your path. God's guidance is not a matter of knowledge as to what his will is – it is not a knowledge issue but a willfulness issue. Whose will ?

27:00 The question becomes – Do you believe God will keep his promises ?

32:00 As with Jesus – the only way to glorify God is to finish the work he has prepared for you to do.

Matt. 6:33 But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things shall be yours as well.
