950727-8 FROM GENERATION TO GENERATION

2:30 1 Corinthians 10:1-13 – with special emphasis on verses 6 and 11. Teaching on how God reached into the lives of his people in profoundly miraculous ways and stressed the need for His people to remember, and pass along to the generations that follow. These things (verses 6 & 11) are examples to God's people so that they walk in his ways.

We need to learn from the experiences of those who have gone before us. That is not the protocol for today's society, but it is God's formula for the continued maturity of his faithful.

4:20 Luke 15:17 The prodigal son remembered (came to his senses) how it had been under the care of his father (in good relationship) and so he returned to him whom he had known.

12:40 Judges 2:10 Terry gives a short teaching about Moses' leadership and then the passing of the leadership to Joshua. Verse 10 is discussed again beginning at 18:40.

17:20 Joshua 24:31 and Judges 2:7 The Israelites pretty much served the Lord during Joshua's time and the time of the elders shortly after. (Joshua led for about 50 years. First in the conquering of the promised land which was inhabited by 7 nations. Then the supervision of the division of the land among the 11 tribes).

18:40 Judges 2:10 “ After that whole generation had been gathered to their fathers, another generation grew up, who neither knew the Lord nor what He had done for Israel”.

21:00 There is often a lust for the supernatural these days, especially among the charismatic community.

24:30 Manna – “What is it” ?

28:10 2 Chronicles 15:3 “ For a long time Israel was without the true God, without a teaching Priest and without the Law”.

Teaching about the true God and the Law.

38:35 Teaching about – without a teaching Priest (one of Terry's catalysts in accepting the call to the St. Paul's, Darien).

41:00 1 John 1:1-3 John relates that he bears witness to a God he knows up close and personal. We can only be effective witnesses if we know the Lord up close and personal.

45:00 We are in very dark days – don't lament but RAISE THE TORCH.

45:50 Psalm 48:12-14 “ That you may tell them to the next generation” Not limited to a chronological generation, but a whole new generation of well grounded Christians who are prepared to KNOW CHRIST AND TO MAKE HIM KNOWN. We can't export what we don't have.

47:10 Joel 1:1-3 Although this reference is not related to the Exodus years it stresses the importance of telling others how God has worked in their lives, and the need to pass it down.

1Cor. 10:1 For I do not want you to be ignorant of the fact, brothers, that our forefathers were all under the cloud and that they all passed through the sea. 2 They were all baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea. 3 They all ate the same spiritual food 4 and drank the same spiritual drink; for they drank from the spiritual rock that accompanied them, and that rock was Christ. 5 Nevertheless, God was not pleased with most of them; their bodies were scattered over the desert.

1Cor. 10:6 Now these things occurred as examples to keep us from setting our hearts on evil things as they did. 7 Do not be idolaters, as some of them were; as it is written: “The people sat down to eat and drink and got up to indulge in pagan revelry.” 8 We should not commit sexual immorality, as some of them did—and in one day twenty-three thousand of them died. 9 We should not test the Lord, as some of them did—and were killed by snakes. 10 And do not grumble, as some of them did—and were killed by the destroying angel.

1Cor. 10:11 These things happened to them as examples and were written down as warnings for us, on whom the fulfillment of the ages has come. 12 So, if you think you are standing firm, be careful that you don’t fall! 13 No temptation has seized you except what is common to man. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can stand up under it.

Luke 15:17 “When he came to his senses, he said, ‘How many of my father’s hired men have food to spare, and here I am starving to death!’

Judg. 2:10 After that whole generation had been gathered to their fathers, another generation grew up, who knew neither the LORD nor what he had done for Israel.

Josh. 24:31 Israel served the LORD throughout the lifetime of Joshua and of the elders who outlived him and who had experienced everything the LORD had done for Israel.

Judg. 2:7 The people served the LORD throughout the lifetime of Joshua and of the elders who outlived him and who had seen all the great things the LORD had

done for Israel.

Judg. 2:8 Joshua son of Nun, the servant of the LORD, died at the age of a hundred and ten. 9 And they buried him in the land of his inheritance, at Timnath Heres in the hill country of Ephraim, north of Mount Gaash.

Judg. 2:10 After that whole generation had been gathered to their fathers, another generation grew up, who knew neither the LORD nor what he had done for Israel.

2Chr. 15:3 For a long time Israel was without the true God, without a priest to teach and without the law.

1John 1:1 That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked at and our hands have touched—this we proclaim concerning the Word of life. 2 The life appeared; we have seen it and testify to it, and we proclaim to you the eternal life, which was with the Father and has appeared to us. 3 We proclaim to you what we have seen and heard, so that you also may have fellowship with us. And our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son, Jesus Christ.

Psa. 48:12 Walk about Zion, go around her,
count her towers,
13 consider well her ramparts,
view her citadels,
that you may tell of them to the next generation.
14 For this God is our God for ever and ever;
he will be our guide even to the end.

Joel 1:1 The word of the LORD that came to Joel son of Pethuel.
