# 05-180-11

### WILL GOD INDEED DWELL WITH MAN ON EARTH

00: -→ Explanation of how the series “Great Questions of the Bible” came to be. Terry has determined that there are 3294 Questions which appear in the Bible. 2272 Questions in the Old Testament and 1022 in the New Testament.

9:40 2 Chronicles 6:18 “Will God indeed dwell with man on earth”? The bible is not, as supposed by many, the story of man’s quest for God. It is rather, the story of how God progressively reveals himself as making it possible for man to reestablish his relationship with him.

14:00 Exodus 29:43-46 God establishes his presence among his people, so that they will know that he is their Lord.

17:10 Exodus 40:34-35 God’s glory completely filled the Tabernacle.

18:10 1 Chronicles 17:1, 11-14 David wishes to build the Lord a more suitable dwelling (rather than the tent). God tells David that it is not he who will build the temple but one of his sons. God says of the Son that he will be his father and his kingdom will last forever.

# 05-180-11 Cont'd

22:35 Jeremiah 23:5-6 A Predictive prophecy (approximately 400 years after David had died, and 600 years before Jesus was born), which said that one of David's descendants who will be a righteous "Branch" called "The Lord of Our Righteousness".

24:20 Zechariah 6:12-13 The one whose name is the "Branch" will be both a King and a Priest, in perfect harmony.

27:00 2 Chronicles 7:1-2 The glory of the Lord filled the Temple (this time it is not the tent but the real temple of Solomon).

27:40 Matthew 1:20-23 Whereas God had previously been unapproachable in his dwelling place, now, we are told that He will come among us in the flesh.

29:10 John 2:19-21 Jesus now discloses that He will be the temple (the dwelling place of God).

30:30 Ephesians 2:19-22 God's people (the body of Christ – the church) will be the dwelling place of God – His Temple - held together by the cornerstone.

33:30 1 Corinthians 3:16-17 We are the Temple of God, by virtue of the Holy Spirit dwelling in us.

34:25 1 Corinthians 6:19-20 There is to be a glory about us, beyond our frail human body.

35:50 1 Peter 2:4-5, 9-10 You are a brick in the full Temple of God and you are part of the Royal Priesthood of all believers.

37:20 Revelation 21:3 Now the dwelling place of God is with men, and He will live with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God.

39:20 First God above us, then God with us (Immanuel), and now God within us (The Holy Spirit). We are the Temple.

2Chr. 6:18 “But will God dwell indeed with man on the earth? Behold, heaven and the highest heaven cannot contain thee; how much less this house which I have built!

Ex. 29:43 There I will meet with the people of Israel, and it shall be sanctified by my glory; 44 I will consecrate the tent of meeting and the altar; Aaron also and his sons I will consecrate, to serve me as priests. 45 And I will dwell among the people of Israel, and will be their God. 46 And they shall know that I am the LORD their God, who brought them forth out of the land of Egypt that I might dwell among them; I am the LORD their God.

Ex. 40:34 Then the cloud covered the tent of meeting, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle. 35 And Moses was not able to enter the tent of meeting, because the cloud abode upon it, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle.

1Chr. 17:1 Now when David dwelt in his house, David said to Nathan the prophet, “Behold, I dwell in a house of cedar, but the ark of the covenant of the LORD is under a tent.”

1Chr. 17:11 When your days are fulfilled to go to be with your fathers, I will raise up your offspring after you, one of your own sons, and I will establish his kingdom. 12 He shall build a house for me, and I will establish his throne for ever. 13 I will be his father, and he shall be my son; I will not take my steadfast love from him, as I took it from him who was before you, 14 but I will confirm him in my house and in my kingdom for ever and his throne shall be established for ever.”

Jer. 23:5 “Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will raise up for David a righteous Branch, and he shall reign as king and deal wisely, and shall execute justice and righteousness in the land. 6 In his days Judah will be saved, and Israel will dwell securely. And this is the name by which he will be called: ‘The LORD is our righteousness.’

Zech. 6:12 and say to him, ‘Thus says the LORD of hosts, “Behold, the man whose name is the Branch: for he shall grow up in his place, and he shall build the temple of the LORD. 13 It is he who shall build the temple of the LORD, and shall bear royal honor, and shall sit and rule upon his throne. And there

shall be a priest by his throne, and peaceful understanding shall be between them both.”

2Chr. 7:1 When Solomon had ended his prayer, fire came down from heaven and consumed the burnt offering and the sacrifices, and the glory of the LORD filled the temple. 2 And the priests could not enter the house of the LORD, because the glory of the LORD filled the LORD’s house.

Matt. 1:20 But as he considered this, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, “Joseph, son of David, do not fear to take Mary your wife, for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit; 21 she will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins.” 22 All this took place to fulfil what the Lord had spoken by the prophet: 23 “Behold, a virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and his name shall be called Emmanuel” (which means, God with us).

John 2:19 Jesus answered them, “Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up.” 20 The Jews then said, “It has taken forty-six years to build this temple, and will you raise it up in three days?” 21 But he spoke of the temple of his body.

Eph. 2:19 So then you are no longer strangers and sojourners, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, 20 built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone, 21 in whom the whole structure is joined together and grows into a holy temple in the Lord; 22 in whom you also are built into it for a dwelling place of God in the Spirit.

1Cor. 3:16 Do you not know that you are God’s temple and that God’s Spirit dwells in you? 17 If any one destroys God’s temple, God will destroy him. For God’s temple is holy, and that temple you are.

1Cor. 6:19 Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, which you have from God? You are not your own; 20 you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body.

1Pet. 2:4 Come to him, to that living stone, rejected by men but in God’s sight chosen and precious; 5 and like living stones be yourselves built into a

spiritual house, to be a holy priesthood, to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.

1Pet. 2:9 But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's own people, that you may declare the wonderful deeds of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. 10 Once you were no people but now you are God's people; once you had not received mercy but now you have received mercy.

Rev. 21:3 and I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Behold, the dwelling of God is with men. He will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself will be with them;
