WHERE IS HE WHO HAS BEEN BORN KING OF THE JEWS

:50 Matthew 2:1-12 Verse 2 contains the question being explored. This is the story of the visit of the wise men.

6:30 Genesis 49:10 The symbol of kingship (the scepter) will stay with the line of Judah and the “one” who is to come will claim it rightly.

7:50 1 Chronicles 17:11-14 A descendant from David will have a kingdom that will last forever. God says he will be his Son.

10:00 Jeremiah 23:5-6 A righteous Branch from David, named The Lord is our Righteousness.

11:35 Isaiah 9:6-7 One will come who will be called Mighty God, Everlasting Father and He will reign forever. This and several other passages may have been known by the wise men.

13:50 Micah 5:2 The prophecy stipulates that a ruler will come whose origins are from old and from ancient times. He will come from Bethlehem Ephrathah. (There were two Behtlehems).

15:40 Joshua 19:15 There is a reference to the town of Bethlehem, but it is the other Bethlehem in Zebulun. (Galilee)

15:40 1 Samuel 17:12 "Now David was the son of an Ephrathite named Jesse, who was from Bethlehem in Judah". The word Bethlehem means "House of Bread".

17:00 Resume teaching from Matthew 2.

25:00 a contrast between Matthew 2:6 and Micah 5:2 explained.

28:40 There is a small portion of the audio missing at this point.

30:00 The story of the Magi represents the manifestation of Christ to the Gentiles - beyond just the Messiah of the Jews.

30:40 Luke 2:29-32 Simeon took the baby Jesus in his arms and declared that He was a light for revelation to the Gentiles.

32:20 John 1:14 The Glory of the Lord – full of grace and truth. Repeated by Peter. 2 Peter 1:16-18.

34:00 John 17:1-5 Jesus prays to the Father and gives the model that is for all of us. We glorify the Father by completing the work and purpose he has prepared for us to do.

Ephesians 2:10 – For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

Matt. 2:1 Now when Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of Herod the king, behold, wise men from the East came to Jerusalem, saying, 2 “Where is he who has been born king of the Jews? For we have seen his star in the East, and have come to worship him.” 3 When Herod the king heard this, he was troubled, and all Jerusalem with him; 4 and assembling all the chief priests and scribes of the people, he inquired of them where the Christ was to be born. 5 They told him, “In Bethlehem of Judea; for so it is written by the prophet: 6 ‘And you, O Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, are by no means least among the rulers of Judah; for from you shall come a ruler who will govern my people Israel.’”

Matt. 2:7 Then Herod summoned the wise men secretly and ascertained from them what time the star appeared; 8 and he sent them to Bethlehem, saying, “Go and search diligently for the child, and when you have found him bring me word, that I too may come and worship him.” 9 When they had heard the king they went their way; and lo, the star which they had seen in the East went before them, till it came to rest over the place where the child was. 10 When they saw the star, they rejoiced exceedingly with great joy; 11 and going into the house they saw the child with Mary his mother, and they fell down and worshiped him. Then, opening their treasures, they offered him gifts, gold and frankincense and myrrh. 12 And being warned in a dream not to return to Herod, they departed to their own country by another way.

Gen. 49:10 The scepter shall not depart from Judah, nor the ruler’s staff from between his feet, until he comes to whom it belongs; and to him shall be the obedience of the peoples.

1Chr. 17:11 When your days are fulfilled to go to be with your fathers, I will raise up your offspring after you, one of your own sons, and I will establish his kingdom. 12 He shall build a house for me, and I will establish his throne for ever. 13 I will be his father, and he shall be my son; I will not take my steadfast love from him, as I took it from him who was before you, 14 but I will confirm him in my house and in my kingdom for ever and his throne shall be established for ever.”

Jer. 23:5 “Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will raise up for David a righteous Branch, and he shall reign as king and deal wisely, and shall execute justice and righteousness in the land. 6 In his days Judah will be

saved, and Israel will dwell securely. And this is the name by which he will be called: 'The LORD is our righteousness.'

Is. 9:6 For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government will be upon his shoulder, and his name will be called "Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace." 7 Of the increase of his government and of peace there will be no end, upon the throne of David, and over his kingdom, to establish it, and to uphold it with justice and with righteousness from this time forth and for evermore. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will do this.

Mic. 5:2 But you, O Bethlehem Ephrathah, who are little to be among the clans of Judah, from you shall come forth for me one who is to be ruler in Israel, whose origin is from of old, from ancient days.

Josh. 19:15 and Kattath, Nahalal, Shimron, Idalah, and Bethlehem — twelve cities with their villages.

Luke 2:29 "Lord, now lettest thou thy servant depart in peace, according to thy word; 30 for mine eyes have seen thy salvation 31 which thou hast prepared in the presence of all peoples, 32 a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and for glory to thy people Israel."

John 1:14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, full of grace and truth; we have beheld his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father.

2Pet. 1:16 For we did not follow cleverly devised myths when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but we were eyewitnesses of his majesty. 17 For when he received honor and glory from God the Father and the voice was borne to him by the Majestic Glory, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased," 18 we heard this voice borne from heaven, for we were with him on the holy mountain.

John 17:1 When Jesus had spoken these words, he lifted up his eyes to heaven and said, "Father, the hour has come; glorify thy Son that the Son may glorify thee, 2 since thou hast given him power over all flesh, to give eternal life to all whom thou hast given him. 3 And this is eternal life, that they know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom thou hast sent. 4 I glorified thee on

earth, having accomplished the work which thou gavest me to do; 5 and now, Father, glorify thou me in thy own presence with the glory which I had with thee before the world was made.

Eph. 2:10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.
