## # 09-169-12 MAKING DISCIPLES

:40 Matthew 28:16-20 The Great Commission.

3:45 Matthew 28:18 The authority which instituted The Great commission was none other than Jesus himself. The command to go into all the world, is not a command simply to the first disciples, but to all believers, now and to come.

7:30 Ephesians 1:10,22 The announced purpose of God is to bring all things in heaven and earth under one head – Jesus Christ. Jesus has been appointed as head over all.

11:00 We are to come unto Jesus and then Go out in his name.

12:10 Matthew 28:19 ....make disciples... It does not say go and make converts or go and make church members.

Matthew 16:24, Mark 8:34, Luke 9:23 – Jesus defines what a disciple is – One who denies himself, takes up his cross daily and follows Jesus.

The cross is not some difficulty in your life. The cross is an instrument of death. So we are to die to ourselves, daily. It is not our agenda – it is the Lord's agenda. Of course that only works if you, in fact, live your life with Him as the Lord.

16:10 Luke 14:26-27; Matthew 10:34-39 Teaching on the difficult words in these passages. Real discipleship

involves knowing the reality that the truth will often divide. Even among those whom you love.

20:00 Matthew 28:19 Teaching on ...."Baptizing them".... One can only live out the Christian life in the context of the Body of Christ – no freelance Christians. ....Teaching Them... One of the greatest weaknesses in Christians and the church, is the lack of sound apostolic teaching. Discipleship involves a teaching outreach. Jesus will be with us (disciples) until the end of the age.

24:00 Exodus 33:12-16 Moses wanted God to provide all the details about where and how to lead. The Lord said "no", but – I will provide my presence and that is more significant than any other thing.

24:45 A story of a 15 year old Boy who heard a sermon and the call of the Great Commission. After going home he meditated upon some scripture verses:

25:40 Psalm 14:2 "The Lord looks down from heaven on the sons of men to see if there are any who understand, any who seek God". The boy responded that he would seek God every day as long as he had breath.

27:00 2 Chronicles 16:9 "For the eyes of the Lord run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to show his might in behalf of those whose heart is blameless toward him". The boy needed to understand what the term blameless meant. # 09-169-12 Cont'd

29:00 Ezekiel 22:30 "And I sought for a man among them who should build up the wall and stand in the breach before me for the land, that I should not destroy it; but I found none". *At 29:40 there is a slight audio interruption.* 

The Boy said that he would stand in the breach (gap).

31:50 We should be willing to answer the call. Perhaps God has not opened up an opportunity yet for some, but he is seeking those who, when called, will answer.

32:20 A story of Spiritual renewal in the lives of other churches who had attended renewal weekends at St. Paul's, Darien.

38:00 Stepping out for the Lord with only: A command in one ear and a promise in the other.

Command – Go and make Disciples.

Promise – I will Go with you.

<u>Matt. 28:16</u> Now the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had directed them. <u>17</u> And when they saw him they worshiped him; but some doubted. <u>18</u> And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. <u>19</u> Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <u>20</u> teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, to the close of the age."

<u>Eph. 1:10</u> as a plan for the fulness of time, to unite all things in him, things in heaven and things on earth.

<u>Eph. 1:22</u> and he has put all things under his feet and has made him the head over all things for the church,

<u>Matt. 16:24</u> Then Jesus told his disciples, "If any man would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me.

<u>Mark 8:34</u> And he called to him the multitude with his disciples, and said to them, "If any man would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me.

<u>Luke 9:23</u> And he said to all, "If any man would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me.

<u>Luke 14:26</u> "If any one comes to me and does not hate his own father and mother and wife and children and brothers and sisters, yes, and even his own life, he cannot be my disciple. <u>27</u> Whoever does not bear his own cross and come after me, cannot be my disciple.

<u>Matt. 10:34</u> "Do not think that I have come to bring peace on earth; I have not come to bring peace, but a sword. <u>35</u> For I have come to set a man against his father, and a daughter against her mother, and a daughter–in–law against her mother–in–law; <u>36</u> and a man's foes will be those of his own household. <u>37</u> He who loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me; and he who loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me; <u>38</u> and he who does not take his cross and follow me is not worthy of me. <u>39</u> He who finds his life will lose it, and he who loses his life for my sake will find it.

<u>Ex. 33:12</u> Moses said to the LORD, "See, thou sayest to me, 'Bring up this people'; but thou hast not let me know whom thou wilt send with me. Yet thou hast said, 'I know you by name, and you have also found favor in my sight.' <u>13</u> Now therefore, I pray thee, if I have found favor in thy sight, show me now thy ways, that I may know thee and find favor in thy sight. Consider too that this nation is thy people." <u>14</u> And he said, "My presence will go with you, and I will give you rest." <u>15</u> And he said to him, "If thy presence will not go with me, do not carry us up from here. <u>16</u> For how shall it be known that I have found favor in thy sight, I and thy people? Is it not in thy going with us, so that we are distinct, I and thy people, from all other people that are upon the face of the earth?"

<u>Psa. 14:2</u> The LORD looks down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there are any that act wisely, that seek after God.

<u>2Chr. 16:9</u> For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to show his might in behalf of those whose heart is blameless toward him. You have done foolishly in this; for from now on you will have wars."
