## # 10-024-12 DIMENSIONS OF DISCIPLESHIP

- :50 Matthew 4:18-22 Jesus calls his first Disciples –Peter, Andrew, James and John.
- 1:10 Matthew 28:16-20 The Great Commission. Teaching begins with a review of #10-020-12.
- 6:20 Matthew 11:28-30 and the context verses 25-27. Teaching follows about pride and attitude. Being wise from God's perspective is different than being wise in the world. Jeremiah 9:23; 1 Corinthians 8:1-3.
  - 14:00 John 14:6 Teaching on Knowing the Lord.
- 14:20 Matthew 11:28-30 continued. Three things Come to Me Learn from Me Take my Yoke.
- 18:00 Teaching on the Yoke. Easy if you are hooked to Jesus and going same way He is going.
- 24:15 Learn from Me. Don't worry about what you don't know. John 14:26 and John 16: 13 The Holy Spirit will guide you into all truth.
- 29:30 Matthew 11:29b ....you will find rest for your soul... Inward Peace as Jesus carries most of the load.

- Matt. 4:18 As he walked by the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon who is called Peter and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea; for they were fishermen. 19 And he said to them, "Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men." 20 Immediately they left their nets and followed him. 21 And going on from there he saw two other brothers, James the son of Zebedee and John his brother, in the boat with Zebedee their father, mending their nets, and he called them. 22 Immediately they left the boat and their father, and followed him.
- Matt. 28:16 Now the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had directed them. 17 And when they saw him they worshiped him; but some doubted. 18 And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, to the close of the age."
- Matt. 11:25 At that time Jesus declared, "I thank thee, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that thou hast hidden these things from the wise and understanding and revealed them to babes; 26 yea, Father, for such was thy gracious will. 27 All things have been delivered to me by my Father; and no one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son and any one to whom the Son chooses to reveal him. 28 Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me; for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. 30 For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light."
- Jer. 9:23 Thus says the LORD: "Let not the wise man glory in his wisdom, let not the mighty man glory in his might, let not the rich man glory in his riches;
- <u>1Cor. 8:1</u> Now concerning food offered to idols: we know that "all of us possess knowledge." "Knowledge" puffs up, but love builds up. <u>2</u> If any one imagines that he knows something, he does not yet know as he ought to know. <u>3</u> But if one loves God, one is known by him.
- <u>John 14:6</u> Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father, but by me.

<u>John 14:26</u> But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you.

John 16:13 When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth; for he will not speak on his own authority, but whatever he hears he will speak, and he will declare to you the things that are to come.

Matt. 11:29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me; for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.
