14-113-15 IS GOD IN EVERYTHING THAT HAPPENS

:00 The teaching opens with a short mention of the Psychiatrist, Author, M. Scott Peck M.D and his famous quote: “Life is Difficult”. Terry goes on to teach the biblical view.

5:50 Romans 8:28 “ And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose”.

Terry teaches on the fullness of this passage. Love of God in scripture is related to following his commandments, not some emotional feeling. It is the desire to please him by obedience. The promise is not universal but to those who Love the Lord and are called according to his purpose. Although the promise is not universal to every person, it is universal to every situation, “in all things”. The promise is dynamic – God works.

God works for “good”. In reference to verse 29 – the good is that which conforms us to the likeness of his son. It may not be comfortable and pleasant to us at the time but God’s ways are higher than our ways, and he knows what we need – to be more obedient.

13:40 1 John 5:3 “This is love for God: to obey his commands”.

22:00 Terry uses the story of Joseph – Genesis 37-45, to make several points regarding God working in circumstances to bring good.

Rom. 8:28 We know that in everything God works for good with those who love him, who are called according to his purpose.

1John 5:3 For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments. And his commandments are not burdensome.
