10-053-18 EMPOWERMENT FOR MISSIONS (RSV)

1:50 John 14:15-17 "If you love me, you will keep my commandments. <u>16</u> And I will pray the Father, and he will give you another Counselor, to be with you for ever, <u>17</u> even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him; you know him, for he dwells with you, and will be in you. Teaching.

4:30 Jeremiah 31:31-33 Prophecy of a New Covenant to come - wherein God's will is written on the hearts of his people.

5:00 Ezekiel 36:26-27 A new heart I will give you, and a new spirit I will put within you; and I will take out of your flesh the heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh. <u>27</u> And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes and be careful to observe my ordinances. <u>28</u> You shall dwell in the land which I gave to your fathers; and you shall be my people, and I will be your God. Teaching on the external and internal nature of the two covenants. Reference Romans 7:12 The law is holy, righteous and good. Teaching.

16:7 The counselor will come after I go away. The Holy Spirit is to be to us everything that Jesus was to the disciples. Teaching.

14:15 John 14:17 <u>17</u> even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him; you know him, for he dwells with you, and will be in you. Teaching. Reference Matthew 7:16, 20 By their fruit you will know them. Reference Acts 7:48 God does not dwell in houses made with hands. Reference 1 Corinthians 6:19 Your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit. The Spirit within.

18:10 John 7:37 On the last day of the feast, the great day, Jesus stood up and proclaimed, "If any one thirst, let him come to me and drink. Teaching on the metaphor of thirst and its relationship to the Living Water. Reference Psalm 42:1-2; Psalm 63:1 My soul thirsts for thee.

Teaching "**If**". Reference Deuteronomy 4:29; 2 Chronicles 7:14.

John 7:37 Do people know that they thirst? A need? Teaching If they recognize a need then Jesus says "come to me." The prophets before said "Turn to the Lord"

24:50 John 1:11-13 Believing and Receiving the Lord. Teaching. Reference Revelation 3:20 Opening the door and asking Jesus to come in. Teaching.

28:00 John 7:38 He who believes in me, as the scripture has said, 'Out of his heart shall flow rivers of living water.'" Teaching.

32:15 John 7:39 "Now this he said about the Spirit," Teaching. The Spirit should fill our lives and then overflow from us – if we keep an open channel. It is possible to receive the Spirit, yet restrict him from manifesting himself.. Teaching on the matter of being Spirit filled. It is not a question of how much of the Spirit a person has but how much of the person does the Spirit have. How yielded is the person? Reference John 3:34 God gives his Spirit without measure.

35:15 Teaching on the Baptism in the Holy Spirit. The topic can be understood in a variety of perspectives: Teaching.

One perspective: The release of the Holy Spirit already resident in you. Reference John 20:19-23 Disciples received the Holy Spirit and were "Born Again". Teaching. Reference Luke 24:44-49 The promise of the Father upon you – clothed with power from on high. Reference Joel 2:28-29 The Father, through the prophet speaks of a day coming when God's Spirit will be poured upon his people. Reference Acts 1:3-5 The promise of the Father explained. Power – Reference Acts 1:8 "But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria and to the end of the earth." Teaching. God's work can only be done by God's power not by human flesh alone. Reference Zechariah 4:6 "Not by might, nor by power, but by my Spirit, says the LORD of hosts."

46:45 1 Corinthians 12:3"no one can say "Jesus is Lord" except by the Holy Spirit." Teaching on Paul receiving the Holy Spirit. Reference Acts 9:17-19

47:10 Teaching on Jesus' own experience with the Holy Spirit. Jesus was born with the Holy Spirit within. The Spirit

comes upon Jesus at the beginning of his ministry Matthew 3:16; Mark 1:10; Luke 3:22; John 1:32.

48:00 Acts 10:38 how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power; how he went about doing good and healing all that were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him. Teaching on the Holy Spirit in the lives of all Christians.

Teaching on how the church has lost track of the intent of Confirmation.

A story about a Confirmation service at St. Paul's where the manifestation of Holy Spirit was evident to all.

55:30 Romans 10:14-17 People become aware of the presence of God, through the action of the Holy Spirit delivering the truth of the Word to them, through those who are willing to work out their calling in the power of the Spirit.

58:00 The anointing of the Spirit – Spirit upon – has nothing to do with Salvation, it is for the enablement for service and ministry in God's purpose. The Holy Spirit is a gift. Reference Acts 2:38, 8:18-20, 10:45, 11:15-17. John 14:15 "If you love me, you will keep my commandments. <u>16</u> And I will pray the Father, and he will give you another Counselor, to be with you for ever, <u>17</u> even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him; you know him, for he dwells with you, and will be in you.

Jer. 31:31 "Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and the house of Judah, <u>32</u> not like the covenant which I made with their fathers when I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt, my covenant which they broke, though I was their husband, says the LORD. <u>33</u> But this is the covenant which I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the LORD: I will put my law within them, and I will write it upon their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

<u>John 1:11</u> He came to his own home, and his own people received him not. <u>12</u> But to all who received him, who believed in his name, he gave power to become children of God; <u>13</u> who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God.

<u>Rev. 3:20</u> Behold, I stand at the door and knock; if any one hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and eat with him, and he with me.

John 7:38 He who believes in me, as the scripture has said, 'Out of his heart shall flow rivers of living water.'" <u>39</u> Now this he said about the Spirit, which those who believed in him were to receive; for as yet the Spirit had not been given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

John 20:19 On the evening of that day, the first day of the week, the doors being shut where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood

among them and said to them, "Peace be with you." <u>20</u> When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. Then the disciples were glad when they saw the Lord. <u>21</u> Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, even so I send you." <u>22</u> And when he had said this, he breathed on them, and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. <u>23</u> If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained."

<u>Luke 24:44</u> Then he said to them, "These are my words which I spoke to you, while I was still with you, that everything written about me in the law of Moses and the prophets and the psalms must be fulfilled." <u>45</u> Then he opened their minds to understand the scriptures, <u>46</u> and said to them, "Thus it is written, that the Christ should suffer and on the third day rise from the dead, <u>47</u> and that repentance and forgiveness of sins should be preached in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. <u>48</u> You are witnesses of these things. <u>49</u> And behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you; but stay in the city, until you are clothed with power from on high."

<u>Joel 2:28</u> "And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit on all flesh; your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, and your young men shall see visions. <u>29</u> Even upon the menservants and maidservants in those days, I will pour out my spirit.

<u>Acts 1:3</u> To them he presented himself alive after his passion by many proofs, appearing to them during forty days, and speaking of the kingdom of God. <u>4</u> And while staying with them he charged them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the promise of the Father, which, he said, "you heard from me, <u>5</u> for John baptized with water, but before many days you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit."

<u>Acts 1:8</u> But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria and to the end of the earth."

Zech. 4:6 Then he said to me, "This is the word of the LORD to Zerubbabel: Not by might, nor by power, but by my Spirit, says the LORD of hosts.

1Cor. 12:3 Therefore I want you to understand that no one speaking by the

Spirit of God ever says "Jesus be cursed!" and no one can say "Jesus is Lord" except by the Holy Spirit.

<u>Acts 9:17</u> So Ananias departed and entered the house. And laying his hands on him he said, "Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus who appeared to you on the road by which you came, has sent me that you may regain your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit." <u>18</u> And immediately something like scales fell from his eyes and he regained his sight. Then he rose and was baptized, <u>19</u> and took food and was strengthened.

For several days he was with the disciples at Damascus.

<u>Matt. 3:16</u> And when Jesus was baptized, he went up immediately from the water, and behold, the heavens were opened and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and alighting on him;

<u>Mark 1:10</u> And when he came up out of the water, immediately he saw the heavens opened and the Spirit descending upon him like a dove;

<u>Luke 3:22</u> and the Holy Spirit descended upon him in bodily form, as a dove, and a voice came from heaven, "Thou art my beloved Son; with thee I am well pleased."

John 1:32 And John bore witness, "I saw the Spirit descend as a dove from heaven, and it remained on him.

<u>Acts 10:38</u> how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power; how he went about doing good and healing all that were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him.

<u>Rom. 10:14</u> But how are men to call upon him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without a preacher? <u>15</u> And how can men preach unless they are sent? As it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach good news!" <u>16</u> But they have not all obeyed the gospel; for Isaiah says, "Lord, who has believed what he has heard from us?" <u>17</u> So faith comes from what is heard, and what is heard comes by the preaching of Christ. <u>Acts 2:38</u> And Peter said to them, "Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

<u>Acts 8:18</u> Now when Simon saw that the Spirit was given through the laying on of the apostles' hands, he offered them money, <u>19</u> saying, "Give me also this power, that any one on whom I lay my hands may receive the Holy Spirit." <u>20</u> But Peter said to him, "Your silver perish with you, because you thought you could obtain the gift of God with money!

<u>Acts 10:45</u> And the believers from among the circumcised who came with Peter were amazed, because the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out even on the Gentiles.

<u>Acts 11:15</u> As I began to speak, the Holy Spirit fell on them just as on us at the beginning. <u>16</u> And I remembered the word of the Lord, how he said, 'John baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit.' <u>17</u> If then God gave the same gift to them as he gave to us when we believed in the Lord Jesus Christ, who was I that I could withstand God?"
