Scriptural References and Comment Notes

16-173-22 COMMITMENT AND OUR INHERITANCE

1:30 Making decisions is the essence of commitment. Reference Joshua 24:15 – as for me and my house we will serve the Lord. Reference 1 Kings 18:21 How long will you go limping between two opinions. Revelation 3:15 Would that you were either hot or cold.

4:30 Galatians 3:26-27 How is one identified as one in the family of God? 1. External, 2. Internal. External signs are Circumcision and Baptism. Internal is the personal relationship with Christ and that comes through faith (trust) in the statements he made about himself being God and the confirmation of that fact by his works and especially by his resurrection. Baptism identifies you with the people of God – but you must at sometime respond to God and ask him to be Lord of your life.

11:30 Galatians 3:28-29 The barriers of separation and distinction are removed in Christ. All who trust and receive are in relationship to him. Reference Philemon 15-16.

16:40 John 17:20-21 Jesus prays for the disciples and all who shall believe in him...that they may be one.

19:20 Galatians 3:28-29 We are all one in Christ Jesus. Teaching on being an heir to the promises of God.

23:40 Galatians 4:1-7 Teaching on our Inheritance as a member of God's family, where we can have an intimate relationship with our true "Abba" Father. Where we understand the distinction between being a slave as opposed to being a son. You are an heir – Teaching. Reference Psalm 149:4.

34:35 Ephesians 1:13-14 The NIV does a poor job at the translation of verse 13. Teaching on difference between hearing and believing. Reference Hebrews 4:2. The Jews heard but it did them no good because they lacked faith (trust).

In the Ephesians passage it is clear that belief brings the deposit of the Holy Spirit as a kind of down payment on the full inheritance to come.

39:00 Colossians 1:10-13 Praying for one another that we may have a life worthy of the Lord. Teaching on inheritance. Reference Colossians 3:22-24 Whatever you do, do it unto the Lord.

46:35 1 Peter 1:3-5 God has given us, in Christ, the assurance of an inheritance that will be kept in heaven for you.

48:35 1 Corinthians 6:9-11. Teaching on some of the things that will eliminate the inheritance available from God.

56:55 James 2:5 God has chosen those who love God, though they may be poor in the eyes of the world, to inherit the kingdom.

Josh. 24:15 But if serving the LORD seems undesirable to you, then choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your forefathers served beyond the River, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you are living. But as for me and my household, we will serve the LORD.”

1Kings 18:21 Elijah went before the people and said, “How long will you waver between two opinions? If the LORD is God, follow him; but if Baal is God, follow him.”

But the people said nothing.

Rev. 3:15 I know your deeds, that you are neither cold nor hot. I wish you were either one or the other!

Gal. 3:26 You are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus, 27 for all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ. 28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, slave nor free, male nor female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus. 29 If you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham’s seed, and heirs according to the promise.

Phil. 1:15 It is true that some preach Christ out of envy and rivalry, but others out of goodwill. 16 The latter do so in love, knowing that I am put here for the defense of the gospel.

John 17:20 “My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, 21 that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me.

Gal. 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, slave nor free, male nor female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus. 29 If you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham’s seed, and heirs according to the promise.

Gal. 4:1 What I am saying is that as long as the heir is a child, he is no different from a slave, although he owns the whole estate. 2 He is subject to guardians and trustees until the time set by his father. 3 So also, when we were children, we were in slavery under the basic principles of the world. 4 But when the time had fully come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under

law, 5 to redeem those under law, that we might receive the full rights of sons. 6 Because you are sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, the Spirit who calls out, “*Abba*, Father.” 7 So you are no longer a slave, but a son; and since you are a son, God has made you also an heir.

Psa. 149:4 For the LORD takes delight in his people;
he crowns the humble with salvation.

Eph. 1:13 And you also were included in Christ when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation. Having believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, 14 who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God’s possession—to the praise of his glory.

Heb. 4:2 For we also have had the gospel preached to us, just as they did; but the message they heard was of no value to them, because those who heard did not combine it with faith.

Col. 1:10 And we pray this in order that you may live a life worthy of the Lord and may please him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God, 11 being strengthened with all power according to his glorious might so that you may have great endurance and patience, and joyfully 12 giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of the saints in the kingdom of light. 13 For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves,

Col. 3:22 Slaves, obey your earthly masters in everything; and do it, not only when their eye is on you and to win their favor, but with sincerity of heart and reverence for the Lord. 23 Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for men, 24 since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving.

1Pet. 1:3 Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In his great mercy he has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, 4 and into an inheritance that can never perish, spoil or fade—kept in heaven for you, 5 who through faith are shielded by God’s power until the coming of the salvation that is ready to be

revealed in the last time.

1Cor. 6:9 Do you not know that the wicked will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived: Neither the sexually immoral nor idolaters nor adulterers nor male prostitutes nor homosexual offenders 10 nor thieves nor the greedy nor drunkards nor slanderers nor swindlers will inherit the kingdom of God. 11 And that is what some of you were. But you were washed, you were sanctified, you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God.

James 2:5 Listen, my dear brothers: Has not God chosen those who are poor in the eyes of the world to be rich in faith and to inherit the kingdom he promised those who love him?
