13-116-24 GOD'S BUILDING - FOUNDATION (RSV)

- 1:00 1 Corinthians 3:9 Paul uses the metaphor of God's family as being like "a field". He also uses the description of God's family as "God's Building".
- 1:45 1 Corinthians 3:10-11 According to the grace of God given to me, like a skilled master builder I laid a foundation, and another man is building upon it. Let each man take care how he builds upon it. 11 For no other foundation can any one lay than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ. Teaching focus will be 1. On our individual lives, for we are God's temple. 2. On the church as being erected upon the one foundation.
- 9:05 Isaiah 28:16 therefore thus says the Lord GOD, "Behold, I am laying in Zion for a foundation a stone, a tested stone, a precious cornerstone, of a sure foundation:

Teaching – God makes a sovereign statement. What is our response to it? Teaching on the name Zion.

- 12:00 "The Stone". 1. Tested; 2. Precious 3. Sure
- 13:05 Isaiah 8:13-15 Isaiah is assured that he can cast his fears upon the Lord and the Lord will provide a "stone". A stone that will separate God's devoted people from those in opposition.

16:20 Matthew 7:13-14 Enter by the narrow gate; for the gate is wide and the way is easy, that leads to destruction, and those who enter by it are many. 14 For the gate is narrow and the way is hard, that leads to life, and those who find it are few.

Teaching – People like the sentimentalized Jesus, but most are reluctant to give themselves totally to him and his commandments. To many, Jesus is a stumbling stone.

- 17:40 Psalm 118:22-23 The stone which the builders rejected has become the head of the corner. 23 This is the LORD's doing; it is marvelous in our eyes. Teaching.
- 19:15 Luke 20:9-19 The parable of the tenants and its application to us. Teaching. Our failure to honor the "Cornerstone" causes us to stumble through life.
- 24:25 Acts 4:5-12 The "Builders" (in this case the Jewish leaders) had rejected the "Stone".
- 26:30 1 Corinthians 3:10 -15 Teaching on our personal houses being built on the one foundation. "Let each man take care how he builds upon it." You can be a Christian, but when your life is over, it will have been worthless, so far as God is concerned.
- 32:50 Matthew 7:24-27 "Every one then who hears these words of mine and does them will be like a wise man who built his house upon the rock; 25 and the rain fell, and the floods came, and the winds blew and beat upon that house, but it did not fall, because it had been founded on the rock. 26 And every one who hears these words of mine and does not do them will be like a foolish man who built his house upon the

- Luke 20:9 And he began to tell the people this parable: "A man planted a vineyard, and let it out to tenants, and went into another country for a long while. 10 When the time came, he sent a servant to the tenants, that they should give him some of the fruit of the vineyard; but the tenants beat him, and sent him away empty-handed. 11 And he sent another servant; him also they beat and treated shamefully, and sent him away empty-handed. 12 And he sent yet a third; this one they wounded and cast out. 13 Then the owner of the vineyard said, 'What shall I do? I will send my beloved son; it may be they

will respect him.' 14 But when the tenants saw him, they said to themselves, 'This is the heir; let us kill him, that the inheritance may be ours.' 15 And they cast him out of the vineyard and killed him. <u>Luke 20:19</u> The scribes and the chief priests tried to lay hands on him at that very hour, but they feared the people; for they perceived that he had told this parable against them.

Acts 4:5 On the morrow their rulers and elders and scribes were gathered together in Jerusalem, 6 with Annas the high priest and Caiaphas and John and Alexander, and all who were of the high-priestly family. 7 And when they had set them in the midst, they inquired, "By what power or by what name did you do this?" 8 Then Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit, said to them, "Rulers of the people and elders, 9 if we are being examined today concerning a good deed done to a cripple, by what means this man has been healed, 10 be it known to you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead, by him this man is standing before you well. 11 This is the stone which was rejected by you builders, but which has become the head of the corner. 12 And there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved."
