## # 13-123 -24 GOD'S BUILDING - WALLS (RSV)

1:00 There are 3,294 questions in the English bible. 2,272 questions in the Old Testament and 1,022 questions in the New Testament. A few examples are given.

2:00 2 Chronicles 6:18 "But will God dwell indeed with man on the earth? Behold, heaven and the highest heaven cannot contain thee; how much less this house which I have built!

2:45 1 Chronicles 17:11-14 Teaching on the Davidic covenant and the Temple to come.

5:30 2 Chronicles 6:7-10 Solomon tells of the Lord's instruction to his father David. Solomon does build the temple.

6:20 2 Chronicles 7:1-2 The dedication of the temple. The LORD filled the temple.

7:10 Jeremiah 23:5-6 From David a righteous Branch called by the name: The LORD is our righteousness.

8:15 Zechariah 6:12-14 The Branch shall build the temple of the LORD. He shall bear royal honor, there will be a priest by his throne – and the crown shall be in the temple. It all comes together.

9:50 John 2:19-20 Jesus declares his body to be the temple. Teaching.

11:30 Ephesians 2:11-22 Jesus has made the two (God's people and the Gentile believers) one. Jesus is the cornerstone in whom the whole structure is joined together to form a holy temple in the Lord. We are also a dwelling place of God in the Spirit. Teaching. Reference Acts 7:48 God does not dwell in houses made with hands.

15:30 1 Peter 2:4-5 Come to him, to that living stone, rejected by men but in God's sight chosen and precious; 5 and like living stones be yourselves built into a spiritual house, to be a holy priesthood, to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.

18:25 2 Chronicles 7:1-2 The Glory of the Lord filled the temple. Reference Matthew 17:1-2

20:25 Revelation 21:1-4 The dwelling place of God is with his people. Reference Revelation 21:22 And I saw no temple in the city, for its temple is the Lord God the Almighty and the Lamb. Teaching on the church as of living stones. Mortised together (fitted not mortared). You can have a congregation and not have a church. Teaching.

28:00 Teaching on the temple rebuilding under Nehemiah. Teaching as it applies to rebuilding the walls of the New Testament temple; the people of God.

30:00 Teaching on the call of St. Paul's church and the status of the Episcopal denomination. We are called to a rebuilding project.

35:00 We are to be fitted together like a stone wall – mortised. Nehemiah and his people had tenacity. The accomplishment – the wall rebuilt in 52 days – made it obvious to everyone that the Lord was in charge. That is a model for us.

<u>2Chr. 6:18</u> "But will God dwell indeed with man on the earth? Behold, heaven and the highest heaven cannot contain thee; how much less this house which I have built!

<u>1Chr. 17:11</u> When your days are fulfilled to go to be with your fathers, I will raise up your offspring after you, one of your own sons, and I will establish his kingdom. <u>12</u> He shall build a house for me, and I will establish his throne for ever. <u>13</u> I will be his father, and he shall be my son; I will not take my steadfast love from him, as I took it from him who was before you, <u>14</u> but I will confirm him in my house and in my kingdom for ever and his throne shall be established for ever.'"

<u>2Chr. 6:7</u> Now it was in the heart of David my father to build a house for the name of the LORD, the God of Israel. <u>8</u> But the LORD said to David my father, 'Whereas it was in your heart to build a house for my name, you did well that it was in your heart; <u>9</u> nevertheless you shall not build the house, but your son who shall be born to you shall build the house for my name.' <u>10</u> Now the LORD has fulfilled his promise which he made; for I have risen in the place of David my father, and sit on the throne of Israel, as the LORD promised, and I have built the house for the name of the LORD, the God of Israel.

<u>2Chr. 7:1</u> When Solomon had ended his prayer, fire came down from heaven and consumed the burnt offering and the sacrifices, and the glory of the LORD filled the temple. <u>2</u> And the priests could not enter the house of the LORD, because the glory of the LORD filled the LORD's house.

Jer. 23:5 "Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will raise up for David a righteous Branch, and he shall reign as king and deal wisely, and shall execute justice and righteousness in the land. <u>6</u> In his days Judah will be saved, and Israel will dwell securely. And this is the name by which he will be called: 'The LORD is our righteousness.'

<u>Zech. 6:12</u> and say to him, 'Thus says the LORD of hosts, "Behold, the man whose name is the Branch: for he shall grow up in his place, and he shall build the temple of the LORD. <u>13</u> It is he who shall build the temple of the LORD, and shall bear royal honor, and shall sit and rule upon his throne. And there shall be a priest by his throne, and peaceful understanding shall be between them both."' <u>14</u> And the crown shall be in the temple of the LORD as a reminder to Heldai, Tobijah, Jedaiah, and Josiah the son of Zephaniah.

<u>John 2:19</u> Jesus answered them, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up." <u>20</u> The Jews then said, "It has taken forty-six years to build this temple, and will you raise it up in three days?"

Eph. 2:11 Therefore remember that at one time you Gentiles in the flesh, called the uncircumcision by what is called the circumcision, which is made in the flesh by hands - 12 remember that you were at that time separated from Christ, alienated from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers to the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world. 13 But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near in the blood of Christ. 14 For he is our peace, who has made us both one, and has broken down the dividing wall of hostility, 15 by abolishing in his flesh the law of commandments and ordinances, that he might create in himself one new man in place of the two, so making peace, 16 and might reconcile us both to God in one body through the cross, thereby bringing the hostility to an end. 17 And he came and preached peace to you who were far off and peace to those who were near; 18 for through him we both have access in one Spirit to the Father. 19 So then you are no longer strangers and sojourners, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, 20 built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone, 21 in whom the whole structure is joined together and grows into a holy temple in the Lord; 22 in whom you also are built into it for a dwelling place of God in the Spirit.

He will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself will be with them; <u>4</u> he will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning nor crying nor pain any more, for the former things have passed away."
