921015-28 BAPTIZED WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT

- 4:00 Acts 1:5, 7-8 Verse 5 "For John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit". Verse 8 But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you.
- 7:35 Matthew 3:11He (Jesus) will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with Fire.
- 11:00 Mark 1:7-8 He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit.
- 12:30 Luke 3:16 He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire.
- 14:10 John 1:29-34 Verse 33.....he who will baptize with the Holy Spirit.
- 20:20 Jesus is the Baptizer. Greek word is "Baptizo" a secular word meaning to cover over or saturate.
- 25:00 This is a teaching about the Holy Spirit "Upon" as compared to the previous teaching # 921008-28 that was about the Holy Spirit within.
- 26:50 Three Scriptures to help understand and presented in the order 1,2,3.

- **1.** John 20:19-22 Verse 22- On Easter evening Jesus breathed on his disciples and said "receive" the Holy Spirit (Within).
- 42:20 **2**. Luke 24:49 "I am going to send you what my Father has promised; but stay in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high".
- 46:20 **3**. Acts 1:3-8 Verse 5 ...you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit. Verse 8 But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you......
- 47:40 Old Testament references to the coming of the Holy Spirit Within Ezekiel 36:27 and Upon Joel 2:28.
- 49:50 The anointing that comes with the Spirit can be looked at as two enablement's. The Spirit <u>within</u> is connected to Salvation and He is the resource to resist the evil one. The Spirit <u>upon</u> is the enablement given us to accomplish the works that God has prepared for us to do.
- 52:50 A teaching on dying to Christ and then taking part in the Resurrection to new life in the Spirit.
- 58:35 Acts 10:38 how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power..... Have we experienced a personal Pentecost?
- 1:06:50 Matthew 3:11 and Luke 3:16 He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire.

The fire is the Holy Spirit convicting us of sin and our response of confession and repentance. Then he forgives us.

- Acts 1:1 In the first book, O The-ophilus, I have dealt with all that Jesus began to do and teach, 2 until the day when he was taken up, after he had given commandment through the Holy Spirit to the apostles whom he had chosen. 3 To them he presented himself alive after his passion by many proofs, appearing to them during forty days, and speaking of the kingdom of God. 4 And while staying with them he charged them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the promise of the Father, which, he said, "you heard from me, 5 for John baptized with water, but before many days you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit."

- John 1:29 The next day he saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world! 30 This is he of whom I said, 'After me comes a man who ranks before me, for he was before me.' 31 I myself did not know him; but for this I came baptizing with water, that he might be revealed to Israel." 32 And John bore witness, "I saw the Spirit descend as a dove from heaven, and it remained on him. 33 I myself did not know him; but he who sent me to baptize with water said to me, 'He on whom you see the Spirit descend and remain, this is he who baptizes with the Holy Spirit.' 34 And I have seen and have borne witness that this is the Son of God."

John 20:19 On the evening of that day, the first day of the week, the doors being shut where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood among them and said to them, "Peace be with you." 20 When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. Then the disciples were glad when they saw the Lord. 21 Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, even so I send you." 22 And when he had said this, he breathed on them, and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit.
