10-144-29 THE HOLY SPIRIT WITHIN

:00 - 3:45 Opening comments on the Holy Spirit and his wish to point us to Jesus. Reference John 16:14-16 He will glorify Jesus and make known his essence.

3:45 John 14:16-17 I will pray the Father and he will give. Jesus knew that he was praying in the Father's will and he knew the scriptures; consequently the prayer would be answered. Reference Ezekiel 36:26-27 Spirit within. New Testament Reference Psalm 51:11 Holy Spirit upon, Old Testament.

8:30 Jesus knew the will of the Father in the same way that we are to know it: through the word of God. So knowing is through the word; Executing his will is through the power of the Holy Spirit. A short teaching on prayer. Reference Matthew 6:10.

10:20 John 14:16-17 Another Counselor. Reference Isaiah 9:6 Jesus is the Wonderful Counselor.

11:40 John 16:7 Jesus says "it is to your advantage that I go away" – so that the Counselor can come. The Holy Spirit is intended to be to us everything that Jesus would be if he were here with us as our constant companion.

18:20 John 14:17 The Spirit of Truth. What are the ways this can be understood. **1.** In relation to Jesus – Reference John 14:6 – “I am the way and the Truth and the life”. Jesus is God unveiled. Reference John 14:9 He who has seen Jesus has seen the Father. Reference 1 Corinthians 12:3 No one can call Jesus Lord, except by the Holy Spirit. It is the Holy Spirit who reveals Jesus to you experientially – a presence that is way beyond knowing him intellectually. Teaching. Reference John 15:16; John 14:6. The Spirit leads us into an intimate relationship with Jesus.

2. The Spirit of Truth: One of the functions of the Holy Spirit is to be the guide and teacher of Truth. Reference John 14:26; Reference John 16:13.

24:00 John 14:17 Teaching on why the world cannot know or accept the Spirit of Truth. Reference Ephesians 1:13 We are sealed with the Holy Spirit.

28:25 1 Corinthians 2:14 “The man without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him, and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually discerned.” Spiritual blindness.

30:00 John 14:17 Teaching about the Holy Spirit within. Reference to the New Covenant, fulfilled with Jesus, wherein God’s will is written on the hearts of his people.

32:30 2 Timothy 1:14 Guard the truth that has been entrusted to you by the Holy Spirit who dwells within you. Reference 1 Corinthians 3:16-17 God’s Spirit lives in you. Reference 1 Corinthians 6:19-20 God’s Spirit lives in you.

35:00 Ezekiel 36:26-27 The Lord says that the Spirit within will move you to follow God's will.

35:20 Romans 6:13-16 Do not yield your members to sin, but to God. Obedience leads to righteousness. Reference Jeremiah 31:31-33 The New Covenant will allow the law of God to be internal upon the minds and hearts.

37:50 Romans 8:2-4 Teaching on yielding to the indwelling Holy Spirit and its impact on our behavior. Reference 1 Corinthians 2:10-16 We have the facility to know the mind of Christ. It requires constant yielding to the Spirit within to know what he has for us to do.

43:00 Terry teaches regarding the question he is most often asked. How do I know what the will of God is for me? Answer: It is not a matter of knowledge as the question might imply. The blockage to knowing the will of God for your life is not your ignorance, but your willfulness. You must choose to do the will of God as a precondition to knowing it. Reference John 7:16-17 If anyone chooses to do God's will, he will find out whether my teaching comes from God or whether I speak on my own.

48:40 John 14:16-17 God has given us: A Prayer - A Promise - A Provision.

Prayer: I will ask the Father

Promise: He will give us a Counselor, the Spirit of Truth.

Provision: The Spirit will dwell in us. Everything we need to discern and do the will of God.

John 16:14 He will glorify me, for he will take what is mine and declare it to you.
15 All that the Father has is mine; therefore I said that he will take what is mine and declare it to you.

John 16:16 “A little while, and you will see me no more; again a little while, and you will see me.”

John 14:16 And I will pray the Father, and he will give you another Counselor, to be with you for ever, 17 even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him; you know him, for he dwells with you, and will be in you.

Ezek. 36:26 A new heart I will give you, and a new spirit I will put within you; and I will take out of your flesh the heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh.
27 And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes and be careful to observe my ordinances.

Psa. 51:11 Cast me not away from thy presence, and take not thy holy Spirit from me.

Matt. 6:10 Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, On earth as it is in heaven.

John 16:7 Nevertheless I tell you the truth: it is to your advantage that I go away, for if I do not go away, the Counselor will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you.

John 14:17 even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him; you know him, for he dwells with you, and will be in you.

John 14:6 Jesus said to him, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father, but by me. 7 If you had known me, you would have known my Father also; henceforth you know him and have seen him.”

John 14:8 Philip said to him, “Lord, show us the Father, and we shall be satisfied.” 9 Jesus said to him, “Have I been with you so long, and yet you do not know me, Philip? He who has seen me has seen the Father; how can you say, ‘Show us the Father?’

1Cor. 12:3 Therefore I want you to understand that no one speaking by the Spirit of God ever says “Jesus be cursed!” and no one can say “Jesus is Lord” except by the Holy Spirit.

John 15:16 You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit and that your fruit should abide; so that whatever you ask the Father in my name, he may give it to you.

John 14:6 Jesus said to him, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father, but by me.

John 14:26 But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you.

John 16:13 When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth; for he will not speak on his own authority, but whatever he hears he will speak, and he will declare to you the things that are to come.

John 14:17 even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him; you know him, for he dwells with you, and will be in you.

Eph. 1:13 In him you also, who have heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and have believed in him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit,

1Cor. 2:14 The unspiritual man does not receive the gifts of the Spirit of God, for they are folly to him, and he is not able to understand them because they are spiritually discerned.

2Tim. 1:14 guard the truth that has been entrusted to you by the Holy Spirit who dwells within us.

1Cor. 3:16 Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in you? 17 If any one destroys God's temple, God will destroy him. For God's temple is holy, and that temple you are.

1Cor. 6:19 Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, which you have from God? You are not your own; 20 you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body.

Ezek. 36:26 A new heart I will give you, and a new spirit I will put within you; and I will take out of your flesh the heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh. 27 And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes and be careful to observe my ordinances.

Rom. 6:13 Do not yield your members to sin as instruments of wickedness, but yield yourselves to God as men who have been brought from death to life, and your members to God as instruments of righteousness. 14 For sin will have no dominion over you, since you are not under law but under grace.

Rom. 6:15 What then? Are we to sin because we are not under law but under grace? By no means! 16 Do you not know that if you yield yourselves to any one as obedient slaves, you are slaves of the one whom you obey, either of sin, which leads to death, or of obedience, which leads to righteousness?

Jer. 31:31 "Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and the house of Judah, 32 not like the covenant which I made with their fathers when I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt, my covenant which they broke, though I was their husband, says the LORD. 33 But this is the covenant which I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the LORD: I will put my law within them, and I will write it upon their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

Rom. 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set me free from the

law of sin and death. 3 For God has done what the law, weakened by the flesh, could not do: sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and for sin, he condemned sin in the flesh, 4 in order that the just requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.

1Cor. 2:10 God has revealed to us through the Spirit. For the Spirit searches everything, even the depths of God. 11 For what person knows a man's thoughts except the spirit of the man which is in him? So also no one comprehends the thoughts of God except the Spirit of God. 12 Now we have received not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit which is from God, that we might understand the gifts bestowed on us by God. 13 And we impart this in words not taught by human wisdom but taught by the Spirit, interpreting spiritual truths to those who possess the Spirit.

1Cor. 2:14 The unspiritual man does not receive the gifts of the Spirit of God, for they are folly to him, and he is not able to understand them because they are spiritually discerned. 15 The spiritual man judges all things, but is himself to be judged by no one. 16 "For who has known the mind of the Lord so as to instruct him?" But we have the mind of Christ.

John 7:16 So Jesus answered them, "My teaching is not mine, but his who sent me; 17 if any man's will is to do his will, he shall know whether the teaching is from God or whether I am speaking on my own authority.

John 14:16 And I will pray the Father, and he will give you another Counselor, to be with you for ever, 17 even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him; you know him, for he dwells with you, and will be in you.
