### # 10-170-29    MANIFESTATIONS OF THE GIFTS – PART 1

3:40 Review of the understanding that all Christians have received the Gift of the Holy Spirit, to indwell their lives, and that the Spirit is given in its fullness. There are not some Christians with more of the Spirit than other Christians. There are however some Christians in which the Holy Spirit has more of them than he does of others. Reference 1 Corinthians 12:3. Anyone who truly knows and receives Jesus as Lord, has the Spirit. Reference John 3:34 God gives the Spirit without limit or measure. Some Christians are more yielded to God – The Holy Spirit – and therefore more effective for Him.

6:00 John 14:16-17 Jesus promises the Holy spirit, the Spirit of Truth, will indwell his people. Reference 1 Corinthians 3:16 and 1 Corinthians 6:19 Each of God's people is the dwelling place of God in the person of the Holy Spirit.

6:50 John 4:14 and John 7:38 A person who is yielded to God – The Holy Spirit – will have an overflowing life. The living water will overflow out from them touching the lives of countless others. Yieldedness, is to be an open channel for the Lord allowing him to flow out.

8:00 Acts 1:12-14 and Acts 2:1-4 The working of the Holy Spirit at the day of Pentecost. Reference Ezekiel 36:26-27 The day is coming when I will put my Holy Spirit within you.

9:25 Acts 2:37-38 At the end of Peter's sermon the crowd asked "What shall we do?" A perfect response to hearing God's message. Teaching on the distinction of a sermon as opposed to a lecture.

Verse 38, Peter's answer – Repent, be baptized (a confirmation of receiving Jesus as Savior and Lord), and you shall receive the Gift of the Holy Spirit.

12:30 Romans 7:14-25 Our human nature is contrary to the will and purpose of our spiritual nature. Sins are the manifestations of a sinful condition. The sinful nature is the underlying basis of sinful acts. We sin because we are sinners.

14:35 Acts 2:38 Repentance. Turning from the sinful nature (the bad news) to the Godly – Spiritual way (the Good news). Baptizing – Reference Matthew 28:19-20. The result of repentance and asking for our Savior, is the bestowal of the Holy Spirit.

16:00 Acts 10:44-45 As Peter is preaching the Holy Spirit came on all who heard the message. Most astonishingly the Gentiles were included.

19:00 Acts 11:1-4 Some of the Jews thought it not right that Peter had gone to a Gentile house and asked him to explain. Reference Acts 11:15-17 Peter says to them that the Holy Spirit came on the Gentiles and he was not going to stand in opposition to the movement of God.

22:15 Terry explains that these first 22 minutes were the background to establish the context (the Gift of the Holy Spirit), for the teaching which now follows: The Spirit's Gifts.

22:35 1 Corinthians 12:1-3 Paul wanted the Corinthians to understand some of the ways in which the Holy Spirit works. Teaching. Reference John 15:26 The Holy Spirit will bring glory to Jesus. If one attempts to downplay Jesus, he is not speaking from the Spirit. Reference 1 John 4:1-3 Test the Spirits to see if they are of God. Teaching.

30:35 Matthew 16:13-19 Peter confesses Jesus as the Christ. Jesus tells him that he could only know that because the Father revealed it to him through the agency of the Holy Spirit.

31:35 1 Corinthians 12:4 Teaching on the varieties of gifts, services and workings. Gifts – (Greek Charismata, Charisma G5486), free gift of God's grace. Teaching on the use of the term Charismatic and its application to the church today. Variety but the same God works in all of them. Teaching.

1Cor. 12:3 Therefore I want you to understand that no one speaking by the Spirit of God ever says “Jesus be cursed!” and no one can say “Jesus is Lord” except by the Holy Spirit.

John 3:34 For he whom God has sent utters the words of God, for it is not by measure that he gives the Spirit;

John 14:16 And I will pray the Father, and he will give you another Counselor, to be with you for ever, 17 even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him; you know him, for he dwells with you, and will be in you.

1Cor. 3:16 Do you not know that you are God’s temple and that God’s Spirit dwells in you?

1Cor. 6:19 Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, which you have from God? You are not your own;

John 4:14 but whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst; the water that I shall give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life.”

John 7:38 He who believes in me, as the scripture has said, ‘Out of his heart shall flow rivers of living water.’”

Acts 1:12 Then they returned to Jerusalem from the mount called Olivet, which is near Jerusalem, a sabbath day’s journey away; 13 and when they had entered, they went up to the upper room, where they were staying, Peter and John and James and Andrew, Philip and Thomas, Bartholomew and Matthew, James the son of Alphaeus and Simon the Zealot and Judas the son of James. 14 All these with one accord devoted themselves to prayer, together with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brothers.

Acts 2:1 When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. 2 And suddenly a sound came from heaven like the rush of a mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. 3 And there appeared to them tongues as of fire, distributed and resting on each one of them. 4 And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues, as

the Spirit gave them utterance.

Ezek. 36:26 A new heart I will give you, and a new spirit I will put within you; and I will take out of your flesh the heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh. 27 And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes and be careful to observe my ordinances.

Acts 2:37 Now when they heard this they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Brethren, what shall we do?" 38 And Peter said to them, "Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Rom. 7:14 We know that the law is spiritual; but I am carnal, sold under sin. 15 I do not understand my own actions. For I do not do what I want, but I do the very thing I hate. 16 Now if I do what I do not want, I agree that the law is good. 17 So then it is no longer I that do it, but sin which dwells within me. 18 For I know that nothing good dwells within me, that is, in my flesh. I can will what is right, but I cannot do it. 19 For I do not do the good I want, but the evil I do not want is what I do. 20 Now if I do what I do not want, it is no longer I that do it, but sin which dwells within me.

Rom. 7:21 So I find it to be a law that when I want to do right, evil lies close at hand. 22 For I delight in the law of God, in my inmost self, 23 but I see in my members another law at war with the law of my mind and making me captive to the law of sin which dwells in my members. 24 Wretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from this body of death? 25 Thanks be to God through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, I of myself serve the law of God with my mind, but with my flesh I serve the law of sin.

Acts 2:38 And Peter said to them, "Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Matt. 28:19 Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, to the close of the age."

Acts 10:44 While Peter was still saying this, the Holy Spirit fell on all who heard the word. 45 And the believers from among the circumcised who came with Peter were amazed, because the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out even on the Gentiles.

Acts 11:1 Now the apostles and the brethren who were in Judea heard that the Gentiles also had received the word of God. 2 So when Peter went up to Jerusalem, the circumcision party criticized him, 3 saying, “Why did you go to uncircumcised men and eat with them?” 4 But Peter began and explained to them in order:

Acts 11:15 As I began to speak, the Holy Spirit fell on them just as on us at the beginning. 16 And I remembered the word of the Lord, how he said, ‘John baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit.’ 17 If then God gave the same gift to them as he gave to us when we believed in the Lord Jesus Christ, who was I that I could withstand God?”

1Cor. 12:1 Now concerning spiritual gifts, brethren, I do not want you to be uninformed. 2 You know that when you were heathen, you were led astray to dumb idols, however you may have been moved. 3 Therefore I want you to understand that no one speaking by the Spirit of God ever says “Jesus be cursed!” and no one can say “Jesus is Lord” except by the Holy Spirit.

John 15:26 But when the Counselor comes, whom I shall send to you from the Father, even the Spirit of truth, who proceeds from the Father, he will bear witness to me;

1John 4:1 Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are of God; for many false prophets have gone out into the world. 2 By this you know the Spirit of God: every spirit which confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is of God, 3 and every spirit which does not confess Jesus is not of God. This is the spirit of antichrist, of which you heard that it was coming, and now it is in the world already.

Matt. 16:13 Now when Jesus came into the district of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, “Who do men say that the Son of man is?” 14 And they said, “Some say John the Baptist, others say Elijah, and others Jeremiah or one

of the prophets.” 15 He said to them, “But who do you say that I am?” 16 Simon Peter replied, “You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.” 17 And Jesus answered him, “Blessed are you, Simon Bar-jona! For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my Father who is in heaven. 18 And I tell you, you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the powers of death shall not prevail against it. 19 I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.”

1Cor. 12:4 Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit;
