10-173-29 MANIFESTATIONS OF THE GIFTS – PART 2

:00 – 3:00 Short comments on the three part section of the teachings titled "Manifestations of the Gifts, Parts 1-3" The section's master title could be "The Gift of the Spirit and the Spirits Gifts."

2:55 John 14:16-17 Jesus prays to the Father in confidence that the Holy Spirit will be imparted to live within all his disciples. Teaching on how Jesus knew the will of the Father and therefore what to pray for. Reference Philippians 2:5-11. Jesus learned the will of the Father in the same way that we can. Teaching on some heretical views of the nature of Jesus as the incarnate God. Reference John 8:28 Jesus only did the will of the Father who sent him. Reference Matthew 13:54 and Mark 6:2 When Jesus as an adult came to those people who knew Jesus as a child; they said - where did he get all this wisdom? Reference Isaiah 11:1-2.

Jesus is the true paradigm of the Spirit filled life, as all the gifts of the Spirit resided in him.

8:00 Ezekiel 36:26-27 The day will come when God will put his Spirit within those who follow him. Reference Luke 24:49 and Acts 1:4-8 Wait for the Holy Spirit to come on you with power. Acts 2:16-18; Joel 2:28-29. God will pour out his Spirit upon his people. # 10-173-29 Cont'd

Two promises: I will put my Spirit within you for New Birth and I will pour out my Spirit upon you as an anointing for service in my name.

9:45 References to the Gift of the Holy Spirit. Acts 2:38, Acts 8:18-20; Acts 10:45; Acts 11:15-17.

10:00 The teaching moves from the Gift of the Spirit to the Spirit's Gifts. 1 Corinthians 12:1-6 covered in previous teaching (Part 1).

1 Corinthians 12:7 Teaching on "Manifest – Manifestation" (Greek - Phanerosis – G5321). You cannot see the Holy Spirit but only the manifestations of him (the symptoms of his activity). Reference John 3:8 The wind, Spirit, can't be seen, but you can see what it does and its effect.

Manifestations are evidences of the fact that the Spirit is actually within you and you are releasing him to overflow to others, to accomplish the good of God's will and purpose.

15:10 1 Corinthians 12:7-11 Reading and teaching. The manifestations of the Spirit are for the building up the body of Christ – Verse 7 - The Common Good. The scripture on the body of Christ (1 Corinthians 12:12-31), immediately follows the section on the manifestations of the Spirit.

18:10 Matthew 13:57-58 and Mark 6:1-6 Jesus unable to do any mighty works in his own hometown. It takes a yielded, faithful and trusting body of Christ to receive the manifestations.

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19:40 1 Corinthians 12:11 Reading and Teaching. The Spirit of God decides what manifestations will occur, through whom and when. Our responsibility is to be yielded and open to the Spirit.

20:45 1 Corinthians 12:8 Wisdom and knowledge. Teaching. Knowledge is information about something you need to know. Wisdom is Spiritual Insight which opens a whole new perspective on God's truth.

The person who has the Gift is the one who receives it, not the person through whom it is delivered. <u>Teaching and</u> <u>examples.</u>

24:30 Matthew 13:54 and Mark 6:2 Where did Jesus get his wisdom. Reference Isaiah 11:1-2 and Isaiah 42:1.

26:20 Jeremiah 23:22 The only way we can proclaim the correct word from God is if we stand in his council and hear it.

27:50 An example of wisdom in response to a question. The Peace that passes understanding lies in the path of God's plan for your life – and the fruit of the Spirit grows only in the garden of obedience.

29:15 1 Corinthians 12:9 Teaching on Faith as both a Fruit of the Spirit and also a Manifestation.

30:20 A teaching about Faith in the story of Elijah, Ahab and Jezebel Reference 1 Kings 17,18,19. And other examples.

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36:20 1 Corinthians 12:9 Gifts - Manifestations of Healing. Teaching. The person who has the gift of healing is the person who is healed.

42:35 1 Corinthians 12:10 Teaching on Miracles.

44:50 Closing remarks. God's purpose is worked out as we yield ourselves to him.

The Fruit of the Spirit begin to grow - The power of the Spirit begins to flow – The Manifestations of God's Spirit occur as the Lord wills - God's people are blessed, we are encouraged and the name of the Lord is glorified. John 14:16 And I will pray the Father, and he will give you another Counselor, to be with you for ever, <u>17</u> even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him; you know him, for he dwells with you, and will be in you.

<u>Phil. 2:5</u> Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, <u>6</u> who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, <u>7</u> but emptied himself, taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. <u>8</u> And being found in human form he humbled himself and became obedient unto death, even death on a cross. <u>9</u> Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name which is above every name, <u>10</u> that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, <u>11</u> and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

John 8:28 So Jesus said, "When you have lifted up the Son of man, then you will know that I am he, and that I do nothing on my own authority but speak thus as the Father taught me.

<u>Ezek. 36:26</u> A new heart I will give you, and a new spirit I will put within you; and I will take out of your flesh the heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh. <u>27</u> And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes and be careful to observe my ordinances.

Luke 24:49 And behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you; but stay in

the city, until you are clothed with power from on high."

<u>Acts 1:4</u> And while staying with them he charged them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the promise of the Father, which, he said, "you heard from me, 5 for John baptized with water, but before many days you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit."

<u>Acts 1:6</u> So when they had come together, they asked him, "Lord, will you at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?" <u>7</u> He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or seasons which the Father has fixed by his own authority. <u>8</u> But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria and to the end of the earth."

<u>Acts 2:16</u> but this is what was spoken by the prophet Joel: <u>17</u> 'And in the last days it shall be, God declares, that I will pour out my Spirit upon all flesh, and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams; <u>18</u> yea, and on my menservants and my maidservants in those days I will pour out my Spirit; and they shall prophesy.

<u>Joel 2:28</u> "And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit on all flesh; your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, and your young men shall see visions. <u>29</u> Even upon the menservants and maidservants in those days, I will pour out my spirit.

<u>Acts 2:38</u> And Peter said to them, "Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

<u>Acts 8:18</u> Now when Simon saw that the Spirit was given through the laying on of the apostles' hands, he offered them money, <u>19</u> saying, "Give me also this power, that any one on whom I lay my hands may receive the Holy Spirit." <u>20</u> But Peter said to him, "Your silver perish with you, because you thought you could obtain the gift of God with money!

<u>Acts 10:45</u> And the believers from among the circumcised who came with Peter were amazed, because the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out even on

the Gentiles.

<u>Acts 11:15</u> As I began to speak, the Holy Spirit fell on them just as on us at the beginning. <u>16</u> And I remembered the word of the Lord, how he said, 'John baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit.' <u>17</u> If then God gave the same gift to them as he gave to us when we believed in the Lord Jesus Christ, who was I that I could withstand God?"

<u>1Cor. 12:1</u> Now concerning spiritual gifts, brethren, I do not want you to be uninformed. <u>2</u> You know that when you were heathen, you were led astray to dumb idols, however you may have been moved. <u>3</u> Therefore I want you to understand that no one speaking by the Spirit of God ever says "Jesus be cursed!" and no one can say "Jesus is Lord" except by the Holy Spirit.

<u>1Cor. 12:4</u> Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; <u>5</u> and there are varieties of service, but the same Lord; <u>6</u> and there are varieties of working, but it is the same God who inspires them all in every one. <u>7</u> To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. <u>8</u> To one is given through the Spirit the utterance of wisdom, and to another the utterance of knowledge according to the same Spirit, <u>9</u> to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit, <u>10</u> to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another the ability to distinguish between spirits, to another various kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. <u>11</u> All these are inspired by one and the same Spirit, who apportions to each one individually as he wills.

John 3:8 The wind blows where it wills, and you hear the sound of it, but you do not know whence it comes or whither it goes; so it is with every one who is born of the Spirit."

<u>1Cor. 12:12</u> For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ. <u>13</u> For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body — Jews or Greeks, slaves or free — and all were made to drink of one Spirit.

<u>1Cor. 12:14</u> For the body does not consist of one member but of many. <u>15</u> If the foot should say, "Because I am not a hand, I do not belong to the body," that would not make it any less a part of the body. <u>16</u> And if the ear should

say, "Because I am not an eye, I do not belong to the body," that would not make it any less a part of the body. <u>17</u> If the whole body were an eye, where would be the hearing? If the whole body were an ear, where would be the sense of smell? <u>18</u> But as it is, God arranged the organs in the body, each one of them, as he chose. <u>19</u> If all were a single organ, where would the body be? <u>20</u> As it is, there are many parts, yet one body. <u>21</u> The eye cannot say to the hand, "I have no need of you," nor again the head to the feet, "I have no need of you." <u>22</u> On the contrary, the parts of the body which seem to be weaker are indispensable, <u>23</u> and those parts of the body which we think less honorable we invest with the greater honor, and our unpresentable parts are treated with greater modesty, <u>24</u> which our more presentable parts do not require. But God has so composed the body, giving the greater honor to the inferior part, <u>25</u> that there may be no discord in the body, but that the members may have the same care for one another. <u>26</u> If one member suffers, all suffer together; if one member is honored, all rejoice together.

<u>1Cor. 12:27</u> Now you are the body of Christ and individually members of it. <u>28</u> And God has appointed in the church first apostles, second prophets, third teachers, then workers of miracles, then healers, helpers, administrators, speakers in various kinds of tongues. <u>29</u> Are all apostles? Are all prophets? Are all teachers? Do all work miracles? <u>30</u> Do all possess gifts of healing? Do all speak with tongues? Do all interpret? <u>31</u> But earnestly desire the higher gifts.

And I will show you a still more excellent way.

<u>Matt. 13:57</u> And they took offense at him. But Jesus said to them, "A prophet is not without honor except in his own country and in his own house." <u>58</u> And he did not do many mighty works there, because of their unbelief.

<u>Mark 6:1</u> He went away from there and came to his own country; and his disciples followed him. <u>2</u> And on the sabbath he began to teach in the synagogue; and many who heard him were astonished, saying, "Where did this man get all this? What is the wisdom given to him? What mighty works are wrought by his hands! <u>3</u> Is not this the carpenter, the son of Mary and brother of James and Joses and Judas and Simon, and are not his sisters here with us?" And they took offense at him. <u>4</u> And Jesus said to them, "A prophet is not without honor, except in his own country, and among his own kin, and in his own house." <u>5</u> And he could do no mighty work there, except that he laid his

hands upon a few sick people and healed them. $\underline{6}$ And he marveled because of their unbelief.

And he went about among the villages teaching.

<u>Matt. 13:54</u> and coming to his own country he taught them in their synagogue, so that they were astonished, and said, "Where did this man get this wisdom and these mighty works?
