13-122-29 WORDS AND WISDOM THE GIFT OF THE SPIRIT AND THE SPIRIT'S GIFTS

:30 1 Corinthians 12:1-6 A variety of gifts, a variety of service, a variety of working, but the same Spirit. Terry gives a summary of the previous teaching on these verses.

:50 Believers will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. Reference to Acts 2:36-39; 8:14-17; 9:17-18; 10:44-48

2:05 John 3:34 God does not bestow the Spirit by measure. God gives the Spirit without limit. The Spirit filled life is really the overflowing life.

3:10 John 4:13-15 The water that Jesus gives will become a spring of water welling up to eternal life. Reference John 7:37-39 Out of you will flow rivers of water. By this he meant the Spirit, whom those who believed in him were to receive.

4:30 1 Corinthians 12:1-4 Teaching.

10:00 Ephesians 2:8-10 Saved by Grace, for the good works God has prepared for us to do (through the power of the indwelling Spirit, who enables us). Reference 1 Chronicles 29:14. All things come from God.

20:20 1 Corinthians 12:7-11 Teaching on the manifestations (Greek: phanerosis) of the Spirit. Reference John 3:8 The Spirit is like the wind. 2 Corinthians 4:2 Open statement- plain truth.

29:10 Deuteronomy 34:9 The Spirit of Wisdom. Reference Matthew 13:53-58. Where did Jesus get all that wisdom? Reference Isaiah 11:1-2. Reference Matthew 16:15-17.

37:50 1 Corinthians 12:9 Teaching on manifestation of faith and the manifestation of healing.

53:30 Job 13:15 Though he slay me, yet will I hope in him.

54:20 1 Corinthians 12:10-11 Teaching. Reference 1 Corinthians 14:1; Reference Ephesians 4:11.

1Cor. 12:1 Now concerning spiritual gifts, brethren, I do not want you to be uninformed. 2 You know that when you were heathen, you were led astray to dumb idols, however you may have been moved. 3 Therefore I want you to understand that no one speaking by the Spirit of God ever says “Jesus be cursed!” and no one can say “Jesus is Lord” except by the Holy Spirit.

1Cor. 12:4 Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; 5 and there are varieties of service, but the same Lord; 6 and there are varieties of working, but it is the same God who inspires them all in every one.

Acts 2:36 Let all the house of Israel therefore know assuredly that God has made him both Lord and Christ, this Jesus whom you crucified.”

Acts 2:37 Now when they heard this they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, “Brethren, what shall we do?” 38 And Peter said to them, “Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. 39 For the promise is to you and to your children and to all that are far off, every one whom the Lord our God calls to him.”

Acts 8:14 Now when the apostles at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of God, they sent to them Peter and John, 15 who came down and prayed for them that they might receive the Holy Spirit; 16 for it had not yet fallen on any of them, but they had only been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. 17 Then they laid their hands on them and they received the Holy Spirit.

Acts 9:17 So Ananias departed and entered the house. And laying his hands on him he said, “Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus who appeared to you on the road by which you came, has sent me that you may regain your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit.” 18 And immediately something like scales fell from his eyes and he regained his sight. Then he rose and was baptized,

Acts 10:44 While Peter was still saying this, the Holy Spirit fell on all who heard the word. 45 And the believers from among the circumcised who came with Peter were amazed, because the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out even on the Gentiles. 46 For they heard them speaking in tongues and extolling God. Then Peter declared, 47 “Can any one forbid water for baptizing these people who have received the Holy Spirit just as we have?” 48 And he

commanded them to be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. Then they asked him to remain for some days.

John 3:34 For he whom God has sent utters the words of God, for it is not by measure that he gives the Spirit;

John 4:13 Jesus said to her, “Every one who drinks of this water will thirst again, 14 but whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst; the water that I shall give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life.” 15 The woman said to him, “Sir, give me this water, that I may not thirst, nor come here to draw.”

John 7:37 On the last day of the feast, the great day, Jesus stood up and proclaimed, “If any one thirst, let him come to me and drink. 38 He who believes in me, as the scripture has said, ‘Out of his heart shall flow rivers of living water.’” 39 Now this he said about the Spirit, which those who believed in him were to receive; for as yet the Spirit had not been given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

1Chr. 29:14 “But who am I, and what is my people, that we should be able thus to offer willingly? For all things come from thee, and of thy own have we given thee.

1Cor. 12:7 To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. 8 To one is given through the Spirit the utterance of wisdom, and to

John 3:8 The wind blows where it wills, and you hear the sound of it, but you do not know whence it comes or whither it goes; so it is with every one who is born of the Spirit.”

Deut. 34:9 And Joshua the son of Nun was full of the spirit of wisdom, for Moses had laid his hands upon him; so the people of Israel obeyed him, and did as the LORD had commanded Moses.

Matt. 13:53 And when Jesus had finished these parables, he went away from there, 54 and coming to his own country he taught them in their synagogue, so that they were astonished, and said, “Where did this man get this wisdom and these mighty works? 55 Is not this the carpenter’s son? Is not his mother called Mary? And are not his brothers James and Joseph and Simon and Judas? 56 And are not all his sisters with us? Where then did this man get all this?” 57 And they took offense at him. But Jesus said to them, “A prophet is not without honor except in his own country and in his own house.” 58 And he did not do many mighty works there, because of their unbelief.

Is. 11:1 There shall come forth a shoot from the stump of Jesse, and a branch shall grow out of his roots. 2 And the Spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and the fear of the LORD.

Matt. 16:15 He said to them, “But who do you say that I am?” 16 Simon Peter replied, “You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.” 17 And Jesus answered him, “Blessed are you, Simon Bar-jona! For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my Father who is in heaven.

1Cor. 12:9 to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit,

Job 13:15 Behold, he will slay me; I have no hope; yet I will defend my ways to his face.

1Cor. 14:1 Make love your aim, and earnestly desire the spiritual gifts, especially that you may prophesy.
