# 11-054-38 UNEQUALLY YOKED (RSV)

- 1:00 Teaching on the blessings of God. Most are conditional and not automatic. Forgiveness, example from the Lord's prayer. Reference Matthew 6:12,14-15. The church is not the dispenser of God's blessings.
- 4:25 Galatians 5:22-23 The fruit of the Spirit is a picture of the attributes of Jesus. For us to manifest the fruit it is necessary to live the will and purpose of God in our lives. God's blessings are not available for purchase. Reference Acts 8:13-20 The blessing of God is free in the sense that you cannot purchase it but the blessings come at great cost.

The peace that passes understanding is found in the path of God's purpose for you and nowhere else. Reference Philippians 4:4-9.

Teaching on how to receive the fruit of the Spirit into our lives. Obedience to God's purpose for our lives.

- 11:00 Teaching on the cost of receiving God's blessings and the sense of his presence.
- 14:00 God anoints his servants with the Holy Spirit. Teaching on the Spirit and the power of the Spirit. If you want the blessing of God, you must walk in obedience.
  - 15:00 Teaching begins regarding marriage to unbelievers.
- 16:30 2 Corinthians 6:14-16 Do not be mismated with unbelievers. In this case teaching is related to marriage.

- 22:20 Romans 8:28 We know that in everything God works for good with those who love him, who are called according to his purpose.
- 23:10 John 14:16-17 There is a difference between the Christian and the world. Non-believers cannot receive the Spirit of Truth. It only becomes a gift when it is accepted.
- 26:30 2 Corinthians 6:14 What fellowship has light with darkness? Reference Colossians 1:13 We have been delivered from the kingdom of darkness into the kingdom of the Son. Believers and non-believers operate under different sovereignties.
- 27:10 Matthew 10:34-39 Jesus said that his presence would cause division among people; even dividing families.
- 28:50 2 Corinthians 6:14-16 Do not be mismated with unbelievers. For what partnership have righteousness and iniquity? Or what fellowship has light with darkness? 15 What accord has Christ with Belial? Or what has a believer in common with an unbeliever? 16 What agreement has the temple of God with idols? For we are the temple of the living God; as God said, "I will live in them and move among them, and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

- Matt. 6:12 And forgive us our debts, As we also have forgiven our debtors;
- Matt. 6:14 For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father also will forgive you; 15 but if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.
- <u>Gal. 5:22</u> But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <u>23</u> gentleness, self-control; against such there is no law.

The Lord is at hand. <u>6</u> Have no anxiety about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. <u>7</u> And the peace of God, which passes all understanding, will keep your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.
