(RSV)

2:50 John 15:16 Jesus said “You did not choose me, but I chose you.....”

11:50 John 14:15-17 Christians have the Holy Spirit within and the world does not. Teaching.

13:00 2 Corinthians 6:14-15 Do not be mismated with unbelievers. For what partnership have righteousness and iniquity? Or what fellowship has light with darkness? 15 What accord has Christ with Belial? Or what has a believer in common with an unbeliever? Teaching.

14:30 1 Corinthians 7:12-13. Teaching. Believers and unbelievers who are already married should not seek to divorce.

Teaching – the marriage represents to us the mystical union between Christ and His church.

16:20 Ephesians 5:21 Be subject to one another out of reverence for Christ. A vertical connection that impacts the horizontal connection. Jesus is the head. If there is a dispute over something, then one or both are not listening to the Lord. One mind and one heart (Peace) is evidence that the couple is submitted to Christ first.

19:40 Philippians 4:7 The peace that passes understanding. It is only found in the path of God's plan for your life and nowhere else. The peace is bestowed where the purpose is found.

Teaching on the application to the church body.
