# 06-230-46 ALL ABOUT JESUS

:00 – 6:00 Background on why Terry decided at this time (1976), to do this teaching on the Acts of the Apostles.

6:00 Acts is the second volume of a two volume work by Luke, the gentile writer. Often called the Acts of the Apostles, but could just as legitimately be called the Acts of the Holy Spirit. At 7:00 Terry mentions the ministry of Paul – it should have been Peter.

7:00 – 8:00 Terry explains that his presentation on Acts will not be so much a historical look at the early activity of the church, but rather a view of the book in the context of what the Holy Spirit is delivering to us today.

9:30 Luke 1:1-4 Teaching on Luke's perspective for writing the Gospel of Luke.

13:55 Acts 1:1-2 Luke sets up the volume "Acts" by reference back to his gospel.

15:40 Genesis 3:15 teaching on the "Proto Evangel"

17:50 Genesis 12:1-3 The first part of the Abrahamic covenant. Passed on to Abraham's descendants, Issac, Jacob (Israel), Judah and beyond.

19:55 Genesis 49:10 The coming Messiah will be from the tribe of Judah.

21:15 Jeremiah 23:5-6 There will come a time when a branch from David will come - his name shall be The Lord is Our Righteousness. Reference 1 Chronicles 22:10

24:00 Isaiah 9:6-7 A child who will grow to become Mighty God, Everlasting Father.

26:55 Micah 5:2 The one who will be the ruler of God's people will come out of Bethlehem Ephrathah – his origin is from ancient days.

35:35 Luke 24:50-53 Jesus, taken up to heaven is the last scene in Luke's gospel. Acts 1:1 begins with reference to that scene.

36:35 Acts 1:2 "after giving instructions" Reference Luke 24:44-49 Jesus opens the minds of the disciples so they will see that he is the subject of the Old Testament. They take in this truth as a matter of spiritual discernment, which goes further than mere human logic.

41:05 Ephesians 1:16-19 A prayer that others will receive the Spirit of wisdom and revelation; to know God more fully and to have the eyes of their hearts enlightened.

43:00 Luke 24:45-49 Jesus tells the disciples to wait for the power the Father promised before engaging in their ministry.

45:50 Acts 1:3-8 Jesus explains what is meant in Luke 24:49 ...what the Father has promised ...clothed with power from on high..... as being the baptism with (in) the Holy Spirit.

51:00 Ordinary men doing extraordinary things in the power of the Holy Spirit.

52:00 Isaiah 11:1-3; 42:1; 61:1 Jesus is the Messiah, the anointed one. Reference Acts 10:38.

<u>Luke 1:1</u> Inasmuch as many have undertaken to compile a narrative of the things which have been accomplished among us, <u>2</u> just as they were delivered to us by those who from the beginning were eyewitnesses and ministers of the word, <u>3</u> it seemed good to me also, having followed all things closely for some time past, to write an orderly account for you, most excellent The-ophilus, <u>4</u> that you may know the truth concerning the things of which you have been informed.

<u>Acts 1:1</u> In the first book, O The-ophilus, I have dealt with all that Jesus began to do and teach, <u>2</u> until the day when he was taken up, after he had given commandment through the Holy Spirit to the apostles whom he had chosen.

<u>Gen. 3:15</u> I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her seed; he shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise his heel."

<u>Gen. 12:1</u> Now the LORD said to Abram, "Go from your country and your kindred and your father's house to the land that I will show you. <u>2</u> And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you, and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. <u>3</u> I will bless those who bless you, and him who curses you I will curse; and by you all the families of the earth shall bless themselves."

<u>Gen. 49:10</u> The scepter shall not depart from Judah, nor the ruler's staff from between his feet, until he comes to whom it belongs; and to him shall be the obedience of the peoples.

Jer. 23:5 "Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will raise up for David a righteous Branch, and he shall reign as king and deal wisely, and shall execute justice and righteousness in the land. <u>6</u> In his days Judah will be saved, and Israel will dwell securely. And this is the name by which he will be called: 'The LORD is our righteousness.'

<u>1Chr. 22:10</u> He shall build a house for my name. He shall be my son, and I will be his father, and I will establish his royal throne in Israel for ever.'

<u>Is. 9:6</u> For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government will be upon his shoulder, and his name will be called "Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace." <u>7</u> Of the increase of his government

and of peace there will be no end, upon the throne of David, and over his kingdom, to establish it, and to uphold it with justice and with righteousness from this time forth and for evermore. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will do this.

<u>Mic. 5:2</u> But you, O Bethlehem Ephrathah, who are little to be among the clans of Judah, from you shall come forth for me one who is to be ruler in Israel, whose origin is from of old, from ancient days.

<u>Luke 24:50</u> Then he led them out as far as Bethany, and lifting up his hands he blessed them. <u>51</u> While he blessed them, he parted from them, and was carried up into heaven. <u>52</u> And they returned to Jerusalem with great joy, <u>53</u> and were continually in the temple blessing God.

<u>Acts 1:1</u> In the first book, O The-ophilus, I have dealt with all that Jesus began to do and teach, <u>2</u> until the day when he was taken up, after he had given commandment through the Holy Spirit to the apostles whom he had chosen.

<u>Eph. 1:16</u> I do not cease to give thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers, <u>17</u> that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give you a spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of him, <u>18</u> having the eyes of your hearts enlightened, that you may know what is the hope to which he has called you, what are the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints, <u>19</u> and what is the immeasurable greatness of his power in us who believe, according to the working of his great might

Luke 24:45 Then he opened their minds to understand the scriptures, <u>46</u> and said to them, "Thus it is written, that the Christ should suffer and on the third

day rise from the dead, <u>47</u> and that repentance and forgiveness of sins should be preached in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. <u>48</u> You are witnesses of these things. <u>49</u> And behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you; but stay in the city, until you are clothed with power from on high."

<u>Acts 1:3</u> To them he presented himself alive after his passion by many proofs, appearing to them during forty days, and speaking of the kingdom of God. <u>4</u> And while staying with them he charged them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the promise of the Father, which, he said, "you heard from me, <u>5</u> for John baptized with water, but before many days you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit."

<u>Acts 1:6</u> So when they had come together, they asked him, "Lord, will you at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?" <u>7</u> He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or seasons which the Father has fixed by his own authority. <u>8</u> But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria and to the end of the earth."

<u>Luke 24:49</u> And behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you; but stay in the city, until you are clothed with power from on high."

<u>Is. 11:1</u> There shall come forth a shoot from the stump of Jesse, and a branch shall grow out of his roots. <u>2</u> And the Spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and the fear of the LORD. <u>3</u> And his delight shall be in the fear of the LORD.

He shall not judge by what his eyes see, or decide by what his ears hear;

<u>Is. 42:1</u> Behold my servant, whom I uphold, my chosen, in whom my soul delights; I have put my Spirit upon him, he will bring forth justice to the nations.

<u>Is. 61:1</u> The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me, because the LORD has anointed me to bring good tidings to the afflicted; he has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound; <u>Acts 10:38</u> how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power; how he went about doing good and healing all that were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him.
