06-240-46 BEFORE THEIR VERY EYES

2:30 Acts 1:9-11 Teaching on the Ascension and Jesus' instruction to the disciples about his approaching death. Reference Matthew 16:23; Mark 8:33.

5:15 John 16:7 Jesus tells disciples that he must "go away" so that the Counselor may come to them. Reference John 14:15-17 The Counselor, the Spirit of truth will be with them forever. Reference Isaiah 9:6-7 Wonderful Counselor.

8:58 Philippians 1:19; Galatians 4:6 and Acts 16:7 The Spirit of Jesus. Present with us right now.

11:30 John 17:1-5 Jesus lifted his eyes toward heaven. Teaching on our spatial language as opposed to God's presence. Jesus glorified the Father by accomplishing the work he was given to do – that is the way we glorify God. The question is for each one of us – what does God want us to do? Reference Isaiah 53:6 – we have gone our own way.

17:20 Philippians 2:5-11 Jesus set aside his glory to do the will of the Father.

20:10 Matthew 20:20-28 Jesus teaches the disciples that self is not the be all end all. Reference Luke 22:24-27 Jesus is the one who serves.

26:00 Mark 9:3-8 The transfiguration. Jesus makes it clear that although our human nature would like to stay on the mountaintop, we are to live in the valley.

29:10 John 1:14 John saw the glory of God manifested. Reference 2 Peter 1:16-18 Peter testifies to seeing the Glorified Jesus.

30:55 John 17:4-5 Jesus had glorified the Father and now asks to return to the Glory in the Godhead. Reference Luke 24:39 a bodily ascension not just a spiritual one.

33:20 Colossians 1:19 All the fullness of God dwelled in Jesus.

36:10 Ephesians 1:16-23 May God give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, that you may know him better, and that your heart may be enlightened. 1. The hope to which he has called you, 2. The riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints, 3. The incomparably great power for those of us who believe. All these things come as a result of the resurrection of the Lord to His rightful place. Jesus in his person, is the message to us – not teachings but he himself. Reference Philippians 2:5-11

43:20 Ephesians 1:22 Jesus is the head of all things, even though it may not look like it. Reference Matthew 28:18. Teaching on the headship of Jesus. The church often acts like a spastic body. Jesus is actually head of all things in reality.

52:45 1 Corinthians 1:10 An appeal for unity. If Jesus is truly the active head of the church then unity would follow. Reference John 17:20-21. Jesus prays for unity.

55:30 Acts 1:9-11 reading and teaching. Reference to John 3:3-8
Being Born Again, Resurrection, and Ascension.

1:02:10 If we shine for the Lord it is a reflected light.

Acts 1:9 And when he had said this, as they were looking on, he was lifted up, and a cloud took him out of their sight. 10 And while they were gazing into heaven as he went, behold, two men stood by them in white robes, 11 and said, “Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into heaven? This Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will come in the same way as you saw him go into heaven.”

Matt. 16:23 But he turned and said to Peter, “Get behind me, Satan! You are a hindrance to me; for you are not on the side of God, but of men.”

Mark 8:33 But turning and seeing his disciples, he rebuked Peter, and said, “Get behind me, Satan! For you are not on the side of God, but of men.”

John 16:7 Nevertheless I tell you the truth: it is to your advantage that I go away, for if I do not go away, the Counselor will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you.

John 14:15 “If you love me, you will keep my commandments. 16 And I will pray the Father, and he will give you another Counselor, to be with you for ever, 17 even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him; you know him, for he dwells with you, and will be in you.

Is. 9:6 For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government will be upon his shoulder, and his name will be called “Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.” 7 Of the increase of his government and of peace there will be no end, upon the throne of David, and over his kingdom, to establish it, and to uphold it with justice and with righteousness from this time forth and for evermore. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will do this.

Phil. 1:19 Yes, and I shall rejoice. For I know that through your prayers and the help of the Spirit of Jesus Christ this will turn out for my deliverance,

Gal. 4:6 And because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, “Abba! Father!”

Acts 16:7 And when they had come opposite Mysia, they attempted to go into

Bithynia, but the Spirit of Jesus did not allow them;

John 17:1 When Jesus had spoken these words, he lifted up his eyes to heaven and said, "Father, the hour has come; glorify thy Son that the Son may glorify thee, 2 since thou hast given him power over all flesh, to give eternal life to all whom thou hast given him. 3 And this is eternal life, that they know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom thou hast sent. 4 I glorified thee on earth, having accomplished the work which thou gavest me to do; 5 and now, Father, glorify thou me in thy own presence with the glory which I had with thee before the world was made.

Is. 53:6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

She said to him, "Command that these two sons of mine may sit, one at your right hand and one at your left, in your kingdom." 22 But Jesus answered, "You do not know what you are asking. Are you able to drink the cup that I am to drink?" They said to him, "We are able." 23 He said to them, "You will drink my cup, but to sit at my right hand and at my left is not mine to grant, but it is for those for whom it has been prepared by my Father." 24 And when the ten heard it, they were indignant at the two brothers. 25 But Jesus called them to him and said, "You know that the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and their great men exercise authority over them. 26 It shall not be so among you; but whoever would be great among you must be your servant, 27 and whoever would be first among you must be your slave; 28 even as the Son of man came not to be served but to serve, and to

give his life as a ransom for many.”

Luke 22:24 A dispute also arose among them, which of them was to be regarded as the greatest. 25 And he said to them, “The kings of the Gentiles exercise lordship over them; and those in authority over them are called benefactors. 26 But not so with you; rather let the greatest among you become as the youngest, and the leader as one who serves. 27 For which is the greater, one who sits at table, or one who serves? Is it not the one who sits at table? But I am among you as one who serves.

Mark 9:3 and his garments became glistening, intensely white, as no fuller on earth could bleach them. 4 And there appeared to them Elijah with Moses; and they were talking to Jesus. 5 And Peter said to Jesus, “Master, it is well that we are here; let us make three booths, one for you and one for Moses and one for Elijah.” 6 For he did not know what to say, for they were exceedingly afraid. 7 And a cloud overshadowed them, and a voice came out of the cloud, “This is my beloved Son; listen to him.” 8 And suddenly looking around they no longer saw any one with them but Jesus only.

John 1:14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, full of grace and truth; we have beheld his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father.

2Pet. 1:16 For we did not follow cleverly devised myths when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but we were eyewitnesses of his majesty. 17 For when he received honor and glory from God the Father and the voice was borne to him by the Majestic Glory, “This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased,” 18 we heard this voice borne from heaven, for we were with him on the holy mountain.

John 17:4 I glorified thee on earth, having accomplished the work which thou gavest me to do; 5 and now, Father, glorify thou me in thy own presence with the glory which I had with thee before the world was made.

Luke 24:39 See my hands and my feet, that it is I myself; handle me, and see; for a spirit has not flesh and bones as you see that I have.”

Col. 1:19 For in him all the fulness of God was pleased to dwell,

Eph. 1:16 I do not cease to give thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers, 17 that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give you a spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of him, 18 having the eyes of your hearts enlightened, that you may know what is the hope to which he has called you, what are the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints, 19 and what is the immeasurable greatness of his power in us who believe, according to the working of his great might 20 which he accomplished in Christ when he raised him from the dead and made him sit at his right hand in the heavenly places, 21 far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and above every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come; 22 and he has put all things under his feet and has made him the head over all things for the church, 23 which is his body, the fulness of him who fills all in all.
