1:15 Acts 2:22-41 The first Apostolic preaching.  
Reference Matthew 28:18-20 Jesus told the disciples to go and make more disciples by teaching them the gospel message. (Not just an exhortation to encourage good living, but the full understanding as to what it means that God has intervened into the world).

There is a good deal of frequency interference on this recording. Most of the harsh interruptions have been eliminated but some words are missing.

7:25 Acts 2:14 "Men of Judea" as complimented with verse 22 "Men of Israel."

7:40 Acts 2:22-23 Jesus of Nazareth – the person - the core of the gospel. Reference Mark 1:1 The gospel about Jesus Christ, the Son of God.

8:50 Romans 1:1-3 The Gospel of Jesus Christ. At 9:15 there is an audio interference, sorry. Terry was making the point that the gospel is not a collection of morals that are to be imposed upon people, but a gospel that tells what God has done for the world. Changed behavior is the fruit of the gospel.

10:00 1 Corinthians 1:23 "but we preach Christ crucified".  
Reference 2 Corinthians 4:5 Paul says that what we preach is Jesus Christ as Lord.....

10:35 Acts 2:22 Jesus was a man credited by God, by what he did in obedience. Reference John 3:2 Nicodemus acknowledges Jesus' status before God.

12:20 Acts 2:23 Jesus suffered according to God's plan. A lamb slain from before creation. Reference Revelation 13:8, Isaiah 53:7.

16:20 Matthew 16:21-23 Jesus lets Peter know that his death is part of God's plan. The wickedness of man did not like the light of Jesus. The sovereignty of God and the free will of man, together in one verse.

18:30 Acts 2:24-28 God raised Jesus, confirming that his sacrifice was sufficient. Verses 25-28 are a memorized quote from Psalm 16. Teaching on the use of scripture by the disciples (the Septuagint – LXX – Greek translation of the Hebrew OT, some 250 years B.C.)

22:00 Acts 2:27 God will not leave the Holy One in the place of the dead. Reference Acts 3:14-15 God raised the Holy One from the dead.

23:30 Acts 2:29-33 Teaching. Verse 33, Reference John 14:16-17, 26; 15:26; 16:7 Peter in the Acts passage is speaking of the Holy Spirit coming to the disciples.

28:20 Acts 2:34-36 Teaching. Peter's boldness is a sure sign that the Holy Spirit is influencing him. Reference Luke 24:49; Acts 1:8. Jesus himself was under the anointing of the Holy Spirit as had been predicted in the OT. Isaiah 11:1-2, 42:1, 61:1. The Greek word for the anointed one is Christos.

33:00 Acts 10:38 Teaching. Peter testifies that Jesus was anointed with the Holy Spirit.

34:00 Acts 2:37 When the people heard the truth of the gospel, they responded "what shall we do?" The gospel proclaimed in the power of the Spirit should always lead people to change. Reference Jeremiah 23:16-22 Preaching after standing in the council of the Lord. Authentic ministry will change people, but it will often be a distressing ministry for the faithful Preacher/Teacher.

41:00 Acts 2:38. Peter's response to the question; What shall we do? Is to tell them to repent and be baptized. Reference Matthew 4:17 Jesus' first proclamation was "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is near." Reference Matthew 28:18-20.

47:00 Acts 2:38-41 .....and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. Reference 1 Corinthians 3:16-17; 6:19.

...For all whom the Lord our God will call. Teaching on calling and response.

1Cor. 1:23 but we preach Christ crucified, a stumbling block to Jews and folly to Gentiles,

2Cor. 4:5 For what we preach is not ourselves, but Jesus Christ as Lord, with ourselves as your servants for Jesus’ sake.

Matt. 16:21 From that time Jesus began to show his disciples that he must go to Jerusalem and suffer many things from the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and on the third day be raised. 22 And Peter took him and began to rebuke him, saying, "God forbid, Lord! This shall never happen to you." 23 But he turned and said to Peter, "Get behind me, Satan! You are a hindrance to me; for you are not on the side of God, but of men."

Acts 10:38 how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power; how he went about doing good and healing all that were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him.
