Scriptural References and Comment Notes

19-103-47 THE CALLED OF JESUS CHRIST

The teaching begins with some comments as to the relevancy of the book of Romans.

4:40 Romans 1:1-6 Reading and teaching.

10:18 John 5:46 Jesus says to his critics that if they believed Moses they would believe in him, for Moses wrote of him. Reference Luke 24:27 Jesus taught the disciples on the road to Emmaus all the things said about him from Moses and Prophets. Reference Luke 24:44-49 Jesus teaches his disciples what the scripture had to say about him. The scripture points to Jesus as the Messiah. From Romans 1:2 God had promised the gospel before Jesus came on the scene as the incarnate God.

12:20 Matthew 28:19-20 The great commission. Go into all the world and make disciples (learners). Reference Matthew 16:18 – Jesus said he would build his church.

14:00 Ezekiel 47:1-12 The water is coming forth out from the Temple of God and eventually it enters the Dead sea. When the water from the Temple enters the Dead sea everything comes alive. So it is with the overflowing life in the Spirit.

16:40 Mark 1:1 The Gospel is centered in and focused on Jesus Christ.

- 17:20 2 Corinthians 5:18-20 God initiated the entire process of reconciliation.
- 20:10 Reference to Isaiah 1:12-13 and 29:13 Meaningless offerings not of the heart.
- 21:05 Return to Romans 1:3-6 Jesus in human geneology is a descendant of David. Reference 1 Chronicles 17:11-14 Where the Lord promises David that he will establish one of his offspring as a king forever. God will be his father and the king will be his Son. Reference Matthew 21:9 Hosanna to the son of David. Reference Genesis 49:10 The Messiah will come from the tribe of Judah.
- 22:25 Return to Romans 1:4-6 Jesus is vindicated through the resurrection.
- 24:10 Romans 1:5-6 Reading. Through him we receive grace and apostleship. Reference to Ephesians 1:3-6 we are blessed with every spiritual blessing in Christ. Everything we need to fulfill his purpose for us is available in Christ.
- 30:35 Return to Romans 1:5-6. Teaching. Grace is unmerited favor a freely given gift of the Lord.
- 32:35 Romans 15:15-16 Paul explains his calling to proclaim the gospel. Reference Galatians 1:11-17 Paul was set apart in God's plan even before he was born. Reference Jeremiah 1:4-5, Jeremiah was also set apart from before his mother's womb. There is relevance to our lives we too have been called to good works which he has planned (Ephesians 2:10).

- 37:50 Ephesians 3:2-3, 7-9. Paul is called to the ministry by the Grace of God.
- 39:20 2 Corinthians 4:1 We should not lose heart in our ministry. God has given it to us by his grace. Grace and ministry coupled together.
- 47:20 Return to Romans 1:5-6 And you also are called to belong to Jesus Christ He is your Lord. Every believer has been called.

Rom. 1:1 Paul, a servant of Christ Jesus, called to be an apostle and set apart for the gospel of God— 2 the gospel he promised beforehand through his prophets in the Holy Scriptures 3 regarding his Son, who as to his human nature was a descendant of David, 4 and who through the Spirit of holiness was declared with power to be the Son of God by his resurrection from the dead: Jesus Christ our Lord. 5 Through him and for his name's sake, we received grace and apostleship to call people from among all the Gentiles to the obedience that comes from faith. 6 And you also are among those who are called to belong to Jesus Christ.

John 5:46 If you believed Moses, you would believe me, for he wrote about me.

<u>Luke 24:27</u> And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he explained to them what was said in all the Scriptures concerning himself.

<u>Luke 24:44</u> He said to them, "This is what I told you while I was still with you: Everything must be fulfilled that is written about me in the Law of Moses, the Prophets and the Psalms."

Luke 24:45 Then he opened their minds so they could understand the Scriptures. 46 He told them, "This is what is written: The Christ will suffer and rise from the dead on the third day, 47 and repentance and forgiveness of sins will be preached in his name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. 48 You are witnesses of these things. 49 I am going to send you what my Father has promised; but stay in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high."

Matt. 28:19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

Matt. 16:18 And I tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it.

Ezek. 47:1 The man brought me back to the entrance of the temple, and I saw water coming out from under the threshold of the temple toward the east (for the temple faced east). The water was coming down from under the south side

of the temple, south of the altar. 2 He then brought me out through the north gate and led me around the outside to the outer gate facing east, and the water was flowing from the south side.

As the man went eastward with a measuring line in his hand, he measured off a thousand cubits and then led me through water that was ankle-deep. 4 He measured off another thousand cubits and led me through water that was knee-deep. He measured off another thousand and led me through water that was up to the waist. 5 He measured off another thousand, but now it was a river that I could not cross, because the water had risen and was deep enough to swim in—a river that no one could cross. 6 He asked me, "Son of man, do you see this?"

Then he led me back to the bank of the river. 7 When I arrived there, I saw a great number of trees on each side of the river. 8 He said to me, "This water flows toward the eastern region and goes down into the Arabah, where it enters the Sea. When it empties into the Sea, the water there becomes fresh. 9 Swarms of living creatures will live wherever the river flows. There will be large numbers of fish, because this water flows there and makes the salt water fresh; so where the river flows everything will live. 10 Fishermen will stand along the shore; from En Gedi to En Eglaim there will be places for spreading nets. The fish will be of many kinds—like the fish of the Great Sea. 11 But the swamps and marshes will not become fresh; they will be left for salt. 12 Fruit trees of all kinds will grow on both banks of the river. Their leaves will not wither, nor will their fruit fail. Every month they will bear, because the water from the sanctuary flows to them. Their fruit will serve for food and their leaves for healing."

Mark 1:1 The beginning of the gospel about Jesus Christ, the Son of God.

<u>2Cor. 5:18</u> All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: <u>19</u> that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting men's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation. <u>20</u> We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God.

<u>Is. 1:12</u> When you come to appear before me,

who has asked this of you, this trampling of my courts?

Is. 1:13 Stop bringing meaningless offerings! Your incense is detestable to me.

New Moons, Sabbaths and convocations— I cannot bear your evil assemblies.

Is. 29:13 The Lord says:

"These people come near to me with their mouth and honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me.

Their worship of me is made up only of rules taught by men.

1Chr. 17:11 When your days are over and you go to be with your fathers, I will raise up your offspring to succeed you, one of your own sons, and I will establish his kingdom. 12 He is the one who will build a house for me, and I will establish his throne forever. 13 I will be his father, and he will be my son. I will never take my love away from him, as I took it away from your predecessor. 14 I will set him over my house and my kingdom forever; his throne will be established forever."

- Gen. 49:10 The scepter will not depart from Judah, nor the ruler's staff from between his feet, until he comes to whom it belongs and the obedience of the nations is his.

In love $\underline{5}$ he predestined us to be adopted as his sons through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his pleasure and will— $\underline{6}$ to the praise of his glorious grace, which he has freely given us in the One he loves.
- Rom. 15:15 I have written you quite boldly on some points, as if to remind you of them again, because of the grace God gave me 16 to be a minister of Christ Jesus to the Gentiles with the priestly duty of proclaiming the gospel of God, so that the Gentiles might become an offering acceptable to God, sanctified by the Holy Spirit.
- <u>Gal. 1:11</u> I want you to know, brothers, that the gospel I preached is not something that man made up. <u>12</u> I did not receive it from any man, nor was I taught it; rather, I received it by revelation from Jesus Christ.
- Gal. 1:13 For you have heard of my previous way of life in Judaism, how intensely I persecuted the church of God and tried to destroy it. 14 I was advancing in Judaism beyond many Jews of my own age and was extremely zealous for the traditions of my fathers. 15 But when God, who set me apart from birth and called me by his grace, was pleased 16 to reveal his Son in me so that I might preach him among the Gentiles, I did not consult any man, 17 nor did I go up to Jerusalem to see those who were apostles before I was, but I

went immediately into Arabia and later returned to Damascus.

- <u>Jer. 1:4</u> The word of the LORD came to me, saying,
- Jer. 1:5

 "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I set you apart;
 I appointed you as a prophet to the nations."
- Eph. 2:10 For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.
- Eph. 3:2 Surely you have heard about the administration of God's grace that was given to me for you, 3 that is, the mystery made known to me by revelation, as I have already written briefly.
- Eph. 3:7 I became a servant of this gospel by the gift of God's grace given me through the working of his power. <u>8</u> Although I am less than the least of all God's people, this grace was given me: to preach to the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ, <u>9</u> and to make plain to everyone the administration of this mystery, which for ages past was kept hidden in God, who created all things.
- <u>2Cor. 4:1</u> Therefore, since through God's mercy we have this ministry, we do not lose heart.
- Rom. 1:5 Through him and for his name's sake, we received grace and apostleship to call people from among all the Gentiles to the obedience that comes from faith. 6 And you also are among those who are called to belong to lesus Christ.
