12-013-48 TILL CHRIST BE FORMED IN US (RSV)

- :00-4:10 Galatians is an epistle with urgency against false teachers and doctrine; which had so quickly invaded Christendom. The problem is even more so today. The doctrine of Jesus PLUS something else. In the Galatian days it was circumcision and the ceremonial law of Judaism added to the Christ. Reference Genesis 17:10-14.
- 4:10 Galatians 2:15-16 The core of Paul's message in the letter to those in Galatia. Paul can hardly believe the gullibility of the Galatian believers. Reference Galatians 1:6 "I am astonished...that you are turning to a different gospel" Reference Galatians 3:1 "You are foolish". Reference Galatians 4:11 "I am afraid I have labored over you in vain" Reference Galatians 4:20I am perplexed about you.
- 7:05 Galatians 4:12 Teaching on Paul using the term "Brethren" in reference to Gentiles. He has contrary emotions about those he had encouraged to faith. Reference Galatians 4:19 "My little children".
- 9:00 Galatians 4:12 Brethren, I beseech you, become as I am, for I also have become as you are. Teaching People have a right to expect something more from a Christian. Reference James 2:17.

- 10:55 Teaching. If we claim to be filled with the Holy Spirit, there ought to be more peace in our life, more love, more joy, more power for the coping with life. Reference 2 Timothy 3:10 Now you have observed my teaching, my conduct, my aim in life, my faith, my patience, my love, my steadfastness, Teaching Paul wants Timothy to reflect on the change Christ has made in his life. Reference Matthew 5:16
- 12:40 Acts 26:28-29 Paul says that he wishes others would become what he had become through the transformed life in Christ. Teaching.
- 15:00 Philippians 2:5-8 When God wanted to do something for us, he didn't send an angel, he came himself and became one of us.
- 16:00 Galatians 4:12-15 Teaching. What was Paul's physical ailment? Perhaps it was an unsightly eye disease. Reference Galatians 6:11.
- 20:25 2 Corinthians 12:7-10 And to keep me from being too elated by the abundance of revelations, a thorn was given me in the flesh, a messenger of Satan, to harass me, to keep me from being too elated (conceited, proud).

Teaching. My Grace is sufficient for you and God's power is perfected by man's weakness. Reference Job 13:15 Though he slay me, yet will I trust in him;

Teaching – faith is not quantitative. Reference Matthew 17:20. Not the amount of faith but the object of our faith.

Teaching on healing.

37:45 Galatians 4:13-15 Paul says that the Galatians had originally accepted him as an angel of God, as Christ Jesus. Reference Matthew 10:40

38:50 Galatians 4:16 Have I then become your enemy by telling you the truth? Reference 2 Timothy 4:3 For the time is coming when people will not endure sound teaching, but having itching ears they will accumulate for themselves teachers to suit their own likings,

40:05 Galatians 4:17-18 Teaching.

Reference 2 Corinthians 11:2 Paul said he presented them to Christ as a pure bride and he was jealous that they were squandering their affections on other things.. Teaching. Reference Colossians 1:28 Paul wants to present everyone mature in Christ.

A calling to prepare mature Christians who can and will cultivate a Christian faith in others. Prepare folks to be able to feed themselves and not be always dependent on someone else to provide their spiritual nurture.

- Gen. 17:10 This is my covenant, which you shall keep, between me and you and your descendants after you: Every male among you shall be circumcised. 11 You shall be circumcised in the flesh of your foreskins, and it shall be a sign of the covenant between me and you. 12 He that is eight days old among you shall be circumcised; every male throughout your generations, whether born in your house, or bought with your money from any foreigner who is not of your offspring, 13 both he that is born in your house and he that is bought with your money, shall be circumcised. So shall my covenant be in your flesh an everlasting covenant. 14 Any uncircumcised male who is not circumcised in the flesh of his foreskin shall be cut off from his people; he has broken my covenant."
- <u>Gal. 2:15</u> We ourselves, who are Jews by birth and not Gentile sinners, <u>16</u> yet who know that a man is not justified by works of the law but through faith in Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Christ Jesus, in order to be justified by faith in Christ, and not by works of the law, because by works of the law shall no one be justified.
- <u>Gal. 1:6</u> I am astonished that you are so quickly deserting him who called you in the grace of Christ and turning to a different gospel —
- Gal. 3:1 O foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you, before whose eyes Jesus Christ was publicly portrayed as crucified?

- James 2:17 So faith by itself, if it has no works, is dead.
