# 12-035-48 WORKS OF THE FLESH (RSV)

2:00 Galatians 5:16-21 Reading. Teaching

3:50 Galatians 5:17 For the desires of the flesh (sarx) are against the Spirit, and the desires of the Spirit are against the flesh (sarx); for these are opposed to each other, to prevent you from doing what you would.

Teaching on the predisposition of thinking of the word flesh in an incomplete way. Teaching on the incursion of Platonic philosophy into the Western church. Teaching on the differentiation between the Greek words (sarx G4561 – our unredeemed human nature, and soma G4983).

11:20 Romans 8:5-8 For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit set their minds on the things of the Spirit. 6 To set the mind on the flesh is death, but to set the mind on the Spirit is life and peace. 7 For the mind that is set on the flesh is hostile to God; it does not submit to God's law, indeed it cannot; 8 and those who are in the flesh cannot please God.

Teaching. The work of the unregenerate person is not pleasing to God. Reference Isaiah 64:6 Even the righteous acts of man are as filthy rags to the Lord.

15:10 John 14:16-17 And I will pray the Father, and he will give you another Counselor, to be with you for ever, 17 even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him; you know him, for he dwells with you, and will be in you.

Teaching on the dynamic of relationships between the redeemed and natural people. Reference Romans 5:7-8

- 17:30 1 Corinthians 3:1-3 ff There are not only two types of people: People of the flesh (natural man) and people of the Spirit (Spiritual man); but a third type. Carnal Christians the Spirit of God dwells in them but they do not live by the Spirit. They follow their own wills and not the will of God they are un-submitted.
- 19:25 Galatians 5:18 But if you are led by the Spirit you are not under the law. Teaching Reference Galatians 5:23b against such there is no law.
- 20:15 Galatians 5:19-21 Now the works of the flesh are plain: fornication, impurity, licentiousness, <u>20</u> idolatry, sorcery, enmity, strife, jealousy, anger, selfishness, dissension, party spirit, <u>21</u> envy, drunkenness, carousing, and the like. I warn you, as I warned you before, that those who do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.

**Teaching** 

- Gal. 5:16 But I say, walk by the Spirit, and do not gratify the desires of the flesh. 17 For the desires of the flesh are against the Spirit, and the desires of the Spirit are against the flesh; for these are opposed to each other, to prevent you from doing what you would. 18 But if you are led by the Spirit you are not under the law. 19 Now the works of the flesh are plain: fornication, impurity, licentiousness, 20 idolatry, sorcery, enmity, strife, jealousy, anger, selfishness, dissension, party spirit, 21 envy, drunkenness, carousing, and the like. - <u>Is. 64:6</u> We have all become like one who is unclean, and all our righteous deeds are like a polluted garment. We all fade like a leaf, and our iniquities, like the wind, take us away.
- John 14:16 And I will pray the Father, and he will give you another Counselor, to be with you for ever, 17 even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him; you know him, for he dwells with you, and will be in you.
- Rom. 5:7 Why, one will hardly die for a righteous man though perhaps for a good man one will dare even to die. 8 But God shows his love for us in that while we were yet sinners Christ died for us.
- <u>1Cor. 3:1</u> But I, brethren, could not address you as spiritual men, but as men of the flesh, as babes in Christ. <u>2</u> I fed you with milk, not solid food; for you were not ready for it; and even yet you are not ready, <u>3</u> for you are still of the flesh. For while there is jealousy and strife among you, are you not of the flesh, and behaving like ordinary men?
- <u>Gal. 5:18</u> But if you are led by the Spirit you are not under the law. <u>19</u> Now the works of the flesh are plain: fornication, impurity, licentiousness, 20 idolatry,

sorcery, enmity, strife, jealousy, anger, selfishness, dissension, party spirit,  $\underline{21}$  envy, drunkenness, carousing, and the like. I warn you, as I warned you before, that those who do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.
