## FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT (RSV)

1:20 Galatians 5:16-23 Reading. Recap of previous session on verses 16-21 and teaching on Life in the Spirit.

5:40 John 3:3-8. Jesus teaches Nicodemus about the Spirit.

6:15 1 Corinthians 1:18-21 The ways of God are as foolishness to the world, (the natural mind).

7:30 Romans 8:5 For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit set their minds on the things of the Spirit. Teaching.

9:35 Romans 8:6 To set the mind on the flesh is death,  
but to set the mind on the Spirit is life and peace. Teaching.

10:20 Romans 8:7-8 For the mind that is set on the flesh is hostile to God; it does not submit to God's law, indeed it cannot; 8 and those who are in the flesh cannot please God. Teaching.

11:30 1 Samuel 16:7 The Lord does not look at the things man looks at. Man looks at the outward appearances, but the Lord looks on the heart. Teaching. Who is the sovereign of your life – The Lord or You? Teaching.

16:00 Teaching on religion. Most churches avoid bringing people to the place where they have to confront a God who wants to change their natural fleshly lives to a Spirit led life. The modern church seldom confronts the flesh with a need for death. Reference Galatians 2:20 and Galatians 5:24. Paul talks of the need for death to self (flesh). Reference Matthew 16:24 Then Jesus told his disciples, "If any man would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me. Teaching on the reality of what the cross represents.

19:20 Romans 8:7-8 Teaching on the flesh (natural man) being hostile to God Doing one's own will instead of God's will.

21:10 Galatians 5:22-23 Teaching regarding the fruit (singular) as opposed to the "works" of the flesh (plural) in verse 19.

Life lived in the "natural" way will be fractured and in a state of dis-ease; whereas life in the Spirit will be fully integrated and whole. Life is either together or not together.

23:40 Galatians 5:22-23 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control; against such there is no law.

Love: Reference Romans 5:5 God's love poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit. Teaching on the usage of three Greek words translated in English as "love". Eros, Phileo, Agapoa.

27:40 1 Corinthians 13:4-7 Teaching on some of the qualities of love.

32:20 Galatians 5:22-23 Peace: Teaching – Peace with God and peace with neighbors. Reference Romans 12:18

33:20 Galatians 5:22-23 Joy: Teaching. Joy is not the same as happiness. Happiness often is dependent upon the circumstances. Joy is a provision yielding to the Holy Spirit.

34:05 Galatians 5:22-23 Patience: Patience is God's way; impatience is rebellion.

35:30 Galatians 5:22-23 Kindness: A social component – kindness towards others.

Goodness: Internal attitude and motivation to help build up another person. Don't add weights to another person's life. Invest yourself in lifting burdens from others.

36:55 Galatians 5:22-23 Faithfulness: Implicit trust in the Lord. Taking God at his word and a willingness to act upon it. Reference Proverbs 3:5-6 Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not rely on your own insight. 6 In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths.

37:55 Galatians 5:22-23 Gentleness: Meekness – a teachable spirit. The opposite of gentleness is arrogance – an un-teachable spirit. Gentleness does not try and manipulate and dominate.

39:00 Galatians 5:22-23 Self-Control: Temperance. Moderation in all good things and abstinence from all bad things. Teaching.

39:50 The Fruit of the Spirit is the character of Christ. We are to fertilize the garden that produces that fruit. A ministry done in the power of the Spirit will exhibit the fruit of the Spirit. In our lives, is there more fruit than last year?

Gal. 5:16 But I say, walk by the Spirit, and do not gratify the desires of the flesh. 17 For the desires of the flesh are against the Spirit, and the desires of the Spirit are against the flesh; for these are opposed to each other, to prevent you from doing what you would. 18 But if you are led by the Spirit you are not under the law. 19 Now the works of the flesh are plain: fornication, impurity, licentiousness, 20 idolatry, sorcery, enmity, strife, jealousy, anger, selfishness, dissension, party spirit, 21 envy, drunkenness, carousing, and the like. I warn you, as I warned you before, that those who do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God. 22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control; against such there is no law.

John 3:3 Jesus answered him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born anew, he cannot see the kingdom of God." 4 Nicodemus said to him, "How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born?" 5 Jesus answered, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God. 6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. 7 Do not marvel that I said to you, 'You must be born anew.' 8 The wind blows where it wills, and you hear the sound of it, but you do not know whence it comes or whither it goes; so it is with every one who is born of the Spirit."

1Cor. 1:18 For the word of the cross is folly to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. 19 For it is written, "I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, and the cleverness of the clever I will thwart." 20 Where is the wise man? Where is the scribe? Where is the debater of this age? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of the world? 21 For since, in the wisdom of God, the world did not know God through wisdom, it pleased God through the folly of what we preach to save those who believe.

Gal. 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me; and the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

Gal. 5:24 And those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.

Matt. 16:24 Then Jesus told his disciples, “If any man would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me.

Rom. 12:18 If possible, so far as it depends upon you, live peaceably with all.
