15-145-49 Ephesians 1:3-10

CHOSEN AND PREDESTINED

2:40 Ephesians 1:3-10 presents a condensed teaching of the Christian message.

5:00 Deuteronomy 8:17-18. No matter what status, wealth or power, we have attained in our life, it must be remembered that we are not to take credit or pride – for the Lord makes it all possible.

6:20 Deuteronomy 28. Most of the promises of God are "Conditional" promises, tied to the obedience of his people. Much of what the Lord would provide is withheld because of disobedience.

11:00 Many of the blessings in the Old Testament were physical and material in composition, but the blessings in the New Testament are mostly "Spiritual".

24:00 Romans 8:30. God did not force the decision, he allowed man's free will to function, yet, He foreknew those who would accept Him and He chose those who chose Him - to be called and justified.

26:30 Ephesians 1:4-5. He chose us to be holy and blameless, and in the pattern of Jesus, that we should come into His family. Are we like Jesus? We are only holy and blameless

because of our position in Christ – not as a result our own merit. The question is – Do we want to be conformed ?

38:40 Galatians 4: 4-7. We who are in Christ have been chosen as heirs and we have received God's Spirit as an advance, an earnest deposit, of that total inheritance.

42:00 Ephesians 1:6 The Spiritual blessing of Grace – The greatest is, the gift of his Son.

51:30 Ephesians 1:10 God's ultimate plan – to bring everything under the Head – Jesus Christ.

<u>Eph. 1:3</u> Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ. <u>4</u> For he chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight. In love <u>5</u> he predestined us to be adopted as his sons through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his pleasure and will— <u>6</u> to the praise of his glorious grace, which he has freely given us in the One he loves. <u>7</u> In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace <u>8</u> that he lavished on us with all wisdom and understanding. <u>9</u> And he made known to us the mystery of his will according to his good pleasure, which he purposed in Christ, <u>10</u> to be put into effect when the times will have reached their fulfillment—to bring all things in heaven and on earth together under one head, even Christ.

<u>Deut. 8:17</u> You may say to yourself, "My power and the strength of my hands have produced this wealth for me." <u>18</u> But remember the LORD your God, for it is he who gives you the ability to produce wealth, and so confirms his covenant, which he swore to your forefathers, as it is today.

<u>Deut. 28:1</u> If you fully obey the LORD your God and carefully follow all his commands I give you today, the LORD your God will set you high above all the nations on earth. <u>2</u> All these blessings will come upon you and accompany you if you obey the LORD your God:

<u>Deut. 28:3</u> You will be blessed in the city and blessed in the country.

<u>Deut. 28:4</u> The fruit of your womb will be blessed, and the crops of your land and the young of your livestock—the calves of your herds and the lambs of your flocks.

<u>Deut. 28:5</u> Your basket and your kneading trough will be blessed.

Deut. 28:6 You will be blessed when you come in and blessed when you go out.

<u>Deut. 28:7</u> The LORD will grant that the enemies who rise up against you will be defeated before you. They will come at you from one direction but flee from you in seven.

<u>Deut. 28:8</u> The LORD will send a blessing on your barns and on everything you put your hand to. The LORD your God will bless you in the land he is giving you.

<u>Deut. 28:9</u> The LORD will establish you as his holy people, as he promised you on oath, if you keep the commands of the LORD your God and walk in his ways. <u>10</u> Then all the peoples on earth will see that you are called by the name of the LORD, and they will fear you. <u>11</u> The LORD will grant you abundant prosperity—in the fruit of your womb, the young of your livestock and the crops of your ground—in the land he swore to your forefathers to give you.

<u>Deut. 28:12</u> The LORD will open the heavens, the storehouse of his bounty, to send rain on your land in season and to bless all the work of your hands. You will lend to many nations but will borrow from none. <u>13</u> The LORD will make you the head, not the tail. If you pay attention to the commands of the LORD your God that I give you this day and carefully follow them, you will always be at the top, never at the bottom. <u>14</u> Do not turn aside from any of the commands I give you today, to the right or to the left, following other gods and serving them.

<u>Deut. 28:15</u> However, if you do not obey the LORD your God and do not carefully follow all his commands and decrees I am giving you today, all these curses will come upon you and overtake you:

<u>Deut. 28:19</u> you go out.	You will be cursed when you come in and cursed when

<u>Deut. 28:20</u> The LORD will send on you curses, confusion and rebuke in everything you put your hand to, until you are destroyed and come to sudden ruin because of the evil you have done in forsaking him. <u>21</u> The LORD will

plague you with diseases until he has destroyed you from the land you are entering to possess. <u>22</u> The LORD will strike you with wasting disease, with fever and inflammation, with scorching heat and drought, with blight and mildew, which will plague you until you perish. <u>23</u> The sky over your head will be bronze, the ground beneath you iron. <u>24</u> The LORD will turn the rain of your country into dust and powder; it will come down from the skies until you are destroyed.

<u>Deut. 28:25</u> The LORD will cause you to be defeated before your enemies. You will come at them from one direction but flee from them in seven, and you will become a thing of horror to all the kingdoms on earth. <u>26</u> Your carcasses will be food for all the birds of the air and the beasts of the earth, and there will be no one to frighten them away. <u>27</u> The LORD will afflict you with the boils of Egypt and with tumors, festering sores and the itch, from which you cannot be cured. <u>28</u> The LORD will afflict you with madness, blindness and confusion of mind. <u>29</u> At midday you will grope about like a blind man in the dark. You will be unsuccessful in everything you do; day after day you will be oppressed and robbed, with no one to rescue you.

<u>Deut. 28:30</u> You will be pledged to be married to a woman, but another will take her and ravish her. You will build a house, but you will not live in it. You will plant a vineyard, but you will not even begin to enjoy its fruit. <u>31</u> Your ox will be slaughtered before your eyes, but you will eat none of it. Your donkey will be forcibly taken from you and will not be returned. Your sheep will be given to your enemies, and no one will rescue them. <u>32</u> Your sons and daughters will be given to another nation, and you will wear out your eyes watching for them day after day, powerless to lift a hand. <u>33</u> A people that you do not know will eat what your land and labor produce, and you will have nothing but cruel oppression all your days. <u>34</u> The sights you see will drive you mad. <u>35</u> The LORD will afflict your knees and legs with painful boils that cannot be cured, spreading from the soles of your feet to the top of your head.

<u>Deut. 28:36</u> The LORD will drive you and the king you set over you to a nation unknown to you or your fathers. There you will worship other gods, gods of wood and stone. <u>37</u> You will become a thing of horror and an object of scorn and ridicule to all the nations where the LORD will drive you.

Deut. 28:38 You will sow much seed in the field but you will harvest little,

because locusts will devour it. <u>39</u> You will plant vineyards and cultivate them but you will not drink the wine or gather the grapes, because worms will eat them. <u>40</u> You will have olive trees throughout your country but you will not use the oil, because the olives will drop off. <u>41</u> You will have sons and daughters but you will not keep them, because they will go into captivity. <u>42</u> Swarms of locusts will take over all your trees and the crops of your land.

<u>Deut. 28:43</u> The alien who lives among you will rise above you higher and higher, but you will sink lower and lower. <u>44</u> He will lend to you, but you will not lend to him. He will be the head, but you will be the tail.

<u>Deut. 28:45</u> All these curses will come upon you. They will pursue you and overtake you until you are destroyed, because you did not obey the LORD your God and observe the commands and decrees he gave you. <u>46</u> They will be a sign and a wonder to you and your descendants forever. <u>47</u> Because you did not serve the LORD your God joyfully and gladly in the time of prosperity, <u>48</u> therefore in hunger and thirst, in nakedness and dire poverty, you will serve the enemies the LORD sends against you. He will put an iron yoke on your neck until he has destroyed you.

<u>Deut. 28:49</u> The LORD will bring a nation against you from far away, from the ends of the earth, like an eagle swooping down, a nation whose language you will not understand, <u>50</u> a fierce–looking nation without respect for the old or pity for the young. <u>51</u> They will devour the young of your livestock and the crops of your land until you are destroyed. They will leave you no grain, new wine or oil, nor any calves of your herds or lambs of your flocks until you are ruined. <u>52</u> They will lay siege to all the cities throughout your land until the high fortified walls in which you trust fall down. They will besiege all the cities throughout the land the LORD your God is giving you.

<u>Deut. 28:53</u> Because of the suffering that your enemy will inflict on you during the siege, you will eat the fruit of the womb, the flesh of the sons and daughters the LORD your God has given you. <u>54</u> Even the most gentle and sensitive man among you will have no compassion on his own brother or the wife he loves or his surviving children, <u>55</u> and he will not give to one of them any of the flesh of his children that he is eating. It will be all he has left because of the suffering your enemy will inflict on you during the siege of all your cities. <u>56</u> The most gentle and sensitive woman among you—so sensitive

and gentle that she would not venture to touch the ground with the sole of her foot—will begrudge the husband she loves and her own son or daughter <u>57</u> the afterbirth from her womb and the children she bears. For she intends to eat them secretly during the siege and in the distress that your enemy will inflict on you in your cities.

<u>Deut. 28:58</u> If you do not carefully follow all the words of this law, which are written in this book, and do not revere this glorious and awesome name—the LORD your God— <u>59</u> the LORD will send fearful plagues on you and your descendants, harsh and prolonged disasters, and severe and lingering illnesses. <u>60</u> He will bring upon you all the diseases of Egypt that you dreaded, and they will cling to you. <u>61</u> The LORD will also bring on you every kind of sickness and disaster not recorded in this Book of the Law, until you are destroyed. <u>62</u> You who were as numerous as the stars in the sky will be left but few in number, because you did not obey the LORD your God. <u>63</u> Just as it pleased the LORD to make you prosper and increase in number, so it will please him to ruin and destroy you. You will be uprooted from the land you are entering to possess.

<u>Deut. 28:64</u> Then the LORD will scatter you among all nations, from one end of the earth to the other. There you will worship other gods—gods of wood and stone, which neither you nor your fathers have known. <u>65</u> Among those nations you will find no repose, no resting place for the sole of your foot. There the LORD will give you an anxious mind, eyes weary with longing, and a despairing heart. <u>66</u> You will live in constant suspense, filled with dread both night and day, never sure of your life. <u>67</u> In the morning you will say, "If only it were evening!" and in the evening, "If only it were morning!"—because of the terror that will fill your hearts and the sights that your eyes will see. <u>68</u> The LORD will send you back in ships to Egypt on a journey I said you should never make again. There you will offer yourselves for sale to your enemies as male and female slaves, but no one will buy you.

<u>Rom. 8:30</u> And those he predestined, he also called; those he called, he also justified; those he justified, he also glorified.

<u>Gal. 4:4</u> But when the time had fully come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under law, 5 to redeem those under law, that we might receive the full rights of sons. <u>6</u> Because you are sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our

hearts, the Spirit who calls out, *"Abba*, Father." <u>7</u> So you are no longer a slave, but a son; and since you are a son, God has made you also an heir.
