16-040-49 Ephesians 2:19-22

THE CHURCH THAT JESUS BUILDS

- 3:00 2 Chronicles 6:18 Will God dwell with man on earth.
- 4:00 Isaiah 59:2 Your sins have built a wall of separation between you and your God.
- 4:40 Exodus 29:44 The Lord will consecrate a tent of meeting and dwell among his people.
- 8:00 Exodus 40:34 The Tabernacle (symbolic dwelling place of God) was filled with God's glory. But it was shrouded in a cloud and Moses could not enter. It was God but at a distance from intimacy which would come later.
- 10:00 1 Chronicles 17:11-12 Davidic Covenant His son will build a temple for the Lord and will be a king but a twofold outworking of the promise is established. The immediate outworking came from David's son Solomon but a future descendent will come and will have a kingdom forever and will be the Temple Himself (Jesus). The prophecy given 900 years before Christ.

- 16:00 2 Chronicles 7: 1-2 The Holy of Holies The Glory of the Lord filled the Temple and as with the earlier Tabernacle entrance was prevented because the Glory filled the space.
- 17:00 Jeremiah 23:5 The righteous "Branch" (uppercase) is predicted. Over 500 years before Christ.
- 19:00 Zechariah 6:12 Here is the man whose name is the "Branch" and he will build the Temple of the Lord. 400 years before Christ but some 500 years after Solomon built the physical temple. So it must have been predicting some other temple to come. The predictions are becoming more and more specific as time moves toward Jesus.
- 23:40 John 2:19-21 Jesus said destroy the Temple and I will raise it again in three days. He was speaking of his body the real dwelling place of God (Temple).
- 30:20 Ephesians 3:12 In Jesus we can approach God with confidence not as in the former days when God was much more distant.
- 37:20 1 Peter 2:5 God's new Temple His people, the Church, is built of living stones into a Spiritual house. Stones, not bricks. Bricks are all the same color, size, shape etc. but stones are all different. Bricks are mortared together by placing a layer and then adding mortar, but stones are mortised together by fitting different shapes into a cohesive bond.
- 39:22 Matthew 5:16-17 Out of the new Temple (believers/followers) is to flow God's glory Jesus said let your Light so shine that God will be praised and glorified.

- Eph. 2:19 Consequently, you are no longer foreigners and aliens, but fellow citizens with God's people and members of God's household, 20 built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the chief cornerstone. 21 In him the whole building is joined together and rises to become a holy temple in the Lord. 22 And in him you too are being built together to become a dwelling in which God lives by his Spirit.
- <u>2Chr. 6:18</u> "But will God really dwell on earth with men? The heavens, even the highest heavens, cannot contain you. How much less this temple I have built!
- Is. 59:2 But your iniquities have separated you from your God; your sins have hidden his face from you, so that he will not hear.
- Ex. 29:44 "So I will consecrate the Tent of Meeting and the altar and will consecrate Aaron and his sons to serve me as priests.
- Ex. 40:34 Then the cloud covered the Tent of Meeting, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle.
- <u>1Chr. 17:11</u> When your days are over and you go to be with your fathers, I will raise up your offspring to succeed you, one of your own sons, and I will establish his kingdom. <u>12</u> He is the one who will build a house for me, and I will establish his throne forever.
- 2Chr. 7:1 When Solomon finished praying, fire came down from heaven and consumed the burnt offering and the sacrifices, and the glory of the LORD filled the temple. 2 The priests could not enter the temple of the LORD because the glory of the LORD filled it.
- Jer. 23:5 "The days are coming," declares the LORD,
 "when I will raise up to David a righteous Branch,
 a King who will reign wisely
 and do what is just and right in the land.

- Zech. 6:12 Tell him this is what the LORD Almighty says: 'Here is the man whose name is the Branch, and he will branch out from his place and build the temple of the LORD.
- John 2:19 Jesus answered them, "Destroy this temple, and I will raise it again in three days."
- John 2:20 The Jews replied, "It has taken forty-six years to build this temple, and you are going to raise it in three days?" 21 But the temple he had spoken of was his body.
- Eph. 3:12 In him and through faith in him we may approach God with freedom and confidence.
- <u>1Pet. 2:5</u> you also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.
- Matt. 5:16 In the same way, let your light shine before men, that they may see your good deeds and praise your Father in heaven.
- Matt. 5:17 "Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them.
