08-036-50 CHRISTIAN LIVING WORTHY OF THE GOSPEL
(RSV)

1:30 Philippians 1:27a Only let your manner of life be worthy of the gospel of Christ,..... Teaching – There is to be a connection between what we believe and what we do. Reference James 2:17 So faith by itself, if it has no works, is dead.

3:15 Ephesians 4:1 I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, beg you to lead a life worthy of the calling to which you have been called,

3:50 Philippians 1:27 (KJV) Only let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel of Christ: Teaching. Our life should adorn the Gospel. Our living should make the gospel attractive.

4:40 Teaching – Gallup poll: The vast majority of Americans profess to believe in God. Reference James 2:19 Even the demons believe in God. Many people are intellectual believers but practical atheists.

Teaching, on not just a generalized concept of God, but a precise and personal God.

8:00 Belief and Salvation – Reference Mark 16:16; Romans 10:9; Acts 16:31; Believe and you shall be saved. Reference John 3:16 For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. Teaching: There are those who

emphasize belief alone and there are those who emphasize good works. The scripture joins the two.

9:25 Philippians 1:27a Only let your manner of life be worthy of the gospel of Christ.... Teaching – your lifestyle's consistency with your faith in Christ.

Teaching on Philippians 1:27b-28a. "Steadfastness". Knowing what you believe and standing firm on the conviction. Not double-minded – Reference James 1:7 "Unstable in all his ways".

11:00 Ephesians 6:13-14 "Stand". Upon what?

12:15 1 Corinthians 3:11 For no other foundation can any one lay than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ.

14:20 Philippians 1:27b in one spirit, one mind, side by side for the faith of the gospel. Teaching – in unity with other believers. Not divided. Reference John 17:20-21 That they all may be one.....So that the world may believe.

16:30 1 Corinthians 12:13a For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body... Reference Ephesians 4:4-6 There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to the one hope that belongs to your call, 5 one Lord, one faith, one baptism, 6 one God and Father of us all, who is above all and through all and in all.

17:30 Philippians 1:27b "Striving...for the faith of the gospel" Teaching – an earnest life with purpose, not drifting. Teaching – The mission of St. Paul's church *"TO KNOW CHRIST AND TO MAKE HIM KNOWN"*

19:55 Philippians 1:28a and not frightened in anything by your opponents. Teaching about opposition. Reference 1 John 4:4 Greater is he that is in you than he who is in the world.

22:25 Philippians 1:29 For it has been granted to you that for the sake of Christ you should not only believe in him but also suffer for his sake, Teaching.
