# 08-213-50    ANOTHER CHRIST; ANOTHER GOSPEL  
(RSV)

:30 Ezekiel 3:17; Philippians 3:2; Matthew 24:4,11  
Warnings of false teachers.

2:05 Jeremiah 23:16-17, 21-22 The Lord reveals the  
false prophets and their message. Visions of their own minds  
and not the word of the Lord.

3:15 Matthew 7:15 Those who come in sheep's clothing,  
yet they are wolves. Their intent is to spoil the kingdom of  
God, by destroying the clearness of the testimony - confusing  
the saints.

3:50 Acts 20:29-30 Paul warns the Ephesian elders of  
the false teachers.

4:40 2 Peter 2:1 Peter reflects on the past false teachers  
and warns of those to come.

5:20 1 John 4:1 Already in the first generation of  
Christians, the false teaching had begun.

8:50 Ezekiel 3:17-19 "Son of man, I have made you a  
watchman for the house of Israel; whenever you hear a word  
from my mouth, you shall give them warning from me. 18 If I  
say to the wicked, 'You shall surely die,' and you give him no  
warning, nor speak to warn the wicked from his wicked way, in

order to save his life, that wicked man shall die in his iniquity; but his blood I will require at your hand. 19 But if you warn the wicked, and he does not turn from his wickedness, or from his wicked way, he shall die in his iniquity; but you will have saved your life.

10:00 Teaching on those who sought to undermine Paul. First Group - the unbelieving Jews. Teaching. Reference Acts 13:50 Antioch. Acts 14:2 Iconium, Acts 14:19, Lystra Acts 17:5 Thessalonica, Acts 18:12-13 Corinth.

Second Group – Jewish converts who accepted the Messiah but also wanted to keep the requirements of the law, (i.e.) Circumcision. Teaching.

13:30 Acts 15:1 The teaching that circumcision was required caused a controversy. Peter declares that salvation comes by faith in Jesus alone. Reference Acts 15:6-11. It is not Jesus + something else. The saving grace of Jesus is a gift and not a wage for good works – Reference Romans 4:4.

16:35 Exodus 20:3-4 Teaching on Aaron's approval of making a golden calf.

18:40 Galatians 1:6-9 I am astonished that you are so quickly deserting him who called you in the grace of Christ and turning to a different gospel — 7 not that there is another gospel, but there are some who trouble you and want to pervert the gospel of Christ. 8 But even if we, or an angel from heaven, should preach to you a gospel contrary to that which we preached to you, let him be accursed. 9 As we have said before, so now I say again, If any one is preaching to you a gospel contrary to that which you received, let him be accursed.

21:00 Teaching on Mormonism. A non-Christian movement.

33:35 2 Corinthians 4:2-5 Paul declares that he will only preach the true Gospel – Jesus is Lord.

Ezek. 3:17 “Son of man, I have made you a watchman for the house of Israel; whenever you hear a word from my mouth, you shall give them warning from me.

Phil. 3:2 Look out for the dogs, look out for the evil-workers, look out for those who mutilate the flesh.

Matt. 24:4 And Jesus answered them, “Take heed that no one leads you astray.

Matt. 24:11 And many false prophets will arise and lead many astray.

Jer. 23:16 Thus says the LORD of hosts: “Do not listen to the words of the prophets who prophesy to you, filling you with vain hopes; they speak visions of their own minds, not from the mouth of the LORD. 17 They say continually to those who despise the word of the LORD, ‘It shall be well with you’; and to every one who stubbornly follows his own heart, they say, ‘No evil shall come upon you.’”

Jer. 23:21 “I did not send the prophets, yet they ran; I did not speak to them, yet they prophesied. 22 But if they had stood in my council, then they would have proclaimed my words to my people, and they would have turned them from their evil way, and from the evil of their doings.

Matt. 7:15 “Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep’s clothing but inwardly are ravenous wolves.

Acts 20:29 I know that after my departure fierce wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock; 30 and from among your own selves will arise men speaking perverse things, to draw away the disciples after them.

2Pet. 2:1 But false prophets also arose among the people, just as there will be false teachers among you, who will secretly bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Master who bought them, bringing upon themselves swift destruction.

1John 4:1 Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are of God; for many false prophets have gone out into the world.

Ezek. 3:17 “Son of man, I have made you a watchman for the house of Israel; whenever you hear a word from my mouth, you shall give them warning from me. 18 If I say to the wicked, ‘You shall surely die,’ and you give him no warning, nor speak to warn the wicked from his wicked way, in order to save his life, that wicked man shall die in his iniquity; but his blood I will require at your hand. 19 But if you warn the wicked, and he does not turn from his wickedness, or from his wicked way, he shall die in his iniquity; but you will have saved your life.

Acts 13:50 But the Jews incited the devout women of high standing and the leading men of the city, and stirred up persecution against Paul and Barnabas, and drove them out of their district.

Acts 14:2 But the unbelieving Jews stirred up the Gentiles and poisoned their minds against the brethren.

Acts 14:19 But Jews came there from Antioch and Iconium; and having persuaded the people, they stoned Paul and dragged him out of the city, supposing that he was dead.

Acts 17:5 But the Jews were jealous, and taking some wicked fellows of the rabble, they gathered a crowd, set the city in an uproar, and attacked the house of Jason, seeking to bring them out to the people.

Acts 18:12 But when Gallio was proconsul of Achaia, the Jews made a united attack upon Paul and brought him before the tribunal, 13 saying, “This man is persuading men to worship God contrary to the law.”

Acts 15:1 But some men came down from Judea and were teaching the brethren, “Unless you are circumcised according to the custom of Moses, you cannot be saved.”

Acts 15:6 The apostles and the elders were gathered together to consider this matter. 7 And after there had been much debate, Peter rose and said to them, “Brethren, you know that in the early days God made choice among you, that by my mouth the Gentiles should hear the word of the gospel and believe. 8 And God who knows the heart bore witness to them, giving them the Holy Spirit just as he did to us; 9 and he made no distinction between us and them,

but cleansed their hearts by faith. 10 Now therefore why do you make trial of God by putting a yoke upon the neck of the disciples which neither our fathers nor we have been able to bear? 11 But we believe that we shall be saved through the grace of the Lord Jesus, just as they will.”

2Cor. 4:2 We have renounced disgraceful, underhanded ways; we refuse to practice cunning or to tamper with God’s word, but by the open statement of the truth we would commend ourselves to every man’s conscience in the sight of God. 3 And even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled only to those who are perishing. 4 In their case the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelievers, to keep them from seeing the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the likeness of God. 5 For what we preach is not ourselves, but Jesus Christ as Lord, with ourselves as your servants for Jesus’ sake.
