(RSV)

:00-4:35 Opening comments on Thessalonians and the theme of the second coming of Jesus.

4:35 Acts 1:9-11 .... "And when he had said this, as they were looking on, he was lifted up, and a cloud took him out of their sight. 10 And while they were gazing into heaven as he went, behold, two men stood by them in white robes, 11 and said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into heaven? This Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will come in the same way as you saw him go into heaven." Reference Matthew 24 and 25 .

6:00 1 Thessalonians 1:9-10 " wait for his Son from heaven"... Teaching.

7:40 1 Thessalonians 2:19-20 For what is our hope or joy or crown of boasting before our Lord Jesus at his coming? Is it not you? 20 For you are our glory and joy.

8:00 1 Thessalonians 3:11-13 "...at the coming of the Lord Jesus with all his saints"

8:30 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18 Reading. Teaching. Terry admonishes the churches and the clergy for not teaching a fuller essence of the gospel and Christian belief. Reference Malachi 2:2 The Lord is warning the priests. Reference Malachi 2:7 For the lips of a priest should guard knowledge,

and men should seek instruction from his mouth, for he is the messenger of the LORD of hosts.

18:10 John 11:11-15 Teaching on death of Lazarus.  
Teaching on death for a Christian. Reference Genesis 2:17.  
Teaching on the two kinds of death: Physical and spiritual.  
Two kinds of Life: Spiritual and physical. Reference Genesis 3:8-9 Adam and Eve hid themselves. There was a wall of separation created by the disobedience – Sin. Reference Isaiah 59:2

22:00 Romans 5:12 Therefore as sin came into the world through one man and death through sin, and so death spread to all men because all men sinned — Teaching.

23:25 Ephesians 2:1 And you he made alive, when you were dead through the trespasses and sins Reference Ephesians 2:4-5 ....Made us alive together with Christ....

24:50 Revelation 20:6 Blessed and holy is he who shares in the first resurrection! Over such the second death has no power, Teaching.

26:40 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18 Teaching on second coming.

33:40 1 Corinthians 15:51-54 “we shall be changed” Reference 1 John 3:2 Beloved, we are God’s children now; it does not yet appear what we shall be, but we know that when he appears we shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is.

Terry takes a few minutes to dispel the idea that all people have an immortal soul.

Gen. 2:17 but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall die.”

Gen. 3:8 And they heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and the man and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God among the trees of the garden. 9 But the LORD God called to the man, and said to him, “Where are you?”

Is. 59:2 but your iniquities have made a separation between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you so that he does not hear.
