11-035-53 PRAYING FOR EACH OTHER (RSV)

1:40 Psalm 63:1 (KJV) O God, thou art my God; early will I seek thee: my soul thirsteth for thee,

1:55 Mark 1:35 And in the morning, a great while before day, he rose and went out to a lonely place, and there he prayed.

2:15 Acts 6:2 And the twelve summoned the body of the disciples and said, "It is not right that we should give up preaching the word of God to serve tables. Reference, quote from Martin Luther – "I am so busy and I have so much to do, that I cannot possibly go through a day without devoting at least three hours to prayer." Reference quote from John Wesley – "God only works in response to prayer."

Teaching – Prayer is to the Christina life, what breath is to the body. Prayer is the intimate link between the Father and ourselves. Prayer is more listening than speaking.

4:15 Hebrews 11:6 And without faith it is impossible to please him. For whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him. Teaching – prayer is the evidence that we believe he is seeking us and will receive us, that he will listen to us, and that we can make a difference in what happens. # 11-035-53 Cont'd

5:00 Teaching on the acronym A.C.T.S. – Adoration, Confession, Thanksgiving, Supplication (two kinds:1.Petition – our own lives. 2. Intercession – prayers for other people and situations) Teaching on the Lord's prayer.

8:30 1 John 1:7 but if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin. Teaching – Sins brought to the light (confessed) are cleansed.

11:15 Teaching – Prayer is the centering our whole being, consciously, on the living God. The focus where are desires come together with his will.

12:00 2 Thessalonians 3:1 Finally, brethren, pray for us.... Teaching. ...That the word of the Lord may speed on and triumph, as it did among you... Teaching. Reference Isaiah 55:10-11 God's word shall accomplish that for which it was sent. Reference 1 Thessalonians 1:5 For our gospel came to you not only in word, but also in power and in the Holy Spirit and with full conviction.

18:30 Teaching on what it means to over-emphasize the externals of a worship service.

25:30 1 Thessalonians 1:9 For they themselves report concerning us what a welcome we had among you, and how you turned to God from idols, to serve a living and true God,

29:50 2 Thessalonians 3:3 But the Lord is faithful; he will strengthen you and guard you from evil. Teaching.

31:00 2 Thessalonians 3:4 And we have confidence in the Lord about you, that you are doing and will do the things which we command. Teaching.

35:00 2 Thessalonians 3:5 May the Lord direct your hearts to the love of God and to the steadfastness of Christ. Teaching.
