# 911010-54    A PRESENT HOPE: A FUTURE INHERITANCE

3:00 1 Peter 1:1-2 A short reference back to the previous teaching and a comment on the last sentence “Grace and peace be yours in abundance.” Grace = the unmerited favor of God. Reference Luke 1:28 Mary is highly favored. Peace = standing without fear in the clothing of Jesus Christ even in the midst of circumstances which seem overwhelming.

8:50 1 Peter 1:3 Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. Teaching on the concept of praise. Hebrew word – Halal. To magnify, extol, praise. Often used with the shortened version of Yahweh – and transliterated in English as Hallelujah.

Teaching. Trinitarian nature of God. Reference 2 Corinthians 1:3 Paul praises the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. Reference Ephesians 1:3.

15:15 Philippians 2:9-11 God the Father is blessed when his Son is blessed. Jesus is highly exalted. His name is above all names.

Terry mentions some pernicious teaching in the Episcopal church that would remove the references to the Father sending his Son to die for our sins.

Jesus did what the Father asked him to do. He finished the Father’s work John 19:30; John 17:4-5.

17:35 Matthew 27:40-42 Jesus voluntarily went to the cross. He could have avoided the suffering - Reference Matthew 26:53 The Father would send the angels to the rescue if he asked.

18:50 1 Peter 1:3-4 In his great mercy God has given us new birth: A living hope and an Inheritance.

Mercy and Grace: Reference Titus 3:5 He saved us according to his own mercy and not on any basis of our righteousness. Reference 2 Corinthians 4:1 Paul sees his life clearly in light of God's mercy.

24:30 There is personal application in God's mercy. Why are you here at this time?

25:30 1 Peter 1:3 New Birth. Teaching. Personal Relationship. Reference Genesis 17:7; Exodus 6:7; 2 Corinthians 6:16

God wants people who will respond to him.

28:45 John 1:11-13 Spiritual birth follows reception of Jesus (the response to accept him as Lord of your life). A relationship to the institutional church is not a relationship with God. Teaching.

34:05 John 2:24-3:8 Teaching on the new birth using Nicodemus as the student of Jesus.

42:00 James 1:16-18 God chose to give us spiritual birth through the word of truth, that we should be a kind of firstfruits.... Reference Romans 10:13-17

44:20 1 Peter 1:23-25 you have been born again not of perishable seed but of imperishable, through the living and abiding word of God. The word remains forever.

47:25 1 John 2:29 He who practices righteousness has been born of God. The new birth creates the desire to do the will of God. If there is no continual desire to do God's will then the new birth of the person needs to be examined. In order to know God's will requires knowing his word and staying in personal touch.

48:30 1 John 3:7-10 What is the settled determination – to do the will of God or to do your own thing. The world wants to do its own thing.

50:53 1 John 4:7 Love is a sign of the new birth.  
Reference Matthew 22:34-40 The Great Commandment – Love God and Neighbor.

51:35 1 John 5:2-4 We express our love of God by keeping his commands and overcoming the world.

52:25 1 Peter 1:3 ...A living Hope... A hope and confidence in the sufficiency of God, not because of doctrine or truth, that we give mental assent to, but a living hope derived from our personal relationship with him. Reference 1 Peter 1:13-15

54:50 1 Peter 1:4 An eternal inheritance that can never perish or spoil. The inheritance is future but we have received

a down payment – the seal of the Holy Spirit. Reference  
Ephesians 1:13-14

1:06:30 2 Corinthians 5:14, 21 Christ died for all, and  
therefore all have died. God made him who had no sin to be sin

1:06:55 1 Peter 1:5 shielded by God's power. Teaching.  
Reference 2 Kings 6:15-17

1Pet. 1:1 Peter, an apostle of Jesus Christ,

To God's elect, strangers in the world, scattered throughout Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia and Bithynia, 2 who have been chosen according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through the sanctifying work of the Spirit, for obedience to Jesus Christ and sprinkling by his blood:

Grace and peace be yours in abundance.

1Pet. 1:3 Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In his great mercy he has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

Luke 1:28 The angel went to her and said, "Greetings, you who are highly favored! The Lord is with you."

2Cor. 1:3 Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassion and the God of all comfort,

Eph. 1:3 Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ.

Phil. 2:9 Therefore God exalted him to the highest place

1Pet. 1:3 Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In his great mercy he has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, 4 and into an inheritance that can never perish, spoil or fade—kept in heaven for you,

Titus 3:5 he saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit,

2Cor. 4:1 Therefore, since through God’s mercy we have this ministry, we do not lose heart.

Gen. 17:7 I will establish my covenant as an everlasting covenant between me and you and your descendants after you for the generations to come, to be your God and the God of your descendants after you.

Ex. 6:7 I will take you as my own people, and I will be your God. Then you will know that I am the LORD your God, who brought you out from under the yoke of the Egyptians.

2Cor. 6:16 What agreement is there between the temple of God and idols? For we are the temple of the living God. As God has said: “I will live with them and walk among them, and I will be their God, and they will be my people.”

John 1:11 He came to that which was his own, but his own did not receive him. 12 Yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God— 13 children born not of natural descent, nor of human decision or a husband’s will, but born of God.

John 2:24 But Jesus would not entrust himself to them, for he knew all men. 25 He did not need man's testimony about man, for he knew what was in a man.

John 3:1 Now there was a man of the Pharisees named Nicodemus, a member of the Jewish ruling council. 2 He came to Jesus at night and said, "Rabbi, we know you are a teacher who has come from God. For no one could perform the miraculous signs you are doing if God were not with him."

John 3:3 In reply Jesus declared, "I tell you the truth, no one can see the kingdom of God unless he is born again."

John 3:4 "How can a man be born when he is old?" Nicodemus asked. "Surely he cannot enter a second time into his mother's womb to be born!"

John 3:5 Jesus answered, "I tell you the truth, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless he is born of water and the Spirit. 6 Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit. 7 You should not be surprised at my saying, 'You must be born again.' 8 The wind blows wherever it pleases. You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going. So it is with everyone born of the Spirit."

James 1:16 Don't be deceived, my dear brothers. 17 Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows. 18 He chose to give us birth through the word of truth, that we might be a kind of firstfruits of all he created.

Rom. 10:13 for, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."

Rom. 10:14 How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? 15 And how can they preach unless they are sent? As it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!"

Rom. 10:16 But not all the Israelites accepted the good news. For Isaiah says, "Lord, who has believed our message?" 17 Consequently, faith comes

from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word of Christ.

1Pet. 1:23 For you have been born again, not of perishable seed, but of imperishable, through the living and enduring word of God. 24 For,

“All men are like grass,  
and all their glory is like the flowers of the field;  
the grass withers and the flowers fall,  
25 but the word of the Lord stands forever.”  
And this is the word that was preached to you.

1John 2:29 If you know that he is righteous, you know that everyone who does what is right has been born of him.

1John 3:7 Dear children, do not let anyone lead you astray. He who does what is right is righteous, just as he is righteous. 8 He who does what is sinful is of the devil, because the devil has been sinning from the beginning. The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the devil’s work. 9 No one who is born of God will continue to sin, because God’s seed remains in him; he cannot go on sinning, because he has been born of God. 10 This is how we know who the children of God are and who the children of the devil are: Anyone who does not do what is right is not a child of God; nor is anyone who does not love his brother.

1John 4:7 Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God.

Matt. 22:34 Hearing that Jesus had silenced the Sadducees, the Pharisees got together. 35 One of them, an expert in the law, tested him with this question: 36 “Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?”

Matt. 22:37 Jesus replied: “ ‘Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.’ 38 This is the first and greatest commandment. 39 And the second is like it: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’ 40 All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments.”

1John 5:2 This is how we know that we love the children of God: by loving God



and carrying out his commands. 3 This is love for God: to obey his commands. And his commands are not burdensome, 4 for everyone born of God overcomes the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world, even our faith.

1Pet. 1:3 Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In his great mercy he has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

1Pet. 1:13 Therefore, prepare your minds for action; be self-controlled; set your hope fully on the grace to be given you when Jesus Christ is revealed. 14 As obedient children, do not conform to the evil desires you had when you lived in ignorance. 15 But just as he who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do;

1Pet. 1:4 and into an inheritance that can never perish, spoil or fade—kept in heaven for you,

Eph. 1:13 And you also were included in Christ when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation. Having believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, 14 who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God's possession—to the praise of his glory.

2Cor. 5:14 For Christ's love compels us, because we are convinced that one died for all, and therefore all died.

2Cor. 5:21 God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

1Pet. 1:5 who through faith are shielded by God's power until the coming of the salvation that is ready to be revealed in the last time.

2Kings 6:15 When the servant of the man of God got up and went out early the next morning, an army with horses and chariots had surrounded the city. "Oh, my lord, what shall we do?" the servant asked.

2Kings 6:16 "Don't be afraid," the prophet answered. "Those who are with

us are more than those who are with them.”
