04-069-55 THOSE WHO WOULD LEAD YOU ASTRAY

:45 1 John 2:24-27 Reading and review of previous teaching on God's safeguards against error. **1**. Let the Word – word abide in you. Reference John 1:1,14. Reference 1 John 1:1-3. **2**. The anointing (Holy Spirit) as resident and active within us.

4:30 The connection between the Word (Jesus) and the word (the scripture). Reference to John 5:39-40 and Luke 24:44-49.

18:40 Acts 2:41-42 The 3,000 new believers devoted themselves to the Apostles' teaching.

20:40 Jeremiah 23:15-22 The false teachers using their own ideas as opposed to proclaiming the word of God. When the true word is proclaimed people's lives are changed.

26:45 1 John 2:27 The anointing – the Holy Spirit. The word is external, the Spirit is internal. The word without the Spirit is a dead letter. Reference 2 Corinthians 3:6. The Spirit without the word leads to fanaticism. With the Spirit and the word together you have the living truth of God.

20:05 Psalm 2:1-3. Those in opposition to God seek to throw off any restraint against their desired behavior. There is an audio break – sorry. Terry refers to Genesis 2:15-17 to show

the example of Adam and Eve "throwing off" God to do their own thing.

30:07 Isaiah 11:1-2; 42:1; 61:1. Luke 4:16-21. All passages relating to the Spirit coming upon. The Messiah – the Christos - means the anointed one. Reference John 1:32-34, where the Holy Spirit comes upon Jesus to inaugurate his ministry, (anointed).

33:05 Acts 10:38 Peter explains to Cornelius how Jesus was anointed. Reference Acts 4:25-26.

35:00 1 John 2:27. Christians are anointed in that they have the indwelling Holy Spirit for the accomplishment of God's purpose. In this case – to discern false teaching and error. Reference to John 14:16-17,26 the Holy Spirit comes to dwell in every Christian and is available for our teaching and counsel. Reference John 15:26-27 The Holy Spirit will bear witness to Jesus. John 16:13-14, The Holy Spirit will guide us and He will glorify Jesus.

39:05 1 Corinthians 1:18-31 Man's wisdom cannot bring him to the true God. Reference 1 Corinthians 2:11-13. The Holy Spirit is given, that we might be able to understand the spiritual truths.

43:40 2 Corinthians 4:5 The Spirit leads the preacher to glorify Jesus. Reference 2 Corinthians 3:4-6. The life changing power of the word is only activated in and through the Spirit.

48:20 2 Peter 1:16-21 The scripture was inspired by the Holy Spirit, therefore, the Holy Spirit is the proper one to teach its meaning.

50:50 A question is asked about 1 Corinthians 2:15. Terry begins the answer with some discussion about the verses immediately preceding. Understanding the scripture in academic terms only is different than having the scripture "alive" in your life. Verse 15 speaks to the gift of discernment in a spiritual man.

53:10 1 John 4:1-3 One of the ways to discern false teaching is to ascertain if the teaching acclaims Jesus as the Christ.

<u>1John 2:24</u> Let what you heard from the beginning abide in you. If what you heard from the beginning abides in you, then you will abide in the Son and in the Father. <u>25</u> And this is what he has promised us, eternal life.

<u>1John 2:26</u> I write this to you about those who would deceive you; <u>27</u> but the anointing which you received from him abides in you, and you have no need that any one should teach you; as his anointing teaches you about everything, and is true, and is no lie, just as it has taught you, abide in him.

John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

John 1:14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, full of grace and truth; we have beheld his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father.

<u>1John 1:1</u> That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon and touched with our hands, concerning the word of life — <u>2</u> the life was made manifest, and we saw it, and testify to it, and proclaim to you the eternal life which was with the Father and was made manifest to us — <u>3</u> that which we have seen and heard we proclaim also to you, so that you may have fellowship with us; and our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son Jesus Christ.

<u>John 5:39</u> You search the scriptures, because you think that in them you have eternal life; and it is they that bear witness to me; <u>40</u> yet you refuse to come to me that you may have life.

<u>Luke 24:44</u> Then he said to them, "These are my words which I spoke to you, while I was still with you, that everything written about me in the law of Moses and the prophets and the psalms must be fulfilled." <u>45</u> Then he opened their minds to understand the scriptures, <u>46</u> and said to them, "Thus it is written, that the Christ should suffer and on the third day rise from the dead, <u>47</u> and that repentance and forgiveness of sins should be preached in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. <u>48</u> You are witnesses of these things. <u>49</u> And behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you; but stay in the city, until you are clothed with power from on high."

Acts 2:41 So those who received his word were baptized, and there were added

that day about three thousand souls. $\underline{42}$ And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers.

Jer. 23:15 Therefore thus says the LORD of hosts concerning the prophets: "Behold, I will feed them with wormwood, and give them poisoned water to drink; for from the prophets of Jerusalem ungodliness has gone forth into all the land."

Jer. 23:16 Thus says the LORD of hosts: "Do not listen to the words of the prophets who prophesy to you, filling you with vain hopes; they speak visions of their own minds, not from the mouth of the LORD. <u>17</u> They say continually to those who despise the word of the LORD, 'It shall be well with you'; and to every one who stubbornly follows his own heart, they say, 'No evil shall come upon you.'"

Jer. 23:18 For who among them has stood in the council of the LORD to perceive and to hear his word, or who has given heed to his word and listened? 19 Behold, the storm of the LORD! Wrath has gone forth, a whirling tempest; it will burst upon the head of the wicked. 20 The anger of the LORD will not turn back until he has executed and accomplished the intents of his mind. In the latter days you will understand it clearly.

Jer. 23:21 "I did not send the prophets, yet they ran; I did not speak to them, yet they prophesied. 22 But if they had stood in my council, then they would have proclaimed my words to my people, and they would have turned them from their evil way, and from the evil of their doings.

<u>1John 2:27</u> but the anointing which you received from him abides in you, and you have no need that any one should teach you; as his anointing teaches you about everything, and is true, and is no lie, just as it has taught you, abide in him.

<u>2Cor. 3:6</u> who has made us competent to be ministers of a new covenant, not in a written code but in the Spirit; for the written code kills, but the Spirit gives life.

<u>Psa. 2:1</u> Why do the nations conspire, and the peoples plot in vain? <u>2</u> The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against

the LORD and his anointed, saying, $\underline{3}$ "Let us burst their bonds as under, and cast their cords from us."

<u>Gen. 2:15</u> The LORD God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to till it and keep it. <u>16</u> And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, "You may freely eat of every tree of the garden; <u>17</u> but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall die."

<u>Is. 11:1</u> There shall come forth a shoot from the stump of Jesse, and a branch shall grow out of his roots. <u>2</u> And the Spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and the fear of the LORD.

<u>Is. 42:1</u> Behold my servant, whom I uphold, my chosen, in whom my soul delights; I have put my Spirit upon him, he will bring forth justice to the nations.

<u>Is. 61:1</u> The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me, because the LORD has anointed me to bring good tidings to the afflicted; he has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound;

<u>Luke 4:16</u> And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up; and he went to the synagogue, as his custom was, on the sabbath day. And he stood up to read; <u>17</u> and there was given to him the book of the prophet Isaiah. He opened the book and found the place where it was written, <u>18</u> "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim release to the captives and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed, <u>19</u> to proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord." <u>20</u> And he closed the book, and gave it back to the attendant, and sat down; and the eyes of all in the synagogue were fixed on him. <u>21</u> And he began to say to them, "Today this scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing."

John 1:32 And John bore witness, "I saw the Spirit descend as a dove from heaven, and it remained on him. <u>33</u> I myself did not know him; but he who sent me to baptize with water said to me, 'He on whom you see the Spirit

descend and remain, this is he who baptizes with the Holy Spirit.' <u>34</u> And I have seen and have borne witness that this is the Son of God."

<u>Acts 10:38</u> how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power; how he went about doing good and healing all that were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him.

<u>Acts 4:25</u> who by the mouth of our father David, thy servant, didst say by the Holy Spirit, 'Why did the Gentiles rage, and the peoples imagine vain things? <u>26</u> The kings of the earth set themselves in array, and the rulers were gathered together, against the Lord and against his Anointed —

<u>1John 2:27</u> but the anointing which you received from him abides in you, and you have no need that any one should teach you; as his anointing teaches you about everything, and is true, and is no lie, just as it has taught you, abide in him.

John 14:16 And I will pray the Father, and he will give you another Counselor, to be with you for ever, <u>17</u> even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him; you know him, for he dwells with you, and will be in you.

John 14:26 But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you.

John 15:26 But when the Counselor comes, whom I shall send to you from the Father, even the Spirit of truth, who proceeds from the Father, he will bear witness to me; <u>27</u> and you also are witnesses, because you have been with me from the beginning.

John 16:13 When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth; for he will not speak on his own authority, but whatever he hears he will speak, and he will declare to you the things that are to come. <u>14</u> He will glorify me, for he will take what is mine and declare it to you.

<u>1Cor. 1:18</u> For the word of the cross is folly to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. <u>19</u> For it is written, "I will

destroy the wisdom of the wise, and the cleverness of the clever I will thwart." <u>20</u> Where is the wise man? Where is the scribe? Where is the debater of this age? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of the world? <u>21</u> For since, in the wisdom of God, the world did not know God through wisdom, it pleased God through the folly of what we preach to save those who believe. <u>22</u> For Jews demand signs and Greeks seek wisdom, <u>23</u> but we preach Christ crucified, a stumbling block to Jews and folly to Gentiles, <u>24</u> but to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God. <u>25</u> For the foolishness of God is wiser than men, and the weakness of God is stronger than men.

<u>1Cor. 1:26</u> For consider your call, brethren; not many of you were wise according to worldly standards, not many were powerful, not many were of noble birth; <u>27</u> but God chose what is foolish in the world to shame the wise, God chose what is weak in the world to shame the strong, <u>28</u> God chose what is low and despised in the world, even things that are not, to bring to nothing things that are, <u>29</u> so that no human being might boast in the presence of God. <u>30</u> He is the source of your life in Christ Jesus, whom God made our wisdom, our righteousness and sanctification and redemption; <u>31</u> therefore, as it is written, "Let him who boasts, boast of the Lord."

<u>1Cor. 2:11</u> For what person knows a man's thoughts except the spirit of the man which is in him? So also no one comprehends the thoughts of God except the Spirit of God. <u>12</u> Now we have received not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit which is from God, that we might understand the gifts bestowed on us by God. <u>13</u> And we impart this in words not taught by human wisdom but taught by the Spirit, interpreting spiritual truths to those who possess the Spirit.

<u>2Cor. 4:5</u> For what we preach is not ourselves, but Jesus Christ as Lord, with ourselves as your servants for Jesus' sake.

<u>2Cor. 3:4</u> Such is the confidence that we have through Christ toward God. <u>5</u> Not that we are competent of ourselves to claim anything as coming from us; our competence is from God, <u>6</u> who has made us competent to be ministers of a new covenant, not in a written code but in the Spirit; for the written code kills, but the Spirit gives life.

2Pet. 1:16 For we did not follow cleverly devised myths when we made known

to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but we were eyewitnesses of his majesty. <u>17</u> For when he received honor and glory from God the Father and the voice was borne to him by the Majestic Glory, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased," <u>18</u> we heard this voice borne from heaven, for we were with him on the holy mountain. <u>19</u> And we have the prophetic word made more sure. You will do well to pay attention to this as to a lamp shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts. <u>20</u> First of all you must understand this, that no prophecy of scripture is a matter of one's own interpretation, <u>21</u> because no prophecy ever came by the impulse of man, but men moved by the Holy Spirit spoke from God.

<u>1Cor. 2:15</u> The spiritual man judges all things, but is himself to be judged by no one.

<u>1John 4:1</u> Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are of God; for many false prophets have gone out into the world. <u>2</u> By this you know the Spirit of God: every spirit which confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is of God, <u>3</u> and every spirit which does not confess Jesus is not of God. This is the spirit of antichrist, of which you heard that it was coming, and now it is in the world already.
