04-112-55 HE LIVES IN US

1:45 1 John 3:23 Reading and teaching. Verse 23 establishes the connection between our belief and our action. Belief without action is void. Even the demons believe, but do not follow God's will – James 2:19.

4:20 James 2:17 Faith without works (action) is dead.

4:50 1 John 3:24 Those who obey God's commands are the ones who live in Him and we know he is within because of the Spirit he gave us. All Christians have the Spirit.

5:40 Acts 2:22-39. The crowd heard Peter's preaching and they asked "what shall we do"? Peter answered, repent, be baptized and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

7:40 2 Peter 1:3-4 God has given us the provision to live the full life in godliness. Reference John 1:14 – the incarnation. Jesus took upon himself our nature – Philippians 2:6-8.

10:00 Romans 8:9 When we believe, trust and receive the life of God (the Holy Spirit) is planted within us to enable us to resist sin and walk in the Lord's will. Reference Romans 8:15-17 We do not have a master-slave relationship with God, but a Father-son relationship. The inner assurance that we are in a Father-son relationship with God is the strongest evidence we have that the Spirit is within us. # 04-112-55 Cont'd

17:00 Romans 5:8 God loved us even while we were sinners.

19:20 Romans 8:17 Since we are sons of God we are also heirs.

21:25 Galatians 4:4-7 God's Son came to give us a filial relationship in place of a legal relationship. We are adopted as God's sons, we receive his Spirit, and we are granted status as heirs. Only the Holy Spirit can produce in us the will to do what God requires: Love Him and our Neighbor. (Mt 22:37-40)

27:00 Romans 10:1-4 Understanding that God alone provides the righteousness that covers us – it is not our own righteousness. God supplies what he requires. Christ is the end of the law so that there may be righteousness for all who believe.

30:30 Luke 17:10 and Isaiah 64:6 Even our best does not measure up to God's standard, so we must rely on his indwelling Spirit. Back to 1 John 3:24 because of the Spirit we know that he lives in us.

34:30 1 John 4:13 Because of the Spirit we know we live in Him.

<u>1John 3:23</u> And this is his commandment, that we should believe in the name of his Son Jesus Christ and love one another, just as he has commanded us. <u>24</u> All who keep his commandments abide in him, and he in them. And by this we know that he abides in us, by the Spirit which he has given us.

James 2:17 So faith by itself, if it has no works, is dead.

<u>James 2:18</u> But some one will say, "You have faith and I have works." Show me your faith apart from your works, and I by my works will show you my faith. <u>19</u> You believe that God is one; you do well. Even the demons believe — and shudder.

<u>Acts 2:22</u> "Men of Israel, hear these words: Jesus of Nazareth, a man attested to you by God with mighty works and wonders and signs which God did through him in your midst, as you yourselves know — <u>23</u> this Jesus, delivered up according to the definite plan and foreknowledge of God, you crucified and killed by the hands of lawless men. <u>24</u> But God raised him up, having loosed the pangs of death, because it was not possible for him to be held by it. <u>25</u> For David says concerning him, 'I saw the Lord always before me, for he is at my right hand that I may not be shaken; <u>26</u> therefore my heart was glad, and my tongue rejoiced; moreover my flesh will dwell in hope. <u>27</u> For thou wilt not abandon my soul to Hades, nor let thy Holy One see corruption. <u>28</u> Thou hast made known to me the ways of life; thou wilt make me full of gladness with thy presence.'

<u>Acts 2:29</u> "Brethren, I may say to you confidently of the patriarch David that he both died and was buried, and his tomb is with us to this day. <u>30</u> Being therefore a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him that he would set one of his descendants upon his throne, <u>31</u> he foresaw and spoke of the resurrection of the Christ, that he was not abandoned to Hades, nor did his flesh see corruption. <u>32</u> This Jesus God raised up, and of that we all are witnesses. <u>33</u> Being therefore exalted at the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, he has poured out this which you see and hear. <u>34</u> For David did not ascend into the heavens; but he himself says, 'The Lord said to my Lord, Sit at my right hand, <u>35</u> till I make thy enemies a stool for thy feet.' <u>36</u> Let all the house of Israel therefore know assuredly that God has made him both Lord and Christ, this Jesus whom you crucified."

<u>Acts 2:37</u> Now when they heard this they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Brethren, what shall we do?" <u>38</u> And Peter said to them, "Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. <u>39</u> For the promise is to you and to your children and to all that are far off, every one whom the Lord our God calls to him."

<u>2Pet. 1:3</u> His divine power has granted to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of him who called us to his own glory and excellence, <u>4</u> by which he has granted to us his precious and very great promises, that through these you may escape from the corruption that is in the world because of passion, and become partakers of the divine nature.

John 1:14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, full of grace and truth; we have beheld his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father.

<u>Phil. 2:6</u> who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, <u>7</u> but emptied himself, taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. <u>8</u> And being found in human form he humbled himself and became obedient unto death, even death on a cross.

<u>Rom. 8:9</u> But you are not in the flesh, you are in the Spirit, if in fact the Spirit of God dwells in you. Any one who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to him.

<u>Rom. 8:15</u> For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the spirit of sonship. When we cry, "Abba! Father!" <u>16</u> it is the Spirit himself bearing witness with our spirit that we are children of God, <u>17</u> and if children, then heirs, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, provided we suffer with him in order that we may also be glorified with him.

<u>Rom. 5:8</u> But God shows his love for us in that while we were yet sinners Christ died for us.

<u>Gal. 4:4</u> But when the time had fully come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law, 5 to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons. <u>6</u> And because you are sons, God has

sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!" <u>7</u> So through God you are no longer a slave but a son, and if a son then an heir.

<u>Matt. 22:37</u> And he said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind. <u>38</u> This is the great and first commandment. <u>39</u> And a second is like it, You shall love your neighbor as yourself. <u>40</u> On these two commandments depend all the law and the prophets."

<u>Rom. 10:1</u> Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for them is that they may be saved. 2 I bear them witness that they have a zeal for God, but it is not enlightened. 3 For, being ignorant of the righteousness that comes from God, and seeking to establish their own, they did not submit to God's righteousness. 4 For Christ is the end of the law, that every one who has faith may be justified.

<u>Luke 17:10</u> So you also, when you have done all that is commanded you, say, 'We are unworthy servants; we have only done what was our duty.'"

<u>Is. 64:6</u> We have all become like one who is unclean, and all our righteous deeds are like a polluted garment. We all fade like a leaf, and our iniquities, like the wind, take us away.

<u>1John 3:24</u> All who keep his commandments abide in him, and he in them. And by this we know that he abides in us, by the Spirit which he has given us.

<u>1John 4:13</u> By this we know that we abide in him and he in us, because he has given us of his own Spirit.
