06-238-56 SPIRITUAL EYES AND EYES OF THE FLESH

- 2:00 Ephesians 1:16-19 A prayer asking the Father to grant wisdom and revelation.
- 4:00 Revelation 1:1 The Greek word for Revelation is apokalupsis and it means the unveiling or uncovering of something that had been obscured. Beginning at chapter 4, what is obscure from an earthly view, becomes visible from a heavenly perspective.

Finite human language is inadequate to express infinite truths, so symbols are used to convey the underlying meaning. The wisdom is only unlocked with spiritual eyes, not eyes of the flesh. One needs the Holy Spirit as his guide.

- 13:30 Verse 1 continued. It is a revelation (unveiling) of Jesus Christ. It is not a revelation of the anti-Christ, or of hell, or of disasters that come upon the earth it is a revelation of Jesus Christ. In the course of the revelation of Jesus Christ other activities will be seen; the church, the world, the anti-Christ, the False Prophet, etc.
- 19:30 Matthew 15:13 "Every plant that my heavenly Father has not planted will be rooted up."
- 22:50 Revelation 1:1 The revelation does not originate with Jesus but with the Father yet it concerns Jesus. There are five generations of revelation within the first verse. The

- light of Jesus Christ will illuminate the deeper truth. It is not a revelation of John.
- 27:00 John sees and hears things that require spiritual eyes and ears.
- 28:30 Revelation 1:3 A blessing to those who read the book aloud (RSV, ESV), who hear it, and who do it (keep what is written).
- 31:25 Revelation 1:10 John says he was in the Spirit as he was given the vision. If we are to appropriate the truths and blessings of the book, we also must be in the Spirit.
- 32:35 1 Corinthians 12:3 ..."no one can say Jesus is Lord except in the Holy Spirit. Also a reference to John 16:13-15, Read passage.
- 34:00 1 Corinthians 10:11 Read Passage. Warnings to us from Israel's history.
- 34:25 Deuteronomy 10:12-13; 16 Read Passage What does God want from his people? Verse 16 Circumcise your hearts.
- 35:50 Acts 7 (Verse 8) The covenant of circumcision. (Verse 51)"You resist the Holy Spirit."
- 39:30 2 Corinthians 3:14-18 The veil can be removed Read Passage. (Audio interference between 40:10-40:15) The blessing comes to those who perceive the truth AND Keep it. Knowledge is of no consequence if it does not issue in changed behavior.

- Eph. 1:16 I do not cease to give thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers, 17 that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give you a spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of him, 18 having the eyes of your hearts enlightened, that you may know what is the hope to which he has called you, what are the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints, 19 and what is the immeasurable greatness of his power in us who believe, according to the working of his great might
- Rev. 1:1 The revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave him to show to his servants what must soon take place; and he made it known by sending his angel to his servant John,
- Matt. 15:13 He answered, "Every plant which my heavenly Father has not planted will be rooted up.
- Rev. 1:3 Blessed is he who reads aloud the words of the prophecy, and blessed are those who hear, and who keep what is written therein; for the time is near.
- Rev. 1:10 I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and I heard behind me a loud voice like a trumpet
- 1Cor. 12:3 Therefore I want you to understand that no one speaking by the Spirit of God ever says "Jesus be cursed!" and no one can say "Jesus is Lord" except by the Holy Spirit.
- John 16:13 When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth; for he will not speak on his own authority, but whatever he hears he will speak, and he will declare to you the things that are to come. 14 He will glorify me, for he will take what is mine and declare it to you. 15 All that the Father has is mine; therefore I said that he will take what is mine and declare it to you.
- 1Cor. 10:11 Now these things happened to them as a warning, but they were written down for our instruction, upon whom the end of the ages has come.
- <u>Deut. 10:12</u> "And now, Israel, what does the LORD your God require of you, but to fear the LORD your God, to walk in all his ways, to love him, to serve the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul, <u>13</u> and to keep the commandments and statutes of the LORD, which I command you this day for

your good?

<u>Deut. 10:16</u> Circumcise therefore the foreskin of your heart, and be no longer stubborn.

Acts 7:8 And he gave him the covenant of circumcision. And so Abraham became the father of Isaac, and circumcised him on the eighth day; and Isaac became the father of Jacob, and Jacob of the twelve patriarchs.

Acts 7:51 "You stiff-necked people, uncircumcised in heart and ears, you always resist the Holy Spirit. As your fathers did, so do you.

<u>2Cor. 3:14</u> But their minds were hardened; for to this day, when they read the old covenant, that same veil remains unlifted, because only through Christ is it taken away. <u>15</u> Yes, to this day whenever Moses is read a veil lies over their minds; <u>16</u> but when a man turns to the Lord the veil is removed. <u>17</u> Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. <u>18</u> And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being changed into his likeness from one degree of glory to another; for this comes from the Lord who is the Spirit.
