06-260-56 ONE LIKE A SON OF MAN

:00 -1:50 Short recap of the prior verses 1-6.

2:10 Acts 1:9-11 Reference to the Ascension and the 2nd coming. The focal point of the book is the second coming in total victory as Lord of Lords and King of Kings (The Day of the Lord). All history moves toward that event.

4:00 Revelation 1:7 Teaching.

4:35 Mark 14:61-62 Jesus says that he is enthroned in heaven and will be coming again on the clouds.

7:00 Back to Revelation 1:7 Teaching.

8:45 Revelation 1:8 Teaching

10:15 Revelation 1:9 John addresses his fellow believers in humility.

12:30 Revelation 1:2 & 5 John uses the term Jesus Christ, but at and after verse 9 he uses the name Jesus without the Christ (the Greek Title of the Messiah), because he is no longer in that capacity, but has ascended to the Throne once more for the ministry of eternity. 13:10 Philippians 2:9-10 At the name of Jesus every knee shall bow.

13:40 Revelation 1:9 John talks of sharing, together with the brothers and sisters, the tribulation and the kingdom (RSV). Reference John 16:33 In the world you will have Tribulation.

14:50 A slight audio break in the recording – sorry.

15:00 Revelation 1:10-11 I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day. Teaching. Reference 2 Corinthians 12:2-3. Teaching on the use of symbols throughout the book, Trumpet etc. Then (verse 11) the Seven churches.

20:45 Revelation 1:12-16 Reading and Teaching. Lampstands are not the source of the light only its conveyance. They are reflectors of the light source, which is "God himself".

24:50 Daniel 7:13-14 OT background reference to "Son of Man" as in Revelation 1:13. The one to whom the whole of history is moving. Teaching continues relating to Revelation 1:12-16.

32:00 Revelation 1:16 Teaching. The seven stars in his hand and the double-edged sword. Jesus remains in the midst of God's people and they are secure in Him.

34:25 Ephesians 6:10-20 The armor of God and the Sword of the Spirit (verse 17).

35:45 2 Timothy 3:14-17 Paul instructs Timothy to hold onto the scriptures as they will make him wise for salvation (the coming into a personal relationship with God), and equipped in the best possible way.

39:30 Romans 10:13-15 Read Passage. People come into God's family by hearing God's word proclaimed.

39:50 Revelation 1:16 His face was like the sun shining in full strength. Reference Malachi 4:2 The "Sun" of righteousness - (the brightest light imaginable) will come. No darkness will prevail in that light, everything will be exposed.

Revelation 1:17 When I saw the Lord in His fullness I fell at his feet !

<u>Rev. 1:1</u> The revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave him to show to his servants what must soon take place; and he made it known by sending his angel to his servant John, $\underline{2}$ who bore witness to the word of God and to the testimony of Jesus Christ, even to all that he saw. $\underline{3}$ Blessed is he who reads aloud the words of the prophecy, and blessed are those who hear, and who keep what is written therein; for the time is near.

<u>Rev. 1:4</u> John to the seven churches that are in Asia:

Grace to you and peace from him who is and who was and who is to come, and from the seven spirits who are before his throne, 5 and from Jesus Christ the faithful witness, the first-born of the dead, and the ruler of kings on earth.

To him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood <u>6</u> and made us a kingdom, priests to his God and Father, to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen. <u>7</u> Behold, he is coming with the clouds, and every eye will see him, every one who pierced him; and all tribes of the earth will wail on account of him. Even so. Amen.

<u>Rev. 1:8</u> "I am the Alpha and the Omega," says the Lord God, who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty.

<u>Rev. 1:9</u> I John, your brother, who share with you in Jesus the tribulation and the kingdom and the patient endurance, was on the island called Patmos on account of the word of God and the testimony of Jesus. <u>10</u> I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and I heard behind me a loud voice like a trumpet <u>11</u> saying, "Write what you see in a book and send it to the seven churches, to Ephesus and to Smyrna and to Pergamum and to Thyatira and to Sardis and to Philadelphia and to La-odicea."

<u>Rev. 1:12</u> Then I turned to see the voice that was speaking to me, and on turning I saw seven golden lampstands, <u>13</u> and in the midst of the lampstands one like a son of man, clothed with a long robe and with a golden girdle round his breast; <u>14</u> his head and his hair were white as white wool, white as snow; his eyes were like a flame of fire, <u>15</u> his feet were like burnished bronze, refined as in a furnace, and his voice was like the sound of many waters; <u>16</u> in his right hand he held seven stars, from his mouth issued a sharp two-edged sword, and his face was like the sun shining in full strength.

<u>Rev. 1:17</u> When I saw him, I fell at his feet as though dead. But he laid his right hand upon me, saying, "Fear not, I am the first and the last,

<u>Acts 1:9</u> And when he had said this, as they were looking on, he was lifted up, and a cloud took him out of their sight. <u>10</u> And while they were gazing into heaven as he went, behold, two men stood by them in white robes, <u>11</u> and said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into heaven? This Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will come in the same way as you saw him go into heaven."

<u>Mark 14:61</u> But he was silent and made no answer. Again the high priest asked him, "Are you the Christ, the Son of the Blessed?" <u>62</u> And Jesus said, "I am; and you will see the Son of man seated at the right hand of Power, and coming with the clouds of heaven."

<u>Phil. 2:9</u> Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name which is above every name, <u>10</u> that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth,

John 16:33 I have said this to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world."

<u>2Cor. 12:2</u> I know a man in Christ who fourteen years ago was caught up to the third heaven — whether in the body or out of the body I do not know, God knows. <u>3</u> And I know that this man was caught up into Paradise — whether in the body or out of the body I do not know, God knows —

Dan. 7:13 I saw in the night visions, and behold, with the clouds of heaven there came one like a son of man, and he came to the Ancient of Days and was presented before him. <u>14</u> And to him was given dominion and glory and kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve him; his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom one that shall not be destroyed.

<u>Eph. 6:10</u> Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might. <u>11</u> Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. <u>12</u> For we are not contending against flesh and blood, but against the principalities, against the powers, against the world rulers of this present darkness, against the spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. <u>13</u> Therefore take the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. <u>14</u> Stand therefore, having girded your loins with truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness, <u>15</u> and having shod your feet with the equipment of the gospel of peace; <u>16</u> besides all these, taking the shield of faith, with which you can quench all the flaming darts of the evil one. <u>17</u> And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. <u>18</u> Pray at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints, <u>19</u> and also for me, that utterance may be given me in opening my mouth boldly to proclaim the mystery of the gospel, <u>20</u> for which I am an ambassador in chains; that I may declare it boldly, as I ought to speak.

<u>2Tim. 3:14</u> But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have firmly believed, knowing from whom you learned it <u>15</u> and how from childhood you have been acquainted with the sacred writings which are able to instruct you for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. <u>16</u> All scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, <u>17</u> that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.

Rom. 10:13 For, "every one who calls upon the name of the Lord will be saved."

<u>Rom. 10:14</u> But how are men to call upon him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without a preacher? <u>15</u> And how can men preach unless they are sent? As it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach good news!"
