## # 07-074-56 THE WOMAN AND THE DRAGON

- 5:00 Revelation, Chapters 12,13,14,15, are seven short pictures (glimpses of the conflict between God and Satan) inserted into the book, between the Judgments of God as expressed in the Trumpets and later to come the Bowls.
- 6:15 Revelation 12 A reading of the passage. The teaching explains the essence of the chapter.
- 12:20 Genesis 3:15 The Proto Evangelion. The first mention of the conflict between God and his fallen angel Lucifer (Satan, devil etc.)
- 15:20 John 8:42-47 Two groups of people. God's people and those opposed to God.
- 22:50 Galatians 3:16 The "Seed" is defined as Christ. The promised one who will destroy the works of the devil (1 John 3:8).
- 24:20 1 Chronicles 17:10-14 God promises David that the One whose kingdom will never end will come from his line.
- 28:30 Luke 10:17-18 Jesus' coming made the end of Satan's power a reality.

- 29:50 Matthew 12:24-29 Jesus makes clear that He cast out demons by the power of God. Terry teaches on the entrance of God's kingdom into the enemy territory and how that affects this creation with respect to the evil one. Satan can only have power over you to the extent you let him.
- 34:30 Revelation 12:4-6 Teaching as related to the first 6 verses and their illustration of God's timeline.
  - 40:00 Revelation 12:7ff Teaching continues.
- 43:40 1 John 3:8b The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the works of the devil.

Revelation 12:10ff Teaching continues.

- 46:00 Hebrews 2:14-15 Read passage. Jesus defeats death for those in slavery.
- 49:40 Revelation 12:14-17 (verse 14) A reminder of the passage from Exodus 19:4. Where God's people are taken from peril as if on the great eagle's wings. (Verses 15-16) Also a reference to the Exodus and the parting of the water. We are (verse 17) in that time of the 1260 days, 42 months, Times, Time and half a time Now when we are holding to the testimony of Jesus. The church age, the Gospel age that time from the ascension of Christ, after the resurrection, until his second coming, in Judgment.

Rev. 12:1 And a great portent appeared in heaven, a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars; 2 she was with child and she cried out in her pangs of birth, in anguish for delivery. 3 And another portent appeared in heaven; behold, a great red dragon, with seven heads and ten horns, and seven diadems upon his heads. 4 His tail swept down a third of the stars of heaven, and cast them to the earth. And the dragon stood before the woman who was about to bear a child, that he might devour her child when she brought it forth; 5 she brought forth a male child, one who is to rule all the nations with a rod of iron, but her child was caught up to God and to his throne, 6 and the woman fled into the wilderness, where she has a place prepared by God, in which to be nourished for one thousand two hundred and sixty days.

Rev. 12:7 Now war arose in heaven, Michael and his angels fighting against the dragon; and the dragon and his angels fought, 8 but they were defeated and there was no longer any place for them in heaven. 9 And the great dragon was thrown down, that ancient serpent, who is called the Devil and Satan, the deceiver of the whole world — he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him. 10 And I heard a loud voice in heaven, saying, "Now the salvation and the power and the kingdom of our God and the authority of his Christ have come, for the accuser of our brethren has been thrown down, who accuses them day and night before our God. 11 And they have conquered him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, for they loved not their lives even unto death. 12 Rejoice then, O heaven and you that dwell therein! But woe to you, O earth and sea, for the devil has come down to you in great wrath, because he knows that his time is short!"

Rev. 12:13 And when the dragon saw that he had been thrown down to the earth, he pursued the woman who had borne the male child. 14 But the woman was given the two wings of the great eagle that she might fly from the serpent into the wilderness, to the place where she is to be nourished for a time, and times, and half a time. 15 The serpent poured water like a river out of his mouth after the woman, to sweep her away with the flood. 16 But the earth came to the help of the woman, and the earth opened its mouth and swallowed the river which the dragon had poured from his mouth. 17 Then the dragon was angry with the woman, and went off to make war on the rest of her offspring, on those who keep the commandments of God and bear testimony

to Jesus. And he stood on the sand of the sea.

Gen. 3:15 I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her seed; he shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise his heel."

John 8:42 Jesus said to them, "If God were your Father, you would love me, for I proceeded and came forth from God; I came not of my own accord, but he sent me. 43 Why do you not understand what I say? It is because you cannot bear to hear my word. 44 You are of your father the devil, and your will is to do your father's desires. He was a murderer from the beginning, and has nothing to do with the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks according to his own nature, for he is a liar and the father of lies. 45 But, because I tell the truth, you do not believe me. 46 Which of you convicts me of sin? If I tell the truth, why do you not believe me? 47 He who is of God hears the words of God; the reason why you do not hear them is that you are not of God."

<u>Gal. 3:16</u> Now the promises were made to Abraham and to his offspring. It does not say, "And to offsprings," referring to many; but, referring to one, "And to your offspring," which is Christ.

1John 3:8 He who commits sin is of the devil; for the devil has sinned from the beginning. The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the works of the devil.

<u>1Chr. 17:10</u> from the time that I appointed judges over my people Israel; and I will subdue all your enemies. Moreover I declare to you that the LORD will build you a house. <u>11</u> When your days are fulfilled to go to be with your fathers, I will raise up your offspring after you, one of your own sons, and I will establish his kingdom. <u>12</u> He shall build a house for me, and I will establish his throne for ever. <u>13</u> I will be his father, and he shall be my son; I will not take my steadfast love from him, as I took it from him who was before you, <u>14</u> but I will confirm him in my house and in my kingdom for ever and his throne shall be established for ever."

<u>Luke 10:17</u> The seventy returned with joy, saying, "Lord, even the demons are subject to us in your name!" <u>18</u> And he said to them, "I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven.

Matt. 12:24 But when the Pharisees heard it they said, "It is only by Be-elzebul, the prince of demons, that this man casts out demons." 25 Knowing their thoughts, he said to them, "Every kingdom divided against itself is laid waste, and no city or house divided against itself will stand; 26 and if Satan casts out Satan, he is divided against himself; how then will his kingdom stand? 27 And if I cast out demons by Be-elzebul, by whom do your sons cast them out? Therefore they shall be your judges. 28 But if it is by the Spirit of God that I cast out demons, then the kingdom of God has come upon you. 29 Or how can one enter a strong man's house and plunder his goods, unless he first binds the strong man? Then indeed he may plunder his house.

<u>Heb. 2:14</u> Since therefore the children share in flesh and blood, he himself likewise partook of the same nature, that through death he might destroy him who has the power of death, that is, the devil, <u>15</u> and deliver all those who through fear of death were subject to lifelong bondage.

Ex. 19:4 You have seen what I did to the Egyptians, and how I bore you on eagles' wings and brought you to myself.
