07-106-56 THE BEAST OUT OF THE EARTH

- :00 Short review. Symbols in Revelation often previously used in Old Testament or even earlier New Testament writings. It is a Revealing of Jesus Christ as he is in Heaven at the right hand of the Father now rather than a view of him as Savior in his incarnation. Further, one needs to interpret the symbolic material in light of the plain teaching elsewhere in the scripture. There is a cosmic spiritual battle raging, behind the battle we see with our senses.
- 6:55 2 Thessalonians 2:1-12 The great moment that all God's people look forward to is The Second Coming of Christ. The coming will only happen after <u>The</u> rebellion and the man of Lawlessness.
- 14:00 1 John 2:21-23 Who is The Liar the man that denies that Jesus is the Christ. Reinforced in Chapter 4:1-3
- 18:00 Revelation 12:17-13:1 The reading and teaching. Verse 1 "Sea" stands for restless humanity.
- 24:00 The obvious emergence of the unholy Trinity. The Dragon, the Beast from the Sea and the false prophet.
- 28:10 There is an audio gap. Terry was recapping the repeating timeframe of 1260 days, 42 months and time, times

and half a time. The time between Christ's first coming and His second coming. It is the time period right now. The age of Grace, the church age, the Gospel age. He recaps from the beginning of chapter 11:1 as the audio continues.

- 30:20 Revelation 13:11-18 This Beast is not as the others, for he looks like a lamb. The exterior of a lamb but the voice of the Dragon.
- 32:00 The previous reference, to the Lamb of God, as distinct from this lamb, like the beast Revelation 5:6-14 describes the Real Lamb of God.
- 34:40 2 Thessalonians 2:9 This second beast (counterfeit lamb) will perform counterfeit miracles and signs.
- 35:35 Revelation 17:11 (Terry said 16:11 but it is 17) Teaching on the Beast out of the Sea Revelation 13:1-10.
- 36:50 Revelation 19:20 The Beast out of the Sea is captured and with him is the False Prophet (The second beast Out of the Earth, Revelation 13:11-18) The false prophet is "Religion" aligning itself with the State (Beast from the Sea) to come in opposition to the true God Jesus.
- 37:10 Revelation 20:10 The unholy Trinity- The Dragon (Satan), The Beast out of the Sea (the political embodiment of the AntiChrist) and the Beast out of the Earth (The false lamb the Religious False Prophet).

Teaching continues on the "Religious" façade of the AntiChrist. It is the church apostate – without Jesus Christ.

- 43:25 Jeremiah 23:16-18 Teaching on the message of false prophets.
- 45:00 Revelation 13:15-18 Teaching continues. (Verse 16) Satan decides to "counterfeit the idea of marking" which God instituted in Chapter 7:3. There now are two people-Those of God and those of the evil one.

God will allow his church to be overcome (for a short time) as described in Chapter 11:7-10. Then God will come in Judgment to vindicate.

47:20 Revelation 13:18 Teaching on the number 666. Political and Religious power organized against the true God.

- 2Th. 2:1 Now concerning the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our assembling to meet him, we beg you, brethren, 2 not to be quickly shaken in mind or excited, either by spirit or by word, or by letter purporting to be from us, to the effect that the day of the Lord has come. 3 Let no one deceive you in any way; for that day will not come, unless the rebellion comes first, and the man of lawlessness is revealed, the son of perdition, 4 who opposes and exalts himself against every so-called god or object of worship, so that he takes his seat in the temple of God, proclaiming himself to be God. 5 Do you not remember that when I was still with you I told you this? 6 And you know what is restraining him now so that he may be revealed in his time. 7 For the mystery of lawlessness is already at work; only he who now restrains it will do so until he is out of the way. 8 And then the lawless one will be revealed, and the Lord Jesus will slay him with the breath of his mouth and destroy him by his appearing and his coming. 9 The coming of the lawless one by the activity of Satan will be with all power and with pretended signs and wonders, 10 and with all wicked deception for those who are to perish, because they refused to love the truth and so be saved. 11 Therefore God sends upon them a strong delusion, to make them believe what is false, 12 so that all may be condemned who did not believe the truth but had pleasure in unrighteousness.
- <u>1John 2:21</u> I write to you, not because you do not know the truth, but because you know it, and know that no lie is of the truth. <u>22</u> Who is the liar but he who denies that Jesus is the Christ? This is the antichrist, he who denies the Father and the Son. <u>23</u> No one who denies the Son has the Father. He who confesses the Son has the Father also.
- 1John 4:1 Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are of God; for many false prophets have gone out into the world. 2 By this you know the Spirit of God: every spirit which confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is of God, 3 and every spirit which does not confess Jesus is not of God. This is the spirit of antichrist, of which you heard that it was coming, and now it is in the world already.
- Rev. 12:17 Then the dragon was angry with the woman, and went off to make war on the rest of her offspring, on those who keep the commandments of God and bear testimony to Jesus. And he stood on the sand of the sea.
- Rev. 13:1 And I saw a beast rising out of the sea, with ten horns and seven

heads, with ten diadems upon its horns and a blasphemous name upon its heads.

Rev. 13:11 Then I saw another beast which rose out of the earth; it had two horns like a lamb and it spoke like a dragon. 12 It exercises all the authority of the first beast in its presence, and makes the earth and its inhabitants worship the first beast, whose mortal wound was healed. 13 It works great signs, even making fire come down from heaven to earth in the sight of men; 14 and by the signs which it is allowed to work in the presence of the beast, it deceives those who dwell on earth, bidding them make an image for the beast which was wounded by the sword and yet lived; 15 and it was allowed to give breath to the image of the beast so that the image of the beast should even speak, and to cause those who would not worship the image of the beast to be slain. 16 Also it causes all, both small and great, both rich and poor, both free and slave, to be marked on the right hand or the forehead, 17 so that no one can buy or sell unless he has the mark, that is, the name of the beast or the number of its name. 18 This calls for wisdom: let him who has understanding reckon the number of the beast, for it is a human number, its number is six hundred and sixty-six.

Rev. 5:6 And between the throne and the four living creatures and among the elders, I saw a Lamb standing, as though it had been slain, with seven horns and with seven eyes, which are the seven spirits of God sent out into all the earth; 7 and he went and took the scroll from the right hand of him who was seated on the throne. 8 And when he had taken the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, each holding a harp, and with golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints; 9 and they sang a new song, saying, "Worthy art thou to take the scroll and to open its seals, for thou wast slain and by thy blood didst ransom men for God from every tribe and tongue and people and nation, 10 and hast made them a kingdom and priests to our God, and they shall reign on earth." 11 Then I looked, and I heard around the throne and the living creatures and the elders the voice of many angels, numbering myriads of myriads and thousands of thousands, 12 saying with a loud voice, "Worthy is the Lamb who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing!" 13 And I heard every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and in the sea, and all therein, saying, "To him who sits upon the throne and to the Lamb be blessing and honor and glory and might for ever and ever!"

14 And the four living creatures said, "Amen!" and the elders fell down and worshiped.

2Th. 2:9 The coming of the lawless one by the activity of Satan will be with all power and with pretended signs and wonders,

Rev. 17:11 As for the beast that was and is not, it is an eighth but it belongs to the seven, and it goes to perdition.

Rev. 13:1 And I saw a beast rising out of the sea, with ten horns and seven heads, with ten diadems upon its horns and a blasphemous name upon its heads. 2 And the beast that I saw was like a leopard, its feet were like a bears, and its mouth was like a lion's mouth. And to it the dragon gave his power and his throne and great authority. 3 One of its heads seemed to have a mortal wound, but its mortal wound was healed, and the whole earth followed the beast with wonder. 4 Men worshiped the dragon, for he had given his authority to the beast, and they worshiped the beast, saying, "Who is like the beast, and who can fight against it?"

Rev. 13:5 And the beast was given a mouth uttering haughty and blasphemous words, and it was allowed to exercise authority for forty-two months; 6 it opened its mouth to utter blasphemies against God, blaspheming his name and his dwelling, that is, those who dwell in heaven. 7 Also it was allowed to make war on the saints and to conquer them. And authority was given it over every tribe and people and tongue and nation, 8 and all who dwell on earth will worship it, every one whose name has not been written before the foundation of the world in the book of life of the Lamb that was slain. 9 If any one has an ear, let him hear: 10 If any one is to be taken captive, to captivity he goes; if any one slays with the sword, with the sword must he be slain. Here is a call for the endurance and faith of the saints.

Rev. 19:20 And the beast was captured, and with it the false prophet who in its presence had worked the signs by which he deceived those who had received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped its image. These two were thrown alive into the lake of fire that burns with sulphur.

Rev. 20:10 and the devil who had deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and sulphur where the beast and the false prophet were, and they will be

tormented day and night for ever and ever.

Jer. 23:16 Thus says the LORD of hosts: "Do not listen to the words of the prophets who prophesy to you, filling you with vain hopes; they speak visions of their own minds, not from the mouth of the LORD. 17 They say continually to those who despise the word of the LORD, 'It shall be well with you'; and to every one who stubbornly follows his own heart, they say, 'No evil shall come upon you.'"

Jer. 23:18 For who among them has stood in the council of the LORD to perceive and to hear his word, or who has given heed to his word and listened?

Rev. 11:7 And when they have finished their testimony, the beast that ascends from the bottomless pit will make war upon them and conquer them and kill them, 8 and their dead bodies will lie in the street of the great city which is allegorically called Sodom and Egypt, where their Lord was crucified. 9 For three days and a half men from the peoples and tribes and tongues and nations gaze at their dead bodies and refuse to let them be placed in a tomb, 10 and those who dwell on the earth will rejoice over them and make merry and exchange presents, because these two prophets had been a torment to those who dwell on the earth.

Rev. 13:18 This calls for wisdom: let him who has understanding reckon the number of the beast, for it is a human number, its number is six hundred and sixty-six.
